35 Pre-paid Obedience/Rally O benching: will be available ringside. Please ensure you request the type of Obedience benching you prefer. Unreserved/Unpaid Obedience/Rally O benching will be available (on a first come basis) in the Conformation benching/grooming area, NOT at ringside. You may only Obedience/ Rally O bench ringside if you have paid/reserved benching, NO exceptions. Please note the size of the spaces and ensure that you reserve the number of spaces required.

Performance dogs cannot be left unattended in soft sided crates. Please place crates facing the Performance rings.

There will be no Conformation benching at ringside, reserved Conformation benching/grooming space will only be available in designated Conformation benching/grooming area.

Once benching is sold out, no further reservations will be taken. There will be limited unreserved space available on a first come basis in the main grooming/ benching area for Conformation, Obedience and Rally O. Get your reservations in early to avoid disappointment. The Red Deer and District Kennel Club reserves the right to limit x-pens in the unreserved benching area.

If you have NOT reserved, you must find an un-reserved space. If you put your items in a space reserved by someone else, you will be told by the Show Superintendent to remove your items immediately, or they will be removed for you.

ZERO TOLERANCE – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at The Red Deer & District Kennel Club Shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit. Including and not limited to suspension from attending the event for a specific period of time in the future, including permanently.

Definition of Bullying: *Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.*

Examples include:

- *insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits*
- *spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo*
- *berating/belittling an individual*
- *unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others*
- *giving insulting nicknames*
- *engaging in practical jokes that humiliate*
- *undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work*
- *physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates*
- *mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms*
- *yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles*
- *intruding on a participant's privacy by pestering, spying or stalking*
- *physically abusing or threatening abuse*
- *criticising a participant persistently*
- *constantly belittling a person's opinions.*

This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, Facebook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram. During Dates of the events.

Rules and Regulations

GENERAL INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS

Dogs should be in the building at least one hour prior to ring time. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be aware of the posted schedule and be at ringside at the time of judging. The club will not call individual dogs to ringside. Please remain at ringside until judging is completed

Dogs must be exercised in the areas provided, anyone exercising their dogs on the grounds outside the building and not cleaning up after them, will be excluded from the show or trial.

Exhibitors are reminded to respect hospitality facilities. The Red Deer & District Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse future entries from any exhibitor who creates excessive destructive or disruption to host facilities (Hotel, motel or campground). The show superintendent is in complete charge of the shows and trials which, are governed by CKC rules. No judge or any other person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under CKC rules shall be subjected to an indignity of any kind during the progress of the show. The Show Committee has a responsibility to see that this rule is enforced.

EXTRACTS FROM THE DOG SHOW RULES - BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES

Chapter 19.7, Page 55, CKC Conformation Show Rules and Regulations.

The Dog Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune. The Red Deer and District Kennel Club reserves the right to remove from the shows or trials any person or dog for any just cause.

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A TCN FEE of \$10.50 must accompany the entry of a dog at a show held under these rules.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 14.1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 – SHOW OFFICIALS

Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent. Any dog excused by the show superintendent or veterinarian, for any reason, shall not compete in any classes or accept any awards for the duration of the shows or trials. No refund of any fees will be made.

If because of riot, civil disturbance, or any other acts beyond the control of the show committee, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds shall be made!

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

A description of all ***Conformation, Obedience and Rally Classes and Rule and Regulations*** can be found at www.ckc.ca

1. This show is held INDOORS at The Westerner Agricentre Building
2. This is an UNLIMITED entry Conformation dog show. Performance shows entry limited to the timing restrictions of each judge.
3. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
4. All entries must be in the Show Secretary's hands by the closing date on the front page of this Premium List.
5. MIXED BREEDS are allowed in the performance events with CCN.
6. RALLY-OBEDIENCE will be held in a 45' x 60' Ring. The Precincts of the Rally trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding the ring. Only dogs entered in the trials are permitted within the Precincts of the Rally trials.
7. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to INDIGNITIES. The Conformation Show or Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7 CKC Conformation Show and 20.7 CKC Obedience and Rally-Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.)
8. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by an act of the event club or because it has been entered incorrectly, except as provided in 9 below. Nor will entry fees be refunded if due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the RDDKC, that make it impossible to open or complete the show. There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments
9. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED INTO THE OBEDIENCE OR RALLY SHOW COMES INTO SEASON within 10 days of the show. A veterinary letter certifying that the bitch came into season within 10 days prior to the show must be delivered to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of that trial's judging. No Refunds will be given for the service fees provided by the dogshow.ca
A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a Veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.
10. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:
 - a. An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
 - b. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
 - c. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
10. The show building will be OPEN at 7 a.m. on Thursday before the show. Booths may set up after 3 p.m. Wednesday.
11. The Westerner Agricentre Building will LOCK the doors at 12 p.m. each night of the show and OPEN the doors at 6:15 a.m. each morning. There will not be anyone one in the Building overnight Dogs are left at your own risk. Red Deer & District Kennel Club will not be responsible for any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or their property.
12. All EMPTY rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour before the show and during the show.
13. Entries will be ACKNOWLEDGED after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts available online .
14. Dogs must be EXERCISED in designated areas only. If you exercise outside you must clean up after your dog.
15. All dogs in the show building must either be REGISTERED in the show or "IN TRANSIT".
16. All entries must be CLEARLY filled out. The Red Deer & District Kennel Club or the Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
17. SIGNS advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted in the benching area or around the rings
18. RDDKC has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with RDDKC Shows, including spectators.
19. Performance dogs cannot be left unattended in soft sided crates. Please place crates facing the Performance rings.

