Standard: Excellent/Master Excellent **Trial #5** (10) followed by **Trial #6** (11)

JWW: Novice **Trial #7** (9) followed by **Trial #8** (9)

JWW: Intermediate **Trial #7** (6) followed by **Trial #8** (6)

JWW: Excellent/Master Excellent **Trial #7** (11) followed by **Trial #8** (9)

Notes from your Trial Chair:

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1) Only park in the designated area. There will be signage.
- 2) Dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring and at the warm up jump. **No "Flexi" lines allowed on the property** for safety reasons.
- 3) Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is not dog aggressive.
- 4) Please pick up after your dog's waste. Please pick up after yourself. There are waste containers for your trash.
- 5) No smoking anywhere on the trial site. You may smoke in your car, please take your butts with you.
- 6) Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum, while warming up and running agility no problem.
- 7) Food will be available on site, AWC Agility World Team Member Fundraiser.
- 8) Shade Tents may be set up, please stay 15 feet from the agility ring fence when setting up.
- 9) Water/pool will be available for the dogs.
- 10) Please ensure your dogs are not running in the planted adjacent neighbours fields. You may walk them up the paths however please be aware of tractors, they are not use to dogs.

Day of Entries accepted, must be received by trial secretary 1 hr before start of day.

Volunteers needed for ring crew, leash runners and course building, etc.....please sign up at the secretary's desk there will be a sign up sheet. Trials require everyone to help out in some way, not necessarily all day. Please help us avoid mandatory helpers or fees in lieu of, if everyone chips in a little we can avoid this.
