Patrick Mudge



Patrick Mudge purchased his first purebred dog (a samoyed) in 1969, which sparked an obsession with all things related to the dog show world. As a teenager he spent as much time as possible at shows lurking around the handlers' setups waiting for an opportunity to take in that second place dog for Reserve! An early fascination with the Winterfold whippets of Martine Collings led to a lifetime of involvement with that wonderful breed. Since that time Patrick has owned several different breeds and has shown dogs(many owned by others) to group first in six of the 7 groups (all but herding) and to Best in Show. His most recent involvement (since 1997) has been with miniature poodles, co-owning Canada's Puppy of the Year for 1997 (BIS Can.Am/Ch Minstrel der Letzte Tanz, "Swayze") #1 mini and #4 Non-sporting dog for 1998 and #2 sire in the breed. Patrick has bred Group winning, BPIS and BISS winning mini poodles. A music educator by profession, teaching piano and voice, he has recently retired, with his partner Walter, to a small (266 acre) farm outside of Fredericton, NB.



Dianne Ivey Maralinga Perm. Regd.

I have been involved in breeding and showing dogs since 1982. I have bred, along with my husband Ray, under the Maralinga prefix which is permanently registered with the CKC. We have bred or owned a number of Australian Terrier Champions in conformation, one of which was BIS CH. Maralinga's Magic in Motion. Magic holds the record in Canada for 5 all breed Bests In Show for an Australian Terrier. Magic was the top Australian Terrier in Canada for 1986, 1987, and 1989. During the period of time we bred Australian Terriers, they placed consistently in the top five in Canadian Conformation.

In 1900, we became interested in the Norwich Terrier. Our very first Norwich came from Denmark and that was the beginning of our love affair with the Norwich Terriers. Since then, we have bred or owned numerous Norwich Terrier Champions and were in the top five conformation Norwich in Canada consistently when we were breeding.

We have put a Tracking Dog Excellent title on one of our male Norwich Terriers Can. Am. Ch Maralinga Mick McCool TDX. That was a great thrill for us. We also did obedience for a short while and put a CDX on an Australian Terrier.

I was a founding member of the Southwest Saskatchewan Kennel Club; a past member of the Alberta Kennel Club; a past member of the Australian Terrier Club of America; a past member of the Southern Alberta Canine Judges Study Group; a past member of the Norwich Club of England; and a past member of the B.C. Okanagan Canine Judges Study Group (a regional CDJA Study Group which now no longer operates in our area; a past member and treasurer of the North Okanagan Tracking Club.

Currently, I am a member of the Canadian Dog Judges Association and lifetime member of the Canadian Kennel Club. I continue to volunteer for my local Kennel Club when asked to ring steward.

I have judged in Scandinavian, Canada and the USA. I am licensed to judge all breeds.

Our breeding program was based on the challenges of both breed type, health while keeping the original purpose of the breed in the forefront of our breeding decisions. We retired from breeding in 2014. I have concentrated solely on conformation judging since 2014.

Susan Quesnel



After acquiring my first Siberian Husky in 1972, the first litter of Atim Reg.(perm) was whelped in 1975. My direction in this breed became sled dog racing and education in structure and commitment to form and function followed. I continued in the conformation ring and finished many champions that also competed with competitive racing teams.

In 1985 I added Belgian Tervuren bitch to our household. Over the next 10 years the beauty, Trainability and loyalty of the Belgian Shepherd became my focus . My breeding program with small Tervuren Kennel has produced National Specialty winners in the US and Canada , HIT obedience dogs, agility title holders and Herding Trial winners.

Not to be forgotten was my interest in Pomeranians and I have had several that completed their championships and lived out their lives as my valued companions.

While not breeding I am still active with my current Belgian in tracking and mentoring in my breed.

Shawn started in the world of purebred dogs as a junior handler showing his mom's English Setters back in 1980. As a teenager, he worked for some of Canada's most notable dog professionals at the time including Mark and Tad Dakin as well as Sonny and Bobbie Tougas. He was the Manitoba Provincial Junior Handling Championship winner three consecutive years.

Along with his daughter and wife, Shawn has bred and shown many English Setters to BIS, specialty wins, and top rankings in both Canada and USA.

