CONFORMATION ENTRY CLASSES

The following conformation classes (divided by sex) will be provided. Only dogs entered in one of the regular, non- regular or unofficial classes shall be allowed within the show precincts.

REGULAR CLASSES (divided by sex):

Junior Puppy – any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy – any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 - 18 Months - any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

Canadian Bred - any dog born in Canada. Champions of any country excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor - any dog owned and handled in the ring by the owner/breeder. The handler must be the owner/coowner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open - for all dogs. The open class shall be divided by coat variety: rough or smooth and by colour: red, black, or any acceptable color other than red or black.

Veterans – (CKC 12.2.1 (h) – dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered. The Veteran Winner for each gender will not compete for championship points. The Veteran Winner for each gender shall compete for Best of Breed.

Specials Only – any dog that has a CKC registration number or a CKC ERN number and who has attained the required points for CKC Championship status. A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after entries close, if the CKC Registration Number or ERN number was received by the Show Secretary 24 hours prior to the opening time of the show. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog was moved to the Specials Only class did not have a CKC number, ERN number or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship. Dogs entered in this class compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select, Award of Merit (if Award of Merit criteria is met), and if eligible, Best Puppy in Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES:

Baby Puppy Class – any dog 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The judging of Baby Puppy classes will occur after Best of Breed judging. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, and Best Baby Puppy in Breed.

Brace – for 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). A Brace should be judged as an identical pair. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead. Dogs entered in Brace must be entered in either a Regular Class or Exhibition Only. If a dog entered in the Brace class is spayed or neutered, the dog must be entered in Exhibition Only.

Puppies 4-6 months (Exhibition Only) – dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only, providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered another dog in one of the Regular classes.

Exhibition Only - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competitions. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes, if provided for in the premium list.



A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or interac for payment.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering Canadian Kennel Club events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. An ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the *Animal Pedigree Act* but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own ERN number. A CKC ERN registration form and ERN fee details can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.ca To obtain an ERN, mail or fax the Canadian Kennel Club the ERN form with a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate plus a certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT.**

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
b) In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

- 1. This specialty show ("the event") is an official CKC approved event. The CCWC Ltd. adhere to the CKC Conformation Dog Show Rules, a copy of which can be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club, #101, 5397 Eglington Avenue West, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5K6 or online at <u>www.ckc.ca</u>.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with, and abide by, the CKC rules pertaining to this event.
- 3. The Event Superintendent will be in full charge of the event.
- 4. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the event date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 5. It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Event Superintendent shall promptly report to the Event Committee, who shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, upon receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 6. CCWC Ltd reserves the right to remove any person from the event.
- 7. Any dog excused by the Event Superintendent for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the event.
- 8. The event committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 9. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The CCWC Ltd. will not be responsible for, and is not obligated to provide, any service to notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging.
- 10. Exhibitors and handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are Mountain Time.
- 11. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for the welfare of their dogs and children.
- 12. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors we require that you keep the grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs.
- 13. Entry fees will not be refunded if the Event cannot open, or be completed, by reason of covid regulations, changes to venue use policy, riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of CCWC Ltd.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win a prize, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the CCWC Ltd. their members, directors, officers, agents, superintendents, volunteers or show secretary, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing, including but not limited to death, disease, illness or medical expenses or death or injuries caused by a dog, while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto. 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.
