Official CKC Entry forms MUST be used. If other forms are used they must be of the same size and have the information in the same order. Please photocopy the enclosed entry forms if you require more than were supplied.

All entries must be received by our Show Secretary prior to closing date. Personal cheques and money orders for full value only will be accepted, and must be made payable to - **Norwegian Elkhound Club of Canada**

NO POST DATED CHEQUES accepted. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$20.00.

N.S.F. Cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes

It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes:

Junior Puppy	Senior Puppy	12 to 18 Months
Bred by Exhibitor	Canadian Bred	Open
Veterans	Specials Only	Exhibition Only

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed..

Competition for Sexually Altered Dogs will be offered for sexually altered dogs over six months of age and will be judged after the judging of Best Puppy in Breed in the regular classes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Breed Class – for two dogs of the same breed

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

18-24 Open for Dogs at least 18 months of age up to but not including 24 months

The winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

Over 9 years for Dogs 9 years of age and older.

The winners of all four classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

50% of the entry fees for each sweeps class will go to the winner of each class;

15% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best in Sweeps;

10% of the total sweeps entry fees will go to the Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received by the closing date and time, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official CKC entry form. **Please type or print clearly.**
2. **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note that **full name and address of owners MUST** be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned. **(Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules)**
3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
4. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show/Trials Secretary after the closing time and date.
5. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Building will open at 6:30am each day. On Friday, the Building will be open from 4:00pm until 10:00pm for anyone wishing to set up early.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.**
- The NECC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules, Sec. 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the act. (Dog Show Rules Sec. 6.3.4)
- The NECC and the Show Committee will use care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either the dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of the KCC and their Show Committee, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be made.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.-
- All rules and regulations as outlined in the Halifax Kennel Club premium list apply to this event

CONFORMATION CLASSES

Junior Puppy A dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy A dog 9 months and up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months A dog 12 months and up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred A dog which was born in Canada
Bred by Exhibitor A dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class A dog 6 months of age or older
Specials Only Dogs who are Canadian Champions
Exhibition Only Dogs 6 months and over not in competition. Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show may be entered in Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular official classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN number.
 2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
 3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
 4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.
- This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. CHAMPIONSHIP POINT RATINGS

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated dog-awarded winners shall be:

Dogs competing (including dog awarded winners):

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from their ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

Dogs competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In no case may a dog earn more than 5 (five) points at a single show.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion it must win at least 10 points under 3 different judges, which includes at least one 2-point win. This 2-point win must be at the breed or group level.