Shawn has been judging since 2018, he has judged in Canada as well as USA at both all breed and specialty events. Currently he is licensed for all breeds in the Sporting Group, Hound Group, Working Group, and on permit for top half of the Herding Group.

Shawn lives in Winnipeg, Manitoba and has owned a printing, publishing, and graphic design company since 1994.

While he grew up with numerous dogs from an early age, his formal introduction to purebred show dogs started in his late twenties with a Doberman bitch that was to become the top winning Doberman during her time and foundation of his Aegis Kennel which continuously produced numerous champions over several generations. This once-in-a-lifetime bitch opened the doors for Fred to become a well-known breeder, trainer, and keen exhibitor of dogs that were strong in type and other important attributes as given in the breed standard for Dobes. He also bred champion whippets for a time until he decided to continue his contribution to the sport by becoming a judge.

A PCCI and FCI licensed all-breed judge, he obtained his first breed license in 2000 and his all-breed license in 2010.

He was a past president of the Philippine Doberman Federation. He was the founding president of the Cavite Canine Club, Inc. which still continues up to the present to be one of the most active clubs affiliated with the Philippine Canine Club, Inc., the national canine club of the Philippines.

Presently, he is a member of the Board of Directors of the PCCI where he serves as the Corporate Secretary, Chairman of the Corporate Planning and Publication Committees, Chairman of the newly established Grooming Committee and member of the Membership, Registration, and Judges Licensing Committees.

He recently authored the PCCI’s coffee table book, “60 Years of Purebred Dogs in the Philippines, the PCCI Legacy,” to celebrate PCCI’s 60th Anniversary.

He is the Philippine representative to the FCI Grooming Commission as well as FCI Education and Public Relations Commission.

I began exhibiting and breeding Gordon Setters in 1974 and then Afghan Hounds in 1976 under the kennel name “Madadhduh” (Gaelic for ‘black dog’). I bred on a very limited basis but was quite successful producing Gordon Setter and numerous Afghan Hound champions including Afghan Hound group winners and a multiple Best in Show and Best in Specialty Show winner. I started my judging career in 1993 and reached All Breed status in 2008. I have judged all breeds across Canada and the USA and have been honored to judge numerous breed and group specialties. I have also judged in Mexico, Japan, Columbia, Finland, Estonia, China and Australia.

