

NOTE: No entry shall be made under a judge, of any dog which the judge or any member of her immediate family or household instructed regularly within 6 months prior to the date of the trial. This applies to judges who train dogs in class or with their handlers.

ALSO NOTE: Handlers may not exhibit under a judge who has participated regularly in training class with them within 6 months prior to the trial

A dog can only be entered once in any one class at a trial

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Rules and Regulations Books are available for \$6.00 plus GST from the CKC. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Rules and Regulations. At the option of the handler, a dog may wear either a well-fitting plain buckle collar, a quick-release collar. No fancy collars, choke collars, pinch collars, or other training collars are prohibited. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other training devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course.

Trial precincts:

The precincts of the trial are all areas reserved for the sole use of the WCOBC. Only Dogs entered in official classes are permitted within the precincts of the trial.

The precincts of these trials are the outside and inside rings, the entire barn, and the immediate area behind the barn.

Rules and Regulations:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor, at a rally obedience trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

NOTE: SAME DAY MOVE UPS WILL BE ALLOWED

Moving Up: A dog that has received 3 qualifying scores from at least 2 different judges, may be transferred to the next level provided that request is received at check in. Please see the trial secretary for a move up form.

Entries open February 13, 2013.

Close of Entries – April 3rd, 2013 - 10 days prior to each event

Please do not send an entry that requires our trail secretary to travel to the post office to sign for receipt as this does not ensure that your entry will be received on time. No entries will be accepted by the Show Secretary after closing time and date. This complies with the instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club.

There are no refunds on overpayment. Confirmations will be emailed after closing date.

All courses will have clearly designated start and finish lines with all obstacles/jumps clearly and sequentially numbered. The course layout for each class will be posted in an easily accessible area at least ½ hour before the start of the class.

List of Awards and Prizes:

- Rosettes will be provided for 1st – 4th in each class.
- Qualifying Rosettes will be awarded for all dogs receiving a qualifying score.
- High in Class rosette shall be provided for each class.
- Prize for High score whippet in all trials

Every dog entered in a CKC approved Obedience Trial must be purebred and must be registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number, a Performance Event Number, or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC miscellaneous Class Certification Number.

The dog must be at least 6 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may not be lame or compete if it has tape or bandages.

WCOBC would like your trial experience with us to be pleasant. Please ask one of your committee members if you aren't sure about something. Thank you.

Our facility:

The Kelowna Dog Sport Centre is located in the middle of a working turf farm. No dogs are allowed on the turf or farm land for any reason. Please do not allow your dogs to play off leash along the driveway or any farm areas adjacent to the barn.

ALWAYS pick up after your dog.

Parking:

We expect parking to be fairly tight at this venue. Parking must be orderly and as space efficient as possible against the north side of the barn. There will be two rows of parking with all large vehicles at the east/far end of the barn.

Camping:

Some dry overnight parking is available by previous arrangement. \$10.00 per night. No hook ups available. Email wcobc@shaw.ca.

Sharing space with Agility:

Please note: These Rally Obedience trials are being held outdoors at the Kelowna Dog Sport Centre and will be running concurrently with Agility trials which will be ongoing inside. Take care to ensure that these two events run efficiently and without conflict.

Weather:

Sorry, No cover will be provided in case of inclement weather. However, there is a small covered area outside the ring. Also, all rally obedience dogs are welcome inside the barn.

Crating:

Crating is available inside the barn on the concrete walk way as well as in the outside ring adjacent to the rally ring. Please share space with the agility dogs.

Toilet:

Porta Potties will be available for your use.

There are dog potty areas in the paddocks adjacent to the outdoor ring. Always be sure to pick up after your dog.

Off leash areas:

There is no off leash area at Kelowna Dog Sport Centre. However, there is a small area behind the barn (south side) where you can play with your dog. Ask for directions if you are not sure of which area is for Whippet Club use on April 13th.

There is an off leash park within a 5 minute drive. Ask for directions.

Lunch:

There are several fast food facilities about five minutes drive from KDSC. (Tim Hortons, Pizza etc.) Ask for directions.
