Judge's Biography

The confirmed judge will be **Claudia Wolf-Meixner, ADRK**

My name is Claudia Meixner and I have been an ADRK-judge since 2010.

Since my birth I have been involved with Rottweilers. I grew up with Rottweilers and I accompanied my parents when they participated in shows and working trials. I also helped them to care of the puppies they bred.

In 1983 I became a member of the Allgemeiner Deutscher Rottweiler Club (ADRK).

In 1984 I took part in a working trial for the first time at the age of twelve years. In that same year I became owner of the kennel „vom Schwaiger Wappen“.

Schwaiger Wappen Rottweilers were and still are very successful in both - show and work - worldwide. On many occasions over the years and still to date, Schwaiger Wappen Rottweilers have achieved some of the most prestigious show titles such as the following: Klubsieger, World Sieger, Bundessieger, Europasiieger, German Champion VDH and ADRK, International Champion and champion titles from many other places all over the world.

Until now I have trained 19 Rottweilers and I have handled them in ZTP and from VPG1 to VPG3. I have also been successful on multiple occasions with my Rottweilers at several ADRK Körungs.

I served on the committee of the ADRK state-group 11 Bavaria North. From 1994 to 2004 I was the main breed warden for this state-group. I am currently still a licensed breed warden and have overseen over 200 litter-controls to date. Since 2012 I have been Vice-President of the state-group Bavaria North.

I would like to thank the Central Ontario Rottweiler Klub for the invitation and I am looking forward to judging your dogs.

CONFORMATION SHOW INFORMATION

Copy of Registration certification **must** be submitted with the entry and originals **must** be made available at the show.

Puppy Classes

4-6 Month Male/Female; **6-9 Month** Male/Female; **9-12 Month** Male/Female

Youth Classes: **12-18 Month** Male/Female; **18-24 Month** Male/Female

Adult Classes

Open Male/Female: **24 months and older** without an IPO or a Championship title.

Champion Class - Over 24 months with a Championship title from RKNA, AKC, CKC, International FCI Champions and any Champion of Record.

Copies of Championship **must** be submitted with the entry and originals **must** be made available at the show.

Working Male/Female: **24 months & older** with an IPO title.

Copy of IPO title **must** be submitted with the entry and originals **must** be made available at the show.

Veteran Male/Female: **8 years or older** the day of the show.

Brood Bitch: Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. Must have at least two (2) offspring appear in the ring. Offspring must be entered in regular classes. The class is evaluated on the merits of the offspring. Owner of the brood bitch does not need to be the owner of the offspring.

Stud Dog: Entered by the owner of the stud dog. Must have at least two (2) offspring appear in the ring. Offspring must be entered in regular classes. The class is evaluated on the merits of the offspring. Owner of the stud dog does not need to be the owner of the offspring.

Kennel Class: Entered by the kennel owner. Three (3) or more dogs bred by the kennel owner & registered with the kennel name of the entrant. All dogs must be entered in the show's regular classes. The kennel owner need not be the owner of all the dogs.

Exhibition Class: Exhibition Classes are for critique only. This class is open to Rottweilers with a disqualifying fault or who are spayed or neutered. Puppies too young to enter regular puppy class can enter exhibition class if puppy has a proof of registration. No ratings or placements are to be awarded. Dogs are critiqued with fault(s) noted. This class is for educational purposes only.

If a dog is eligible for more than one class, the owner may determine the class to enter in.

STANDARD EVALUATION TEST INFORMATION

RKNA Standard Evaluation Title (SE):

The **RKNA SE** title is not a breed test title as it is a certified conformation analysis and consists of measurement, grading of eye color, dentition check and show critique. The dog's conformation must be judged of breeding quality and free of disqualifying faults. The owner **must** provide a weight certificate signed by a vet within 20 days prior to the test. The dog **must** have a valid hip certification. A copy must be provided upon submission of entry and original made available at the show. The dog **must** have a tattoo or microchip for identification (handler is responsible for providing a microchip reader). The Rottweiler is assessed for conformation and soundness.

The test includes everything on the dog being measured or evaluated, including:

height at withers, body length, muzzle, chest depth, chest circumference, skull, eye color, bite and dentition, bone strength, head shape, cheek bone, and general behaviour.

i) Dogs will be weighed, measured and critiqued. A weight certificate (issued within 20 days of the test) may be substituted for weighing the dog if no scale is available. Character traits of the dog become more or less apparent during the weighing and measuring process.

ii) The tattoo or microchip number shall be read out loud as part of the measuring and critique.

iii) The following tests will be done to establish the interaction in a group and sensitivity to noise;

a. The Group. The handler with dog on leash walks through a group of five to eight people. The handler and dog return to the center of the group where the dog sits. The group, when instructed by the judge, converges on the dog and handler and remains there until told by the judge to disperse.

b. The Gun. The handler and dog walk away from the judge. At a distance of fifteen paces, a 22 short blank starter pistol, or its equivalent, is fired twice with a short interval in between each shot. Should the dog have a reaction to the gunfire, this exercise may be varied and repeated at the judge's discretion. If the dog continues to show a strong reaction to gunfire, the test is stopped and the dog does not pass.

Original paperwork MUST be presented to Show Secretary upon registration at show. This includes registration papers and hip certification papers. If titles are to be recorded on the Standard Evaluation, proof of titles must be shown (score book and current membership card from organization the score book is held with, title certificates, etc.).

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION:

- Dogs born in countries with anti-docking laws must be shown with a natural tail.
- A copy of your dog's proof of registration papers MUST be sent in with each entry. Copies of supporting documents for the Champion and Working classes; breed surveys, and Standard Evaluations MUST also be submitted.
- Spayed or neutered dogs may not show with the exceptions of Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Exhibition Classes.
- Dogs with missing teeth will be excused from the ring
- Males will be judged first
- All dogs must be shown on a Fur-Saver collar (no nylon or pinch collars nor choke chains)
- Dogs are shown in natural stance; no hand stacking allowed. No food allowed in the ring; toys may be used at the judge's discretion. Double handling is encouraged.
- Any entry that does not meet the Class requirement will be invalid.
- When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry
- This is a German style Breed show
- The event is being held outdoors, rain or shine
- No dogs are allowed to be tied out at the show site or ringside
- No dogs are allowed to be crated near the ring
- Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them
- Adult classes will be moved long enough for the judge to evaluate the movement
- You should always receive confirmation to the shows you enter. CORK and RKNA are not responsible for lost or late postal deliveries or lost or misdirected electronic entries. It is the entrant's responsibility to check on entry status on or before the entry closing date if confirmation has not been received.
- *Your dog should know to show bite; sides, front and open wide.*
- *The dog must allow the judge to touch genitals and tail while standing.*

RKNA CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM

To attain the RKNA Championship title, a dog must achieve 5 total points. Points can be earned in the following ways:

- 1 point: V1 rating at any RKNA show
- 1 point: RKNA Best Male/Female
- 2 points: Ztp
- 2 points: IPO title

To attain the RKNA Elite Championship title, a dog must be a RKNA Champion and achieve an additional five (5)

Points. Points can be earned in the following ways:

- 1 point RKNA Best or Most Beautiful in Show
- 1 point RKNA Kombi-Sieger/in
- 2 points RKNA Sieger/in or RKNA Klub Sieger/in
- 2 points RKNA Gekört.