Currently I share my heart and home with a Border Terrier and Cavaliers. We are active in agility, hoopers and scent work. I am a Life Member of the Canadian Kennel Club and have belonged to numerous breed clubs over the years. I am currently the Show Chair and President of the Ontario County Kennel Club and a member of Cavalier King Charles Spaniel Club of Canada, the Eastlake Cavalier Club and Durham Region Canine Athletes. 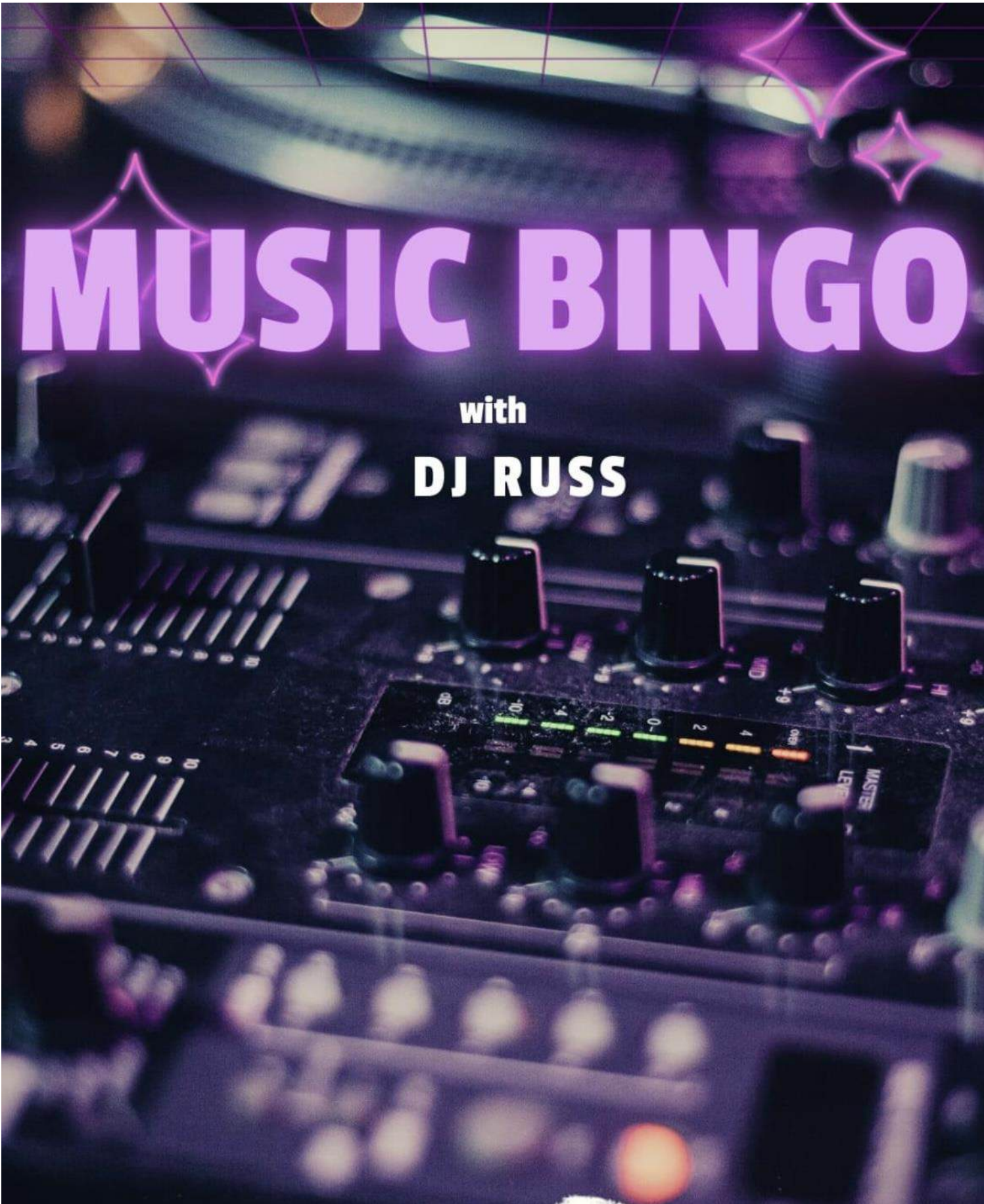

Junior Puppy - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

Senior Puppy- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 Month Class - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

Canadian Bred - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

Bred By Exhibitor - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

Open Class - shall be for all Dogs.

Specials Only - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded

CLASSIFICATION – OBEDIENCE

NOVICE “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its CDX Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

OPEN HA - The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.

Open18A -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Dow is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

OPEN HB - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the.

Open 18B – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises.

UTILITY A – For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

UTILITY B – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

PRE-NOVICE – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NOVICE C – as Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE - as Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

VETERANS (Unofficial class)– For any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. Exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice classes. Dogs entered in Veterans must also be entered in any regular class or exhibition only. Owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

Unofficial Classes

Non-Regular/Unofficial Obedience Classes

All Dogs Entered In A Non-Regular Class Must Also Be Entered In A Regular Class Or For Exhibition Only On The Same Day.

Novice C, and Veterans are not eligible for High in Trial

Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

2 **LIMITED ENTRY** Rally Ring size will be **40' x 60'**. The precincts of these trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.
Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.

The following classes will be offered in each Rally Obedience trial: Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B, Rally Master.

RALLY NOVICE A:

Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B:

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE:

The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes. (CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A:

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A:

This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign.

New- RALLY MASTER - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class..
A person may enter more than one dog in this class
All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

No handler who has exhibited a dog through its C.K.C.Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the A class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.

Refer to Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for further information.

All exhibitors must be familiar with Rally Rules and Regulations effective: January 1, 2018.

