GAME: Ducks and/or pheasants will be used in all tests.

AWARDS: Standard CKC rosettes will be awarded to all passing dogs at the tailgate dinner on Saturday and after the stakes on Sunday at Headquarters.

CLOTHING: All contestants and gallery must wear dark or camouflage clothing, or you may be asked to change before running your dog. Waders may be required.

RUNNING ORDER: Dogs and bitches will be mixed and run in order of the draw. Dogs handled by the same owner will be separated where possible.

It is the responsibility of the Handler to clarify any conflict with the Marshal of each Test.

Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations for Hunt Tests:


Chapter 18: Section 7. It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

Non Member Participation Fee (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee.
- Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

The *South Western Ontario Retriever Training Club* is a member in good standing with the Canadian National Master Retriever Club. As of July 1, 2010 only Master passes at Hunt Tests hosted by clubs in good standing with the Canadian National Master Retriever Club are considered in determining eligibility to enter the <u>Canadian National Master Hunt Test</u>. This year, it will be held in Saskatchewan.
