UP TO DATE COVID RING PROCEDURES AND LIABILITY WAIVER WILL BE SENT OUT WITH THE JUDGING SCHEDULE TO ALLOW FOR CHANGES IN REGULATIONS CLOSER TO THE TRIAL DATE. UPDATES WILL ALSO BE POSTED ON THE DKC FACEBOOK PAGE AT THE TIME.

#### REFUND POLICY - COVID & OTHERWISE

If, due to Covid, these trials are not able to be held: refunds will be issued to exhibitors - Minus any costs incurred by DKC. DogShow.ca WILL NOT REFUND SERVICE FEES IF ENTERED AFTER APRIL 7TH. If because of an act of God, riot or civil disobedience, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations or decree (other than Covid related), or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the DKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- \* Anyone entering the show facility will be required to sign a COVID-19 Waiver and will be required to follow all Covid-19 protocols put in place for these shows and trials at all times.
  - \* The Dartmouth Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators. The Dartmouth Kennel Club will not be responsible for any equipment left on the show premises.
  - \* The building will be open an hour before judging commences.
  - \* Only dogs ENTERED in the Trials will be allowed within the trial precincts.
  - \* Judging will not be delayed to accommodate an exhibitor or handler who fails to have their dog in the ring when required.
  - \* The superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
  - \* No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight. Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way will be removed to safety by the appropriate authorities.
  - \* "Puppy/Dog for sale" signs will not be permitted within the precincts of the show.
  - \* It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Obedience Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
  - \* Masks must be worn correctly. Masks MUST be worn during all exercises & at all times within the building by all exhibitors. All participants are to provide their own face masks, the Dartmouth Kennel Club will not have masks available for participants. Anyone who is not following the Covid 19 protocols as laid out, and is unwilling to follow those rules, even after being reminded, will be asked to leave the premises without refund. The Dartmouth Kennel Club is trying to be responsible and ensure individuals' safety and those risking others health will not be tolerated.
  - \* It is the responsibility of the exhibitor/handler to clean up after their dogs outside the ring and outside the building. Please make sure your area inside and outside is clean and all garbage is placed into the appropriate receptacle before you leave.
  - \* Please note there will be no prong or spike collars allowed at this venue
  - \* Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their class (allowing for absentees). The club requests that the competitors vacate the trial grounds when class is complete and awards are presented. Competitors can opt to leave as soon as finished if they prefer. Ribbons will not be mailed out.
- \* EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS. RULE BOOKLETS FOR ALL EVENTS ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C. IN PRINT AND ONLINE AT CKC.CA

\* Personal cheque or Money order for the full amount only will be accepted and should be made out to DARTMOUTH KENNEL CLUB.

\* **No post dated cheques accepted.** All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Overpayment of entries will be considered a donation to DKC Trials.

#### **ENTRY INFORMATION**

\* **All entries must be received by the closing date and time**, accompanied by the proper entry fees and submitted on an official DKC entry form or on DogShow.ca online. Please type or print clearly.

\* **Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.**

\* **To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the closing date and time. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.**

\* **INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.** Agents and handlers please note (Section 13.1.2, Dog Show Rules) that full name and address of owners MUST be filled in and to whom ID's are to be returned.

#### **OBEDIENCE CLASSES**

#### **OBEDIENCE EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:**

Please designate jump height on entry forms.

A bitch in season may not compete. Entry fees will be refunded only if Veterinarian's Certificate to this effect is received by the Trial Secretary before the commencement of the Trial.

#### **RALLY CLASSES:**

Novice A & B, Intermediate, Advanced A & B, Excellent A & B, Master Rally Ring Size is 40x60.

#### **(Will depend on current Covid restrictions)**

**Attention USA exhibitors:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds.

If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated. Thank you

#### **\* Move up:**

**The entry of a dog entered in an official obedience or rally trial class in accordance with these rules may be changed to another official class within the same trial. The change must be on the appropriate form and submitted to the Trial Secretary by the owner or handler at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the trial, schedule permitting.**

**NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEES ARE IN EFFECT**

An annual “Non-member” participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian “non-member” of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number. In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the “non-member” will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the “non-member” participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled. Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by “Non-CKC” members and are not applicable to CKC members.

**Temporary Competition Number (TCN)**

Starting March 2nd,2020 all owners of unregistered, CKC-recognized breeds entering events are required to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as “listed”, and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a PEN (Performance Event Number) or CCN (Canine Companion Number). TCNs can be obtained:  
Online through CKC’s Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit a TCN application online);  
By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC; or

**EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)**

Foreign born dogs entering Canada for the purpose of competing in CKC events, whose primary owners’ address on the foreign registration certificate is outside Canada, must obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN).

- a) The dog must be registered with a CKC recognized Kennel Club and must be a CKC recognized breed.
- b) A copy of the registration certificate showing the name and address of the owner must accompany the application along with the required fee.
- c) The Event Registration Number (ERN) must be obtained from the CKC within thirty (30) days of the first event entered.
- d) Failure to obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN) within thirty (30) days of the first event entered will result in any points, scores or awards cancelled.
- e) Dogs earning CKC titles with an Event Registration Number (ERN) will receive the appropriate title certificate.
- f) An Event Registration Number (ERN) is not a CKC Registration; it simply allows the dog to be entered in a CKC event without registering the dog.
