JUDGES' BIOGRAPHIES 2014

ROBERT BLACK,
Newtown, Pennsylvania

I've had Terriers all my adult life. My first breed was Westies and I got one in 1968 and started showing and breeding a few years later. My second terrier love is Lakeland Terriers. Presently I share my home with four Lakelands. I started judging in 2002 and judge all the Terrier breeds/group plus Toy Manchester Terriers and BIS. I have judged Terriers four times in Australia and Terrier Specialty shows in Brazil, Germany, Ireland, Sweden, Finland, South Africa and Japan. In the US I've had the honor of judging three times at the AKC Eukanuba Show now held in Orlando and twice at Westminster. I am a member and Show Chair for 27 years of the Hatboro DC, Montgomery County Kennel Club, Kennel Club of Philadelphia and Santa Barbara KC, plus the US Lakeland Terrier parent club. I hold life membership in both the US and the Canadian Westie Clubs.

ROBERT FROST,
Greenfield, Indiana

My vocation was in the Federal Civil Service, working primarily in the waste water field. My avocation is what really matters—my interest in dogs.

I first got involved with a pet Basenji in 1971. Salukis soon followed and my career took off from there.

With very limited breeding we have been able to produce multi BIS, multi BISS, multi BIF, and a National Specialty winners.

Also numerous obedience, canine good citizen and other coursing titles. Another point of pride is having the only two Salukis to have passed the German Shepherd Dog Club of America temperament test. We believe in a well-rounded dog—home, field, show and everywhere else.

Before becoming a judge, I was a professional handler showing and finishing titles on many breeds. During this time I was involved heavily in giving handling classes and offering numerous classes and seminars ranging from form vs. function, anatomy, and other aspects of our dog world.

Judging has become a continuous effort of education. To do the job, one must study and research each breed with dedication. It doesn't end with those approved breeds, but to other breeds as well. When judging BIS you cannot give short shrift to any dog.

First and foremost, a dog must have breed type followed by correct and breed specific soundness. Then it needs the look a dog needs to show it has the ability to do the job it was bred to do. When these factors mesh on a dog it is an awesome experience.

I am currently approved to judge all breeds in lure coursing, Hounds, Non-Sporting and Herding Groups, Italian Greyhounds, Toy Poodles, Juniors, Misc. breeds and BIS.

I have had the honor of judging throughout the US, mainland China, Mexico, New Zealand and Australia. Each country has so much to offer in terms of quality and its people's dedication to their dogs.

BARBARA HEAL,
Spenceville, Ontario

Barbara Heal began her canine career in 1969 breeding Samoyeds under the "Polobar prefix while living in Truro, Nova Scotia. During that time she became one of the founding members of the Cobequid Kennel Club. She is a Life Member of the Canadian Kennel Club, Past President of the Ottawa Kennel Club and served as Show Chair for the Purina Invitational Show of Shows for nine years in addition to the Eukanuba Best of the Best 100. Barbara also served as President of the Samoyed Club of Canada on two separate occasions and wrote the Samoyed Breedlines column in Dogs In Canada magazine for eight years. Her activities have also included serving as a member of the CKC Discipline Committee from 2000 to 2003.

Barbara's interest in the Doberman Pinscher began in 1980 after joining her husband Fred with his "Jagermeister" Dobermans. She soon became a co-breeder and handler of Dobes, as well as many other breeds. Over the years Barbara has piloted many Dobermans and Samoyeds to top honors and still cherishes those memories

In 2004 Barbara began her judging career and became an active member of the Canadian Dog Judges Association; currently serving as Vice President. She has judged in the US, Brazil and plans for Australia in 2014. Barbara is licensed to judge Sporting, Working, Herding and is currently on Permit for the first half of the Hound Group.

Thornton, Ontario

There has been a dog in my life for the past 50 years. My husband, Albert and I work together bouncing ideas off each other for matings, and his 'eye' is invaluable for decisions of keeper puppies and how to present them in the show ring. I have learned along the way with a lot of reading and help from many people. I've owned a rough collie, an Irish Setter and a Newf; but began my journey of breeding and exhibiting with Siberians and have learned the ropes with some of the best of both breeders and exhibitors; some you may know of Snowmist, Bain's Northern, Vishnu and Artic Light ...and from a number of different breeds over the last 25+ years. I now breed and exhibit Australian Shepherds under the ThundeRun prefix.

