No post dated cheques accepted. All NSF cheques will be subject to a charge of \$20.00. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.



Entries must be submitted by mail, hand delivered or via the Entry Line. No other entry service is authorized to take entries for these events.

Please Note: Credit Card payments/Fax Entries accepted ONLY through THE ENTRY LINE.

Important Note Regarding Emails & Faxes: It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission, either email, facsimile, or any document transmitted electronically, reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules and

Regulation. Sent fax receipts, and/or , copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients. NOTE: All entries paid by credit card MUST be sent via The Entry Line. The Evangeline Kennel Club does note accept credit cards for payment.

Attention Foreign exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - * Effective March 2, 2020

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN).

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number.

Dogs may still enter CKC events until without a registration number or ERN until March 2, 2020 by marking TCN on the entry form (or Listed if it is an older entry form). An email address is required on the entry form in this case. Before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab called TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

* If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. The CKC will update its records accordingly.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN)

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40 plus tax. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide us with your full return address. - Faxed requests will be accepted. Please include your VISA/MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibits this or presents a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension. Please forward your request to:

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line.) The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder):

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: We are fortunate to have permission to use this site for our shows and trials. To help us retain this location

Please keep grooming inside the boards of the rink. No dogs, grooming, crates, ringside tables, etc will be allowed in the side boxes, (Penalty box , etc.)

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- 1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time. Moving class dogs to specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex many be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
- 3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
- 4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
- 5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show/trials Secretary after the closing date and time.
- 6. Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the CKC may compete in these shows. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 7. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close.
- 8. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Evangeline Kennel Club, its officers and associates, will use due care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- The Superintendent will be in complete charge of these shows and trials.
- Handlers and exhibitors with several breeds must arrange for alternative handlers should judging times of different breeds conflict.
- Due to the limited amount of space, the Superintendent may be required to control the number of and/or area taken up by x-pens. All exhibitors are required to co-operate with the Superintendent in this regard.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club
 official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to
 indignities. TheConformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any
 infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take
 such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See
 Section 19.7)
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is called to be judged.
- All exhibitors should review Section 4.1-Judges-General, sub sections 4.1.3, 4.1.4 & 4.1.5 of the CKC Conformation Rules and Regulations.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the EKC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- Only dogs entered in the Shows & Trials will be permitted in the building.
- Only a dog individually registered, or eligible to be registered, in the stud book of the Canadian Kennel Club may compete in these shows and trials.
- SHOW PRECINCTS The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers.
