A Temporary Competition fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form."

General Information

- Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. A fee of \$15.00 will be charged on NSF cheques. No post-dated cheques will be accepted.
- Please include all Canadian Tracking Titles earned by the dog on the entry form. For entry into UTD either a Canadian TD title or a valid pre-test certification certificate from a person authorized to certify dogs.
- Entrants are not permitted to train on the test grounds for the 14 days prior to the test. If in doubt, contact the secretary for information about what areas are off limits.
- A random draw of all non-duplicate entries will be held June 2, 2022 at 7:00 pm at 5334 Cobble Hills Rd, Thamesford, ON N0M 2M0.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs.
- All dogs must be kept on leash and under control at all times.
- Dogs not officially entered in the Test will not be permitted on the grounds.
- Bitches in season will be allowed to compete but will be assigned the last track.
- Exhibitors should note that the CKC does not confer a title on a dog until it is registered individually in the club's records. An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of The Canadian Kennel Club. The fee will match the Event Registration Number (ERN) fee.

- Drawing for the tracks will commence at 8:30 am DST. Location (in the area of Veteran's Memorial Parkway and Dundas Street in London, ON) to be determined by closing date and will be communicated to entrants at that time.
- Judging will commence at 9:00 am DST with the UTD tracks, followed by the UTDX tracks.
- Maps to draw location and tracks will be sent with a confirmation on entry to the test.
