Edna has been into dog shows since was a little girl, showing her father's dogs in México, Puerto Rico, and United States. She grew up with Irish Setters, Boxers, English Springer Spaniels, Fox Terriers (Smooth), Rottweilers and Beagles (these two last breeds being her major passion). Edna is a breeder, owner and handler of many American, Mexican, Grand Mexican and international champion Beagles and Rottweilers. She has judged on most international circuits, Grand Mexican Champion, America's Champions and Specialties shows such as Rottweiler - México, Costa Rica, Guatemala, Australia and Canada (Rottweiler Club of Canada); Boxer - Canada (Boxer Club of Canada); Neapolitan Mastiff - México as well ATIMANA 2004 (the first Latin American judge to do this in the history of ATIMANA) in México, and in Venezuela; Kerry Blue Terrier - Spain and USA; Akita - México; Top Ten Doberman - México; Shih Tzu - Canada (Canadian Shih Tzu Club); Weimaraner - United States; Borzois - United States; Sweepstakes Beagles - Venezuela (Caracas); Judge for the Dog World Show México 2007 (Beagle, Bloodhound and Best In Group 6 (Scent Hounds)); ATIMANA México 2007 (Dog World Show); Traverse, Michigan, USA 2007, Perth, Australia 2007, Sydney, Australia 2007, Adelaide, Australia 2007, Ocala, Florida, USA 2007

Alyce Gilmore of Lake Charles, Louisiana, was raised in Thibodaux, Louisiana where her parents bought the family a pet beagle in 1969. Ms. Gilmore purchased her first show beagle in 1985 and has not been without one since. In 1987, Alyce bred her first beagle litter under the Bayou Oaks prefix. Since then, she has bred over 50 champions with 8 winning All-Breed Best in Show, and a National Speciality winner. Her biggest winner, Ch Bayou Oaks Cappuccino, was Best of Variety at Westminster Kennel Club, twice Best of Variety at National Beagle Club of America and winner of 17 All-Breed BIS. She has always maintained a small breeding program, usually breeding 1-2 litters a year. Alyce served as Chairman of Judges Education for the National Beagle Club of America, where she collaborated to develop the Beagle Visualization. She has also bred Basset Hounds including numerous champions and one National Specialty winner.

Ms. Gilmore is a retired RN with a Bachelor's degree from Northwestern State University. She is currently studying Art at McNeese State University with a concentration in painting.
