

I am also a member of and serve on the board of the Penn Treaty Kennel Club and am co-show chair of the Greater Philadelphia Dog Club; I am Vice-President of the Liberty Brussels Griffon Club and an active member of the Boston Terrier Club of America, I am a member of the American Miniature Schnauzer Club and serve as liaison for the National Specialty held in conjunction with Montgomery County Kennel Club. I am also vice-president and serve on the board of the Tri-Angle Boston Terrier Breeders Club.