**The precincts of these trials are the rings and immediate area surrounding the rings of the show site.
Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.**

GENERAL RULES COVERING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above Shows and Trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The Show committee or employs of the club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the Show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this Rule has been violated.
4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds.
5. Dogs must be on the Grounds one hour before the judging of their Breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging.
6. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of Breed or Class Judging. No Ring shall be held up waiting Exhibitors or Handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute Handlers available so that judging will not be delayed.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these Shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the Entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship Show held under these Rules cannot again be shown at a Show held under these Rules until the dog has been examined by an Official Committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the Examining Committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the Exhibitors and the Spectators we insist upon keeping our Grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please Exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging Ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, NOT in the vicinity of the Ring areas.
11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry Fees will NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
13. The use of PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM will be kept to an absolute minimum. Therefore, IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE, when necessary. There will Be no paging for individual dogs.
14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS – SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information, may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- (a) Registered with the CKC
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number
- (c) Eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (d) If it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonored cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

BORDER CROSSING - A RABIES CERTIFICATE IS REQUIRED TO BRING A DOG INTO CANADA, GOVERNMENT REGULATIONS REQUIRE A CERTIFICATE AND IT MUST BE DATED AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY INTO CANADA.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs, instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$58.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)



CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

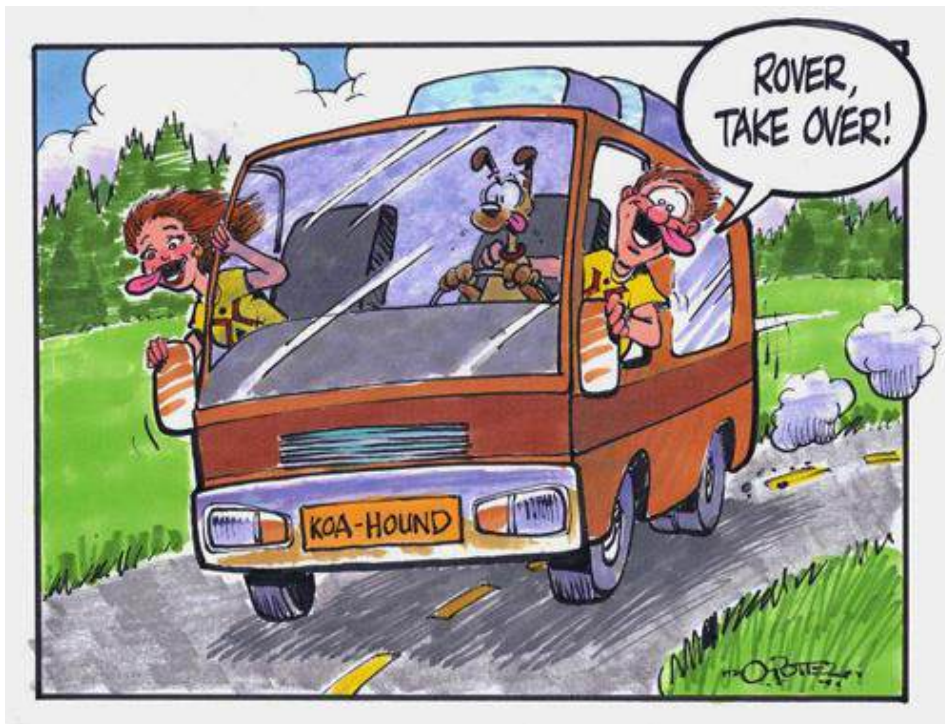

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the “CKC Dog Show Rules”, and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Skaha Kennel Club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance there to, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

Delays waiting for dogs are not possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their dogs “conflict”

Crates will be allowed at ringside during the judging of your specific breed only and they must be removed immediately after to avoid clutter.

Dogs are not allowed in washrooms.

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Violators will be asked to leave the show grounds.

The welfare of an exhibitor’s child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you will exercise control and restraint over the children in your care on the days of these shows.

The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/concessions.

The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.

You must leave your setup in the same clean condition you found it in when you first arrived at the show. The club may refuse entries from any persons.

ZERO TOLERANCE

Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Skaha Kennel Club or associated Specialty shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit.

Definition of Bullying: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.

Examples include: • insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits • spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo • berating/belittling an individual • unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others • giving insulting nicknames • engaging in practical jokes that humiliate • undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work • physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates • mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms • yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles

This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, Facebook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram During Dates of the events.

The Show Superintendent Or Show Officials May Eject Anyone From The Grounds And Ban Further Exhibition Of Dogs For Bullying, Indignities, Abuse, Physical Or Verbal To Anyone.