I have enjoyed success with many Championships on dogs I've bred as well as others I've had the pleasure to own along the way. I've had a few Bests and BPIS winners and multiple dogs in the top 15 over the years.... All breeder/owner/handled. This is our hobby and I enjoy showing the fruits of our labour.

I care deeply about the 'industry', and am learning so much more since I was encouraged to pursue a judging career. Seeing how it works from the middle of the ring, not just on the mats. Still in the start of my journey into judging, I have had the pleasure of judging many lovely exhibits across Canada. The fun is just beginning!

LINDA C. MORE,
Cary, North Carolina

Linda grew up with Shetland Sheepdogs, and started showing in Breed, Obedience and Juniors at age 12. She bred Shelties for about 20 years and co-bred Keeshonden more briefly. Her dogs earned Obedience titles through Utility as well as Championships. In the early 1970's Linda was granted an AKC handler's license and before long was busy as a full-time professional handler based in Connecticut. By the time she retired from handling in 1991, Linda had shown clients' dogs in some 60 different breeds representing all seven Groups, and campaigned Specialty and All-Breed BIS winners in Sporting, Hound, Working, Terrier and Herding breeds.

In November of 1991 Linda was granted AKC approval to judge, starting with the Herding Group. She joined AKC as a conformation field representative in 1997, worked in the Raleigh office

from 1999 to 2003, and is now retired. She currently judges the Sporting, Hound, Terrier and Herding groups, Siberian Huskies, and Junior Showmanship, and has had the pleasure of judging numerous national and regional specialties. Linda had German Shepherd Dogs as companions from 1992 through 2008, and the current resident entertainer is a Border Collie, training in agility and tracking. Linda is a member of the Dog Judges Association of America and at present is the Judges' Education Chairman for the American Shetland Sheepdog Association.

Argentina

Licensed to judge by F.C.A./ F.C.I. : ALL-BREEDS (all-rounder) - AKC judge # 29739

Judging since 1988, have judged multiple championship specialties and all-breeds shows in all five Continents.

All breed professional handler from 1974 to 1985, winning #1 dog all breeds 6 times. Was proclaimed Handler of the year for 1976 in the Argentine magazine "World of Dogs". She's the current President of the Schnauzer Club of Argentina (since 1995), and a former Director of Airedale Terrier Club of Argentina, American Cocker Club of Argentina, and Afghan Hound Club of Argentina. She's Former member of the Advisory Committee to the F.C.A.'s Board of Directors, and Former member of the Airedale Terrier Club of America & the American Miniature Schnauzer Club.

Other activities

- has worked as a translator at lectures for international judges, has given lectures and chats in Kyoto (Japan), Jakarta (Indonesia), Sydney (Australia), Lima & Arequipa (Peru), Ecuador, Buenos Aires and in most of the provinces of Argentina where they have canine activities on different themes,
- has interviewed Top Dog People for prestigious magazines in Brazil and Argentina
- has given technical advice on and co-conducted a TV show called "FOUR-LEGGED FRIENDS", with special emphasis on Canine World activities.
- has successfully counseled numerous Canine and professional activities
- a professional singer, having been trained in opera and lyrical at the "Instituto Superior de Arte del Teatro Colon", de Buenos Aires. At present time, she sings with "En Camino...", a duet that performs argentine folk music.

HARRY O'DONAGHUE,
Ireland

Harry began his career in pedigree dogs in 1953. He has bred more than 200 English, Irish and Foreign Champions under the BLACKDALE prefix. Most of these were terriers. He has however successfully bred Irish Setters, Cocker Spaniels, Labradors, Wolfhounds, Basset Hounds, Beagles, Pugs, Bulldogs, Shetlands, Cavalier King Charles Spaniels, Pomeranians, Yorkshire Terriers and

many of the Terrier breeds. He is now a World Renowned wire fox terrier breeder and exhibitor. He has won Best Of Breed at Crufts , the world's biggest dog show, on twelve separate occasions with twelve different exhibits. His very modern kennel houses many famous Champions including the record holder Multi CHAMPION BLACKDALE CAROUSEL.

