It will be the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that any electronic submission reaches the proper authority or recipient, within the times and limits as regulated for each document in the CKC Rules & regulations. Sent fax receipts, and/or, copies of sent emails, will not be taken as evidence of receipt by recipients.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number. In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Attention USA exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to fluctuating currency rates, cheques in US Funds will not be accepted.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

REGULAR CLASSES

The following CKC classes, divided by sex, will be provided. Enter one category only per entry form.

Junior Puppy	a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show.
Senior Puppy	a dog between 9 months up to 12 months on the day of show
12-18 Months	a dog between 12 months up to 18months on the day of show
Canadian Bred	a dog which was born in Canada.
Bred by Exhibitor	a dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open	all dogs
Veterans	all dogs 7 years of age or older. Dogs may be neutered.
Specials Only	dogs who are Canadian champions only
Exhibition	dogs 3 months and over, not in competition
Altered	dogs 6 months & over that have been sexually altered

Note: Awards of Merit will be made (if warranted) at the rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed to a maximum of 4. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed..

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

Dogs entered in Non-Regular Classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only, or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class - shall be for Stud Dog and two of his Get only

Brood Bitch Class - shall be for Brood Bitch and two of her progeny only

Note: All Non-Regular Class judging will follow immediately after Best of Breed. Please be sure to mark non-regular classes entered on your regular entry form.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweeps shall be for any dog 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be six classes in all, divided by sex.

Junior Class for Dogs at least 6 months of age up to but not including 9 months.

Senior Class for Dogs at least 9 months of age up to but not including 12 months.

12-18 Open for Dogs at least 12 months of age up to but not including 18 months.

For Puppy Sweepstakes the winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Puppy Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Puppy Sweepstakes

VETERANS SWEEPSTAKES

Veterans Sweeps shall be for any dog 7 years of age and up. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes, Specials or Exhibition Only. There will be four classes in all, divided by sex.

7-9 years for Dogs at least 7 years of age up to but not including 9 years

9-12 years for Dogs at least 9 years of age up to but not including 12 years

Over 12 years for Dogs 12 years of age and older.

For Veteran Sweepstakes the winners of all six classes will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veteran Sweepstakes

A rosette will be awarded to first, second, third and fourth places in each class as well as to Best in Sweeps and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweeps. A suitable prize will also be offered to Best in Sweeps and Best Opposite in Sweeps.

For both Puppy and Veterans Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

Class winner - 50% of the total entry fees for their class;

Best in Sweeps - 15% of the total sweepstakes entry fees;

Best Opposite Sex in Sweeps - 10% of the total sweepstakes entry fees

25% will be retained for administrative purposes.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN number simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, e.g., AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount of \$57.60 (plus GST or HST where applicable) payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide us with your full return address to enable the ERN number to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA / MasterCard number, expiry date, cardholder's name and signature.

This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "Listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

1. All entries are to be sent to the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY.
2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by proper entry fees and forms.
3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and Handlers please note that full name and address of owners must be filled in.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom entries were made.
5. To comply with CKC regulations, we will be unable to accept or substitute any entry reaching the show / trials secretary after the closing date and time.
6. Only dogs eligible for CKC registration may enter this show. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
7. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provisions of Ch. 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary **IN WRITING at least one hour prior** to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler.
8. **NOTE:** Please complete a **separate entry form for each class** that an individual dog is entered

SECTION 1 - A dog awarded Winners at a championship show held under these Dogs Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of shows, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- **All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show grounds and surrounding areas for their own dogs or dogs they are handling and must use the designated areas.**
- Dogs should be in the building 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have their dog at ringside when it is scheduled.
- The KCC and Exhibition Park will not be held responsible for any equipment left in the building overnight.
- A canteen will be available in the arena.
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- No dogs will be allowed in the building overnight
- The Keeshond Club of Canada will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible in the event of an accident to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- "Puppy for Sale" or "Dog for Sale" signs will not be permitted in the building.
- The precincts of the show shall be the entire building and its entrances.
