ENTRY INFORMATION: HST included per dog, per test, per day: JH - \$55, SH - \$60. MH - \$65. Registration number, or PEN/ERN/CCN number must also be submitted.

Do not mail or courier entries directly to the secretary. Do not email entries or e-transfer payment to the secretary. Such entries will NOT be accepted.

Refunds will be given for bitches in season or dogs determined by a veterinarian to be unfit to compete. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the test.

Catalogue, running orders and test site addresses will be posted on dogshow.ca after closing.

GAME: Game birds shall be used.

RUNNING ORDER: Running order will be determined by random draw conducted at the home of the secretary. The running order will be posted on the Club Facebook page and dogshow.ca after the draw.
