Junior – 7-10 yrs. (Novice and Open) Intermediate – 11-14 yrs. (Novice and Open)

Senior - 15 up to but not incl. 18 yrs. (Novice and Open)

Best Overall (excluding Pee Wee)

All Golden Retriever Dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes or Exhibition Only on the day of competition. Entry to be made at the show. Complete rules will appear in the show catalogue. Age for all classes is as of December 31st the preceding year.

Best Overall Rosette donated by MJN Show Services. A rosette will be offered for First through Fourth in each class. Each participant will receive a rosette.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more Points allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5

*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

CKC RULES AND REGULATIONS

The exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club applying to Conformation Shows, Licensed Obedience Trials, and Licensed Rally Obedience Trials. A judge officiating at a show or trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show or trial. It shall be the duty of the club holding the show or trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

SPECIALTY OFFICIAL CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes.

JUNIOR PUPPY – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

SENIOR PUPPY – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 18 MONTHS – a dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

CANADIAN BRED – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs.

VETERANS CLASS (classes split by ages: 7 to 10 years and 10+ years) – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch from each age split class will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

EXHIBITION ONLY – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

AWARD OF MERIT – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BRACE – Two dogs of same breed (not necessarily of the same sex). Must be handled by one person on one lead. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

STUD DOG & GET – Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two <u>only</u> of his Get. Stud Dog must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two <u>only</u> of her Progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

Dogs entered in Obedience cannot be used as part of these classes.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Dogs must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

GUN DOG AND BITCH CLASS – shall be for any dog of either sex with a CKC WC, WCI or WCX or a CKC or AKC JH or SH or a GRCA WC or WCX.

FIELD DOG AND BITCH CLASS – shall be for a dog of either sex with a CKC or AKC MH or placement in a CKC or AKC Licensed Field Trial.

These classes will be held after the Breed Class and any Non-Regular Class judging.

USA EXHIBITORS

SWEEPSTAKES

The following classes, **divided by sex**, will be offered at this sweepstakes:

Junior Puppy – 6 months & under 9 months

Senior Puppy – 9 months and under 12 months

12-15 Month – 12 months and under 15 months

15-18 months – 15 months and under 18 months

First Place winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

A Rosette will be offered for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes and for 1st to 4th in each Sweepstakes Class.

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows:

First in Each Class – 50% of entry money for that class

Best in Sweepstakes – 15% of total sweepstakes entry money

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The following classes, **divided by sex**, will be offered at this sweepstakes: 7-10 years – 7 years and under 10 years

10+ years – 10 years and over

First Place Winners will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes.

A Rosette will be offered for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex Veteran in Sweepstakes and for 1st to 4th in each Veteran Sweepstakes Class.

Money received in entry fees shall be divided as follows:

First in Each Class – 50% of entry money for that class

Best in Veteran Sweepstakes – 15% of total sweepstakes entry money Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes – 10% of total sweepstakes entry money

25% will be held for administration costs.

Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class or Exhibition Only at this show. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in Veteran Sweepstakes.
