Lunch breaks will be at the judge's discretion.

10 min/20 participants will be allowed for competitors to walk the course prior to trial except for Advanced and Excellent C and Team where the walkthrough is 3 minutes for 10-12 participants.

Please Note: Food or toys MUST be in the RIGHT-HAND POCKET of the handler, <u>OUT OF SIGHT</u> NO TREAT/BAIT BAGS. NO ACTIVE TOYS (clickers, laser, squeak toys, etc)

To keep the event running smoothly, all competitors will be expected to keep track of the running order and to be in the 'on deck' area prior to your run.

ALL DOGS COMPETING <u>MUST</u> BE REGISTERED WITH CARO TO COMPETE. REGISTRATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE AT http://www.canadianrallyo.ca AND MUST BE SUBMITTED TO CARO, NOT SENT IN WITH ENTRIES.

REGISTERING YOUR DOG WITH CARO IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY. YOU <u>MUST</u> SHOW YOUR DOG'S REGISTRATION CARD AT THE TRIAL.

CARO MEMBERS RECEIVE DISCOUNTED ENTRY FEES. MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AVAILABLE AT http://www.canadianrallyo.ca APPLICATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO CARO FOR PROCESSING. MEMBERSHIP NUMBER MUST BE INCLUDED ON TRIAL ENTRY FOR DISCOUNT.

FACILITIES

Indoors Saturday June 16th – all facilities available in-house or within five minutes driving time.

Saturday June 17th is an OUTDOOR facility 25 kms. south of Brandon. Bring your own seating, shade tent, etc. Washrooms and water will be provided.

Lunch will not be provided either day – please bring your lunch if you are staying all day and do not want to go out or return to Brandon. Fast food/full service restaurants, hotel/motel, camping, hospital, vet, etc. is available in Brandon.

All dogs must be crated, in an ex-pen, or on leash when not in the ring. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the trial grounds.

ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SUPERVISED BY A PARENT NOT COMPETING IN THE TRIALS.

ANYONE OBSERVED NOT PICKING UP AFTER THEIR DOG WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

ANYONE OBSERVED DISCIPLINING THEIR DOG IN A MANNER THAT OFFENDS A JUDGE'S SENSIBILITIES WILL BE EXCUSED AND WILL FORFEIT ENTRY FEES.

More hotels (Comfort Inn, Super 8, Redwood Inn, Rodeway Inn) are located at the north end of Brandon on Hwys. #1 and #10 approx. 10 minutes further. Most have Pet Fees and they vary widely - check in advance.

WEATHER

This is an outdoor trial, and it's in MANITOBA (weather unpredictable). In case of severe weather, we will attempt to wait it out and delay the trial however, the trial will proceed rain or shine. No refunds will be given due to inclement weather. This is also the Brandon Hills and tick central. Check your dog for ticks every evening.

TRIAL INFORMATION

Trial held under CARO rules and regulations. CARO recognized and approved. Members in good standing with CARO will have discounted entries. See entry form.

AWARDS

Blue Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog/handler team achieving a score of 170 or better (180 or better in Team and 190 or better in C stream).

DIRECTIONS TO OUTDOOR TRIAL SITE (Sunday 17th)

On Sunday the trial will be held at Two Brown Dogs Canine Consultants outdoor training site south of Brandon, MB.

Turn SOUTH off #1 Trans-Canada on #10 Hwy. (18th Street). Continue south through Brandon 18 kms. past the Zeller's Mall to Tower Rd. Turn left (EAST) and travel 4 kms (2 ½) miles. We are the last drive on the left side of the road and it will be well marked.