Harry started judging in 1961 and became an ALL BREEDS JUDGE in 1971. He now judges ALL BREEDS, ALL GROUPS and BEST IN SHOW throughout the world. He is also an F.C.I. approved ALL BREEDS judge. . He has judged major canine events in Norway, Denmark, Sweden, Germany, Switzerland, Finland, Latvia, Spain, Italy, Portugal, France, Argentina, Austria, Estonia, Uruguay, Cuba, Australia, New Zealand, U.S.A., Holland, Belgium, Russia, Japan, South Africa, Canada, Taiwan, Malta, Greece, Cyprus, Ukraine, England and Ireland.

He has also considered it a great honour to have been invited to judge THE WORLD DOG SHOW and CRUFTS on several occasions. He is well known for his seminars on Wire Fox Terriers.

NORMAN PATTON,

Mesa, Arizona

Mr. Norman Patton was born into a dog family in Springfield, Illinois. His parents raised Chihuahuas. At the early age of 15 he showed his first dog at the Chihuahua Club of America, along with his father they were Winners Dog and Winners bitch, under Mr. Melbourne Downing. That was the start of it all. Mr. Patton started showing dogs for friends, including Poodles, Pugs, Pokes, Poms and Chihuahuas. At the age of 21 he received his handlers license. When he was 25 years old he decided to pursue his education and become a teacher. He attended Illinois State University, Southern Illinois University and University of Illinois. He received his Bachelors degree in 1968. He then was hired as a High School teacher in Springfield, Illinois. After 2 years teaching he moved to St. Louis, Missouri and then taught school nearby in Belleville, Illinois. A position which he held for 30 years.

After Mr. Patton retired from teacher he pursued his judging career and has been judging for 48 years. His judging has taken him to China, Japan, England, Canada and in every state in the United States. He has judged Westminster several times and has judged at the Eukanuba show twice.

Mr. Patton is approved for the Sporting, Terrier, Toy, Non-Sporting, four working breeds and eight hound breeds.

He is kept very busy, judging approximately 65 shows a year.

IAN RASMUSSEN,

Queensland, Australia

I have been involved in show dogs since 1975 and in that time the most successful breeds that I have owned and shown include Saluki's, Whippets, Dobermans, Siberian Huskies, Norfolk Terriers and Papillons. Over the years I have won in excess of 200 Best in Show awards with dogs from these breeds.

My main breed is Salukis and I have owned and bred them since 1978 under the Ahmadi prefix in partnership with Phillip Bennett. We have bred in conjunction with Erin Brown and Penny Dunkley of Quanmarra Salukis that have been amongst the top winning Salukis in Australia for many years. Our breeding has also produced successful Salukis in America, Japan and Sweden.

My other passion is Papillons and have co owned and bred several Best in Show winners in recent years under the Birikino prefix

I have been judging since 1991 and in 2007 was granted All Breeds status by the Australian National Kennel Control. Countries that I have judged in are Australia, New Zealand, Singapore, America, Thailand, Japan, the Philippines, Korea, China, India, Russia, Indonesia, Finland, Estonia,

Sweden, Portugal and Brazil .

I am also a member of our Judges Committee, Chairperson of the Junior Handler Committee and I also give breed lectures on several breeds as well as lecturing on Handling.

JEAN THOMPSON SINGH,
United Kingdom

I have been asked by the Border Terrier Club of Ontario to write a few lines about my time in the breed and my judging career. Outlined below is a brief chronological account of my association with Border Terriers.

I was brought up in the Borders region of the United Kingdom at a place called Longhirst Station close to the small village of Longhirst near Morpeth and our bungalow was called Countryside Cottage, so as a very small girl, the little dogs were never far away from me. A Border Terrier was always round our home and in 1969, I became interested in showing my dogs.

It was not long before I bred my first litter from Vandamere's Sweet Sue by Dandyhow Brussel Sprout and from this litter came my first champion of the breed in CH. Vandamere's Band Of Gold.

My father also had a good interest in the Borders and in showing, and a few years later we went into partnership. We had many great times together in those years, travelling all over the country to shows and meeting our fellow exhibitors. There were more Vandamere champions made up over the years however, they were all bitches.

