#### **CKC Non-Member Participation Fee**

### ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require</u> an <u>ERN - Event Registration Number</u>. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$59.40 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. #### Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

• To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter

back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure</u> <u>Travel Document</u>.

• Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.

#### GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.30 per copy + 13% Ontario HST.
- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All
  rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this
  specialty.

#### ATTENTION: CKC JUNIOR HANDLING RULES - EFFECTIVE JAN. 1, 2016.

Section 3.4.1 - "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handler Number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

Age Structure: Junior (7-11 years), Senior (12-18 years).

**Junior Obedience Pre-Novice** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

**Intermediate Obedience Pre-Novice** This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

Senior Obedience Pre-Novice This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have not achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition.

**Junior Obedience Novice** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

**Intermediate Obedience Novice** This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

Senior Obedience Novice This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday who have achieved 500 score points in any Pre-Novice competition or for any junior of relevant age who wishes to compete in this class.

**Junior Obedience Open** This class is for handlers 7 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 11th birthday.

Intermediate Obedience Open This class is for handlers 11 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 15th birthday.

Senior Obedience Open This class is for handlers 15 years of age on the date of the competition up to the date of their 18th birthday. 9.2 Any dog may be used at the Pre-Novice, or Novice level including those with any Obedience titles.

A dog used at the Open level must have a CD title (either CKC and/or AKC).

#### Entry Fee: \$2.00 payable at registration.

Entries must be received one hour prior to posted start time of Specialty and/or Trial. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the show/trial on that day. The Doberman Pinscher Club of
