ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. AWARD OF MERITS may be awarded at the Judge's discretion. For every 10 dogs competing at the breed level there is 1 AOM available. Select Dog and Select Bitch may, or may not be considered for these AOM.

Rosettes will be offered for: Class placements 2ND, 3RD, 4TH IN EACH CLASS and PARADE OF VETERANS.

Veteran Parade: Veterans entered in the Specialty can enter the Parade of Veterans without an additional fee. Veterans NOT entered in a class at the Conformation Specialty can enter as FEO. Veterans only entered in obedience must enter the Conformation specialty FEO. There is no additional fee to enter Parade of Veterans.

DPCC Obedience: Trophies and Rosettes are awarded for the following:
HIGH IN TRIAL, HIGHEST QUALIFYING SCORE IN EACH CLASS – Novice A/B/C, Intermediate Novice, Open A/B, Utility A/B, Brace, Veterans and Team. Class placements 2nd to 4th will receive a rosette.

DPCC Rally: Trophies and Rosettes are awarded for the following:
HIGHEST QUALIFYING SCORE IN EACH CLASS – Novice A/B, Intermediate, Advanced A/B, Excellent A/B and Team. Class placements 2nd to 4th will receive a rosette. A HIGHEST OVERALL QUALIFYING SCORE – Trophy & Rosette will be awarded to the dog with the highest score. In the event of a tie, the class of higher difficulty will receive the prize

Agility

The Alberta Doberman Pinscher Club is pleased to offer trophies and rosettes to the Highest Scoring Doberman in both the Standard and Jumpers with Weaves Classes (both regular and select) in the Alberta Kennel Club Agility Trial 4 Saturday, July 30, 2016. A rosette will be awarded to Highest Scoring Doberman overall from these classes. In the event of a scoring tie for HQS the award will be presented to the Doberman competing in the class containing the higher degree of difficulty.

Perpetual Awards

DPCC Best of Breed: Troll Arabesque/Vintage Year: The Troll Arabesque/Vintage Year Memorial Trophy is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada for Best in Specialty. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. A keeper trophy will be awarded to the winner.

DPCC High In Trial Trophy: The High In Trial Trophy is offered each year by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada for High In Trial. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name will be inscribed on the plaque. A keeper trophy will be awarded to the winner.

ADPC Best of Breed Trophy: is offered each year by the Alberta Doberman Pinscher Club for Best in Specialty. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name is inscribed on the plaque, there is no keeper trophy.

Gary Page Memorial Trophy: is offered each year by the Alberta Doberman Pinscher Club for Best Puppy in Specialty. This is a perpetual trophy and the winner's name is inscribed on the plaque. There is no keeper trophy.

NOTE: The person handling the exhibit in the ring shall be recognized as the agent of the owner, and delivery of any prize won to the handler of the winning dog shall constitute full delivery of the prize to the rightful owner.

JUVENILE / VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The winners of each class will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in both Sweepstakes.

20% of the total entry fees for both Sweepstakes will be retained by the Doberman Pinscher Club of Canada to defray costs. The remaining 80% shall be divided as follows:

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs <u>owned and handled in the ring by the breeder</u> for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERAN CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed/neutered.
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades.</u>
PARADE OF VETERANS (DPPC National ONLY)	Dogs must be 7 years of age or older. <u>Please supply a short biography of 50 words or less for each dog entered in the Parade. This should be provided to the Catalogue chair at time entries close.</u> Contact Rachel Jesse rachel@dogalog.ca
BABY PUPPY	dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. <u>These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points.</u>
BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.
ALTERED	Open to dogs who have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

ERRORS IN ENTRIES

An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. **The fee is \$59.40 + 5% GST.**
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter

back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
4. "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION – Conformation & Obedience

Jr. Obedience Friday – Conformation Saturday following Specialty

ATTENTION: CKC JUNIOR HANDLING RULES – EFFECTIVE JAN. 1, 2016.

Section 3.4.1 - “Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked.”

Classes Offered

Conformation: Junior Novice / Intermediate Novice /
Senior Novice / Junior Open / Intermediate Open / Senior Open.

Age Structure: Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

Obedience

Junior Obedience Pre-Novice This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

Intermediate Obedience Pre-Novice This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

Senior Obedience Pre-Novice This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

Junior Obedience Novice This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

Intermediate Obedience Novice This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

Senior Obedience Novice This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

Junior Obedience Open This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday.

Intermediate Obedience Open This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday.

Senior Obedience Open This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday. 9.2 Any dog may be used at the Pre-Novice, or Novice level including those with any Obedience titles.
