- The 1<sup>st</sup> OTCH Am Staff in history, a street rescue and Gaines placer.
- UDs & HITs on a Greyhound (Gaines placer) & a Dachshund.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> OTCH Aus Cattle Dog in the breed & 1<sup>st</sup> UDX.  
'Brock' had multiple HITs, Gaines placements & 5 **200** scores. He became an OTCH 5 times over with limited showing.
- CDX Pomeranian with HITs & Gaines placements
- The 3<sup>rd</sup> OTCH Am Staff in the breed, 1<sup>st</sup> UDX, Gaines placer and '**200**' dog.
- Parson Russell Terrier unbeaten in Novice with 8 HITs and two **200** scores.



Pat has trained dogs professionally for 28 years and has had many successful competition students. She bred border collies for many years and has been deeply involved with the rescue & re-homing of puppies and dogs of different breeds, sizes and temperaments. Pat feels this experience contributes greatly to her knowledge of dog behavior & training. Many of these rescues go on to performance and working homes and most of Pat's competition dogs have been ILP'd rescues.

Pat is now employed by a large Guide Dog organization, evaluating puppies and dogs and teaching people how to train. In addition to the Parson Russell, she is also currently training a Hurricane Katrina pit bull and a rescued Australian Shepherd.