In 2008 I was campaigning a dog and a bitch and in September of that year Nanrich Lets Go To Vandamere gained her third and qualifying Challenge Certificate and became a UK Champion, and a few days later Vandamere's Secret Agent JW, gained his third and qualifying Challenge Certificate and also became a UK Champion. A great week of showing and my first dog champion.

I awarded Challenge Certificates for the first time in 1984 and if my memory serves me right I believe I have judged the breed 15 times at Championship level. However, although the Border Terrier was and still is, my first love, I also became interested in French Bulldogs and campaigned them in the show ring for a time with good success making a Champion. I have awarded Challenge Certificates five times in this breed also.

Faye is on the board of the Doberman Pinscher Club of America, and Judges Education Committee chairperson of the Doberman Pinscher Club of America. She is currently President of the Mount Rainier Working Dog Club and Puget Sound Doberman Pinscher Club. She is also a member of the Seattle Kennel Club.

Dr. Donald Sturz, Jr. began his involvement with the sport of dogs in 1969 along with his family. He competed avidly in Junior Showmanship and ranked as the nation's number one Junior in 1974, 1975, & 1976. He apprenticed under a number of successful professional handlers, gaining a broad base of breed knowledge through that experience. CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 A Dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level, save that no more than five (5) points will be credited to a dog for a single show.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12. In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Chapter 4 - Section 4.1.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Flat ribbons will be given for 1st through 4th in sweepstakes.

ALL SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES – BOTH SEXES

OFFICIAL CLASSES (ALL SPECIALTIES)

Baby Puppy – a dog between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

Junior Puppy – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

Senior Puppy – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 15 Months – a dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

15 – 18 Months – a dog between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.

Canadian Bred – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner *and* breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class – for all dogs.

Veterans – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

Specials Only – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

Award of Merit – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Exhibition Only – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

Brace: Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

Stud Dog & Get: Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two or more of his Get, ownership in this class need not be identical. Stud Dog may be neutered.

Brood Bitch & Progeny: Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, ownership in this class need not be identical. Brood Bitch may be spayed.

Each entrant for Brace, Stud Dog, or Brood Bitch must be entered in one of the Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. All Get and Progeny must be entered in an Official Class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Parade of Champions, Titleholders or Veterans: Champion dogs must have completed all requirements for Championship status. Titleholders must have titles recognized by the CKC and AKC. Veteran dogs must be over seven years of age as of the date of the show. Spayed & neutered dogs or dogs in unorthodox trim may be entered.

Field Trial Class: Shall be for dogs having Canadian WC or better (WCI, WCX) title, a CKC licensed Field Trial placement in an official class or a Junior Hunter (JH). Dogs must be at least 6 months of age or older and eligible for registration. Each entrant for Field Trial Class must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only.

Obedience Trial Class: for dogs and bitches who have earned at least a C.D. degree.

Field Champion Class: for Field Champions of record only.

Each entrant for these Unofficial Classes must be entered in one of Official Classes in the Specialty or Exhibition Only. Dogs entered in Obedience cannot be used as part of these classes.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$58.50 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

