<u>Please note:</u> If you have a dog you are looking to certify, we will be offering certification runs after the completion of the 2nd CAP Test on Friday, September 25th. You will need to arrange for your own bye dog.

Roll Call and Running Order

Saturday: Rolling Inspections/Roll Call from when you arrive until 10:30 AM. Running order TBA based on entries received. Singles will be run after regular stakes. Puppies and Veterans - 12 PM Registration. Run Saturday after BIF

Sunday: Rolling Inspections/Roll Call from when you arrive until 10:30 AM. **Running order TBA based on entries received**. Singles will run after regular stakes. Puppies and Veterans - 12pm Registration. Run after regular stakes and Singles.

Eligible Entries

Open to any Afghan, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have ERN # or PEN #. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications, or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada.

Stakes Offered

Open Stakes. For all hounds including Field Champions. Mixed Stake. Combines breeds with entries of three or less with agreement of all owners. Best in Field. For all Best of Breed winners & 1st from Mixed Stake. Singles. See Description elsewhere. Puppy Sweeps. Puppies between 6 & 18 months on date of trial. Run individually **Saturday and Sunday** Veteran Sweeps. Dogs 7 years & older on date of trial. Run individually **Saturday and Sunday**

Placements and Awards

Chapter 7, Section 1: Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis: 1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points 2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points 3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points 4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points NBQ: No points

No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been excused in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition. Exhibitors please note: As per rule 9.6.1(b) of the CKC Lure Field Trial Rules and Regulations a dog must "Attain 1 first or 2 second placements by defeating dogs in head to head competition". No placements will be awarded towards CKC championships if all dogs in a breed run as singles, but the points will stand.

Singles Competition

Rolling Roll Call from when you arrive until 10:30 AM. Dogs will be run individually and scored by both judges. Hounds will run after the open stake has completed its preliminary round and then again after the open stake has completed its final round. Singles stake entries from all breeds shall be combined into one mixed stake, with points and placements awarded across all the breeds. A hound entered in the Singles stake shall be barred from competition in the Open or Veteran stakes at the same trial. A dog that is declared ineligible can compete in the single stake in a trial. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. A trophy and ribbon will be awarded to 1st place and ribbons for 2nd to NBQ.

The waiver must be filled out and sent to the Secretary for your entry to be accepted. If you are entering via DOGSHOW.CA the waiver must be completed and emailed/mailed to the Secretary, or brought to the field. We must receive a signed waiver for your dog to run. Post entries will be accepted up to ½ hour prior to Roll Call.

Please note: Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Event Secretary after the closing time and date. PLEASE ALLOW AMPLE TIME FOR DELAYS IN THE MAIL. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL. Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you!

Prize List (All prizes must be claimed at the trial. They will NOT be mailed)

Best of Breed (or 1st if stake is split) Rosette + Suitable Prize 2nd to NBQ Rosette Best in Field Rosette + Suitable Prize <u>Singles</u> Suitable Prize for 1st place. <u>Puppy and Veteran</u>- 50% of entry for 1st in each class

Highest Scoring Veteran (over seven) in the Regular Stake each day will receive a Suitable Prize.

Exhibitors Please Note:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Event Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$59.40 + 5% GST.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved. This fee does not have to be paid before entering this show.

Additional Information for Field Trial

- Overnight parking permitted on field. Port-a-potty on site.

- Stakes will be split if the entry is 24 or more hounds at roll call.

- Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible.

- Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.

- Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.

- All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A Standing Start will be used on Tally-Ho.

- Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. No Flexi-leads or shock collars allowed.

- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field.
- Please bring your own food, refreshments, water and shade.
- No catalogue will be published.
- Delisle Veterinary Clinic is within easy access from the field.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- Please come early to help fill gopher holes as they have been very busy.

SPECIAL COVID 19 PRECAUTIONS THAT MUST BE ADHERED TO BY ALL VOLUNTEERS AND PARTICIPANTS ATTENDING THIS EVENT

Please refer to <u>https://www.saskatchewan.ca/covid-19</u> for the latest Provincial restrictions and guidelines pertaining to outdoor sports activities.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING/MASKS:

The Provincial physical distancing guideline of maintaining a minimum of 6 feet or 2 meters distance from others whenever possible must be adhered to at these events by volunteers and participants. When arriving at the field, please park in a row(s) 6 feet away from each other. As much as possible, please stay in or near your vehicle except when running or exercising a dog. In situations where physical distancing cannot be maintained, the wearing of a facial covering (mask or face shield) over nose and mouth will be required. Facial coverings must be worn by handlers when having to approach the Secretary's trailer, and for running/score information. Facial coverings must also be worn at the line where more than 1 dog is running. Participants must provide their own mask or other suitable face covering.

HANDLER'S MEETING:

The handler's meeting information will be sent via email on Friday, Sept. 25th or before. It is each handler's responsibility to read and follow the information provided. The Secretary can be reached via text or call at 306-230-8349 after 6pm on Friday if there are any questions.

DAY OF EVENT ROLL CALLS/INSPECTIONS:

Roll Call/Inspection will be done at everyone's vehicle. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings at this time. They will proceed down the row of vehicles and ask handlers to move their dogs for a soundness check. To check for females in season, we will ask the owners of females to wipe their own dogs with a tissue and show the inspection committee the tissue.

CLEANLINESS:

Sanitizer will be available at the Secretary's trailer and by the Porta Potty. Bring your own hand sanitizer to use before and after touching your facial coverings, as well as any other incidences of touching objects with contamination potential. Porta Potty – Please use hand sanitizer prior to touching any surfaces with contamination potential and use the provided spray to sanitize the area after you use it.

FOOD/WATER:

A reminder that to comply with health and safety guidelines related to COVID-19, there will be no food or water provided on site. Please bring your own food/refreshments for yourself and for your dog(s).

WELLNESS:

If on the day of these events you or any member of your household are exhibiting any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19, please refrain from attending these events. Entry withdrawals due to illness will be refunded in full. Failure to respect physical distancing guidelines as noted above will result in excusal from the event and event precincts without refund of entry fees.

COVID REFUND POLICY:

In the event that provincial regulations change and force the cancellation of these events prior to the day of the event, entry fees will be refunded.

Any person(s) found to be willfully disregarding these precautions will be asked to leave the property, with no refund of any entry fees.


Directions to the field: Approximate GPS coordinates N51.91022 W 107.091402

The field is about 4 km southeast of Delisle, at the intersection of Range Road 3084 (Durham Road) and Township Road 342. If you are coming north from Calgary on #7, turn Right on #766 approx. 1 km past Delisle, and right at the first turn past the feedlot. The Pattison farm (big red barn, metal roof) is the first place you come to; the field is across the road from the buildings, on the right.

If you are coming from Saskatoon on #7, turn left about 10 km past Vanscoy, onto Durham Road. Continue approx. 3.5 km on Durham Road, crossing 766. The Pattison farm is the second place you come to

on Durham Road. The field is across the road from the buildings, on the right.


