6.1 Entry Requirements

6.1.1 Draft dog tests shall be open to all dogs of sufficient height and weight that are physically capable of performing all the exercises in a particular class. The judges must excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity. All dogs must be 18 months of age or over on the first day

"DAY OF TEST" ENTRIES

Day of test entries will be accepted on **<u>SATURDAY</u>** only, on a first come, first serve basis, beginning 90 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of each trial and ending 60 minutes prior to the start time. This is dependent on the number of preregistered entrants.

A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