There Will Be Bathing Areas And Indoor Potty Areas

CONFORMATION CLASSES OFFERED:

The following Regular classes will be offered, divided by sex.

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

12 – 18 MONTH CLASS 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

VETERAN CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 4 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.



CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

As of July 2021, the rules for awarding of Grand Champion and Grand Champion Excellent have changed. Please see CKC Conformation Rule 15.2 Grand Champion (GCH) & 15.3 Grand Champion Excellent (GCHEX) for details.

OBEDIENCE:

PRE-NOVICE – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NOVICE “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

NOVICE “C” – as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE - as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

OPEN “HA”- The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized

breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.

OPEN “18A” -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

OPEN “HB” - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes .

OPEN 18B – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes

UTILITY “A” – For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

UTILITY “B” – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES OFFERED

- Rally Ring size will be **45' x 60'**
- The precincts of these trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding
- Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.
- Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.
- All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
- No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.
- No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the A class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.

The following classes will be offered in each Rally Obedience Trial: Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B, Rally Master

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE - The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign.

RALLY MASTER - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

Extracts From CKC Dog Show Rules
Chapter 8 Entries and End of Show Section

8.2.5 An error in an age specified class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

Section 8.3.1 Entries: Every dog entered in a Championship show must be one of the following:

- a) registered with the CKC,
- b) have an Event Registration Number,
- c) be eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- d) if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN).

Section 8.4.1 Listed Dogs: If a dog is not registered as in 8.3.1 (a) or (b) but is eligible for registration with the CKC, it may be entered at a show as a listed dog provided:

- b) that if born in Canada, it is eligible for individual registration;
- c) that if not born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC.
- d) that if it is a foreign born and owned dog, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtain from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

Section 8.4.2 Entry of a listed dog at a show must be accompanied by a listing fee as set by the Board in addition to the regular entry fee.

Section 8.5.1 Acceptance of Entries: If indicated in the premium list, an electronically transmitted entry may be accepted provided the entry is accompanied by a credit card charge authorization.

Section 8.5.3 No entry shall be accepted from or on behalf of any person who is officially known to be expelled, deprived of privileges, debarred or suspended by the CKC or any other registering body for pure bred dogs.

Section 8.5.4 After entries close, no further entries may be accepted, cancelled or substituted other than as otherwise stated in this section or as provided for in case of a postal strike.

Section 8.6.1 Refusal of Entries: The authorities of any show may:

- a) decline to accept entries for just cause, and/or
- b) refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show building on account of disease or viciousness.
- c) in the case of non-acceptance, refund the fee with the reason for non-acceptance.

Section 8.8.2 Fees: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

Section 8.9.1 Moving a Dog to Specials: A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or that has a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and has completed the requirements for a Championship in accordance with these rules but at the time of the closing of entries for a show has not received confirmation of the title, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Specials Only providing the transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in writing by the owner or handler at least one hour prior to the opening of the show.

Section 8.9.2 If it is established that a dog transferred to Specials Only has not completed the Championship requirements, all awards will be canceled and all ribbons and prizes won shall be forfeited. The owner may also be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.9.3 When one or more All-Breed and/or Specialty Shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the moving of class dogs to Specials must be made prior to the scheduled opening of the first show.

Chapter 4 Judges Section 4.1.3 A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Section 4.1.6 No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act.

Chapter 14 Disqualifying or Excusing Dogs

Section 14.1.2 (a) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to excuse or disqualify a dog which menaces, threatens, attempts to bite or bites the judge, another person, or another dog in the ring. When a dog is twice excused on this account, it shall have the status of a disqualified dog.

(b) At his discretion, a judge shall have the authority to permanently disqualify a dog which bites the judge or another person in the ring. Dogs disqualified under this provision will not be eligible for reinstatement. The decision to permanently disqualify a dog must be clearly indicated on the Judge's Disqualification Form.

Section 14.1.4 Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until

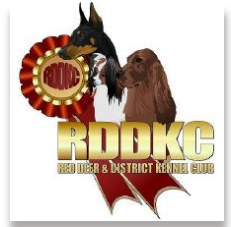