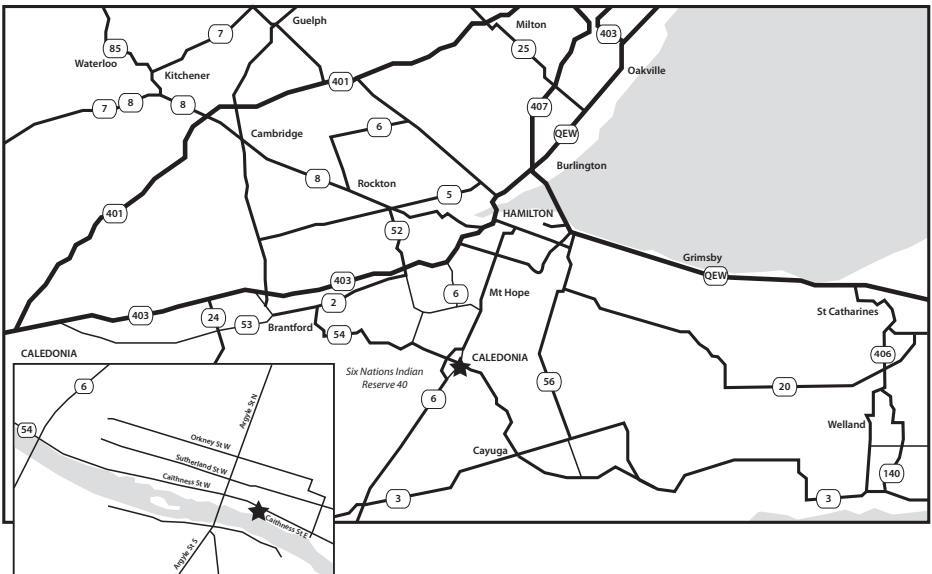

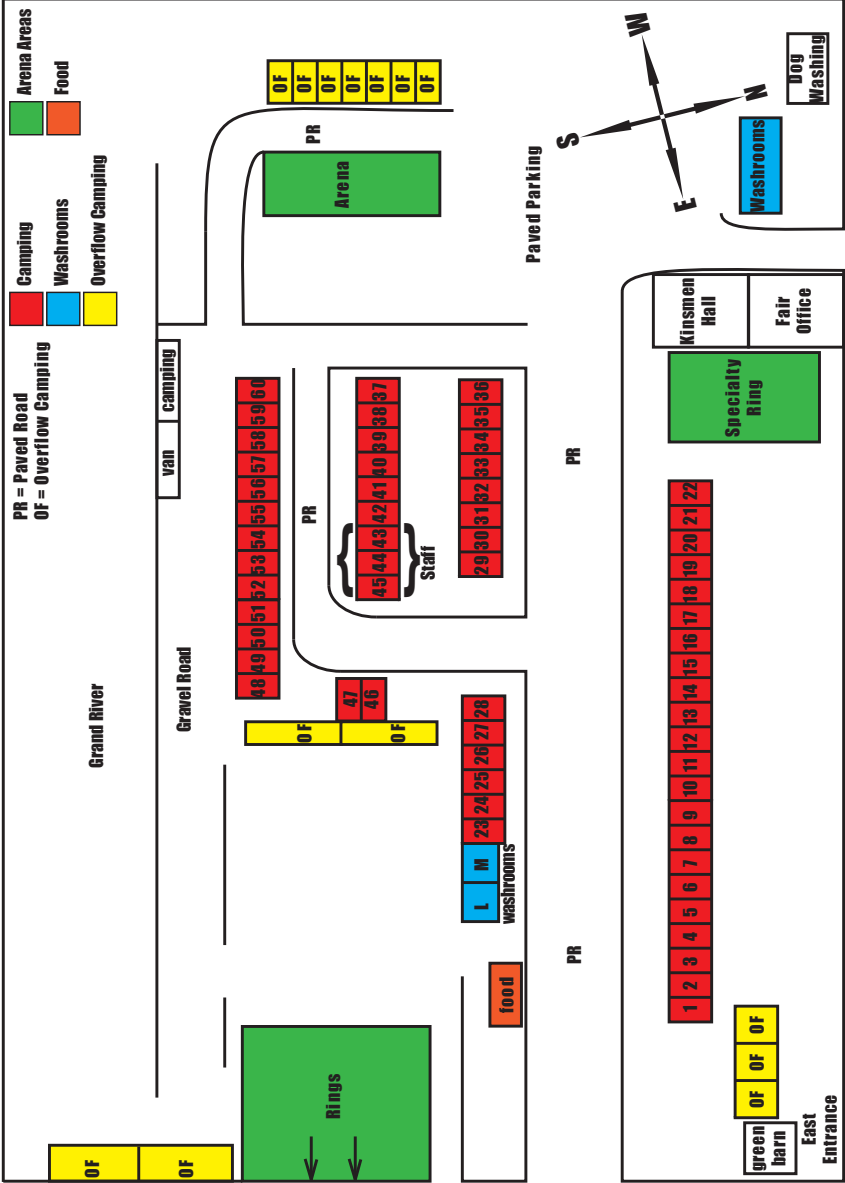
