NEW FOR THIS SHOW

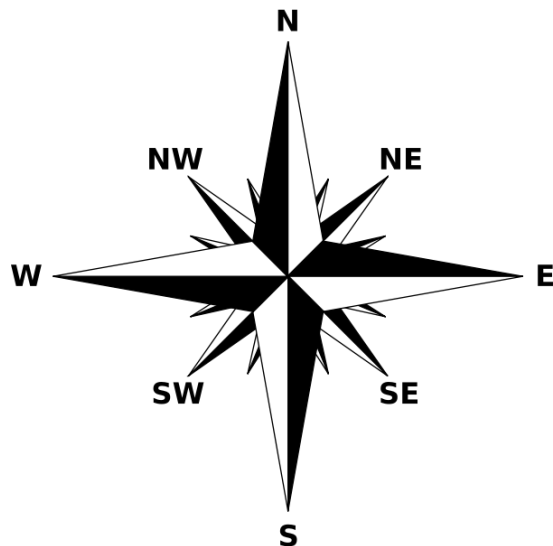
The Fire Marshall and EMS have determined that the parking area SOUTH and WEST of the main arena at the Camrose Regional Exhibition is too crowded for Emergency Vehicles to get through if there was an emergency. Therefore, for this show and in the foreseeable future, exhibitor and public parking and camping will NOT be allowed in the area SOUTH and WEST of the arena. The area will be fenced and you will be towed if you're in there without a pass.

Parking and camping will all occur in the NORTH parking lot. A camping area will be designated. Spots will be 25' wide. There will be no power for camping so bring a generator. The CRE campground, a couple blocks west of the north parking lot will be open with power hookups only.

The ring setup will remain the same as before. You will be allowed to unload on Thursday night in the restricted area along the SOUTH and WEST side of the building. You will also be allowed to load in the restricted area on the SOUTH and WEST side of the building after 3 PM on Sunday. Make sure there is a wide roadway when you are loading and unloading.

The performance area will remain unchanged, but you will have to park in the NORTH parking lot.

There will be an area for day benching in the NORTH lobby. All equipment must be removed each night.

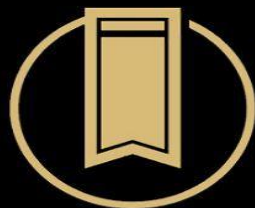

CLASSES OFFERED



CONFORMATION:

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY - 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

12 – 18 MONTH CLASS 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for “Specials Only” and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be canceled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT Allowed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

VETERAN CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

BRACE CLASS - This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex).

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

A service charge of 10% will be assessed. This includes entries sent online or post using a credit card or Interac for payment.

OBEDIENCE

PRE-NOVICE – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NOVICE “A” - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its CDX. Title in Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE “B” - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

NOVICE “C” – as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE - as per Obedience Trial Rules & Regulation

OPEN “HA”- The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.

OPEN “18A” -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

OPEN “HB” - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes .

OPEN “18B” – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes

UTILITY “A” – For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

UTILITY “B” – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

VETERANS (Unofficial class)– For any dog that has earned the title of C.D. or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial. Exercises shall be performed and judged as in the Novice classes. Dogs entered in Veterans must also be entered in any regular class or exhibition only. Owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.

BRACE CLASS(Unofficial class) The Brace class is open to any two dogs that have earned the title of CD or higher. It is not necessary that the same person owns both dogs, nor that they be the same breed, except when entered in a breed-specialty obedience trial. The owner or any other person may handle a brace in this class. A person may enter more than one brace in this class. The Brace class is performed and judged in the same manner as the Novice class. The two dogs shall be hitched together with a brace chain or coupling and are judged on the performance of the two dogs as though they were one.



RALLY OBEDIENCE

RALLY NOVICE A: Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B: Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE: The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A: This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A: This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign

RALLY MASTER: This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class.. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

*All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

*No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

*No handler who has exhibited a dog through its C.K.C. Obedience CDX title shall be eligible to enter the 'A' class in Rally Novice, Advanced or Excellent.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION

A description of all *Conformation, Obedience and Rally Classes* and *Rule and Regulations* can be found at www.ckc.ca

1. This show is held INDOORS at the **Camrose Regional Exhibition Grounds (4250 Exhibition Drive, Camrose, Alberta)**
2. This is an UNLIMITED entry Conformation dog show. Performance shows entry limited to the timing restrictions of each judge.
3. DAY OF TRIAL ENTRIES are not permitted at this show. All entries must be in the Show Secretary's hands by the closing date on the front page of this Premium List.
4. MIXED BREEDS are allowed in the performance events with CCN.
5. RALLY-OBEDIENCE will be held in a **40' x 55' Ring**. The Precincts of the Rally trials are the ring and immediate area surrounding the ring. Only dogs entered in the trials are permitted within the Precincts of the Rally trials.
6. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to INDIGNITIES. The Conformation Show or Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (19.7 CKC Conformation Show and 20.7 CKC Obedience and Rally-Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations.)
7. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by an act of the event club or because it has been entered incorrectly, except as provided in 8 below. Nor will entry fees be refunded if due to riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the BRCA, that make it impossible to open or complete the show. **See COVID ERA Rules for Special Circumstances.**
8. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED INTO THE OBEDIENCE OR RALLY SHOW COMES INTO SEASON within 10 days of the show. A veterinary letter certifying that the bitch came into season within 10 days prior to the show must be delivered to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of that trial's judging.
9. NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:
 - a) An annual non-member fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
 - b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or pay the non-member fee.
 - c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-members of the CKC.
10. The show building will be OPEN at 6:30 a.m. on Friday before the show. Booths may set-up after 1 p.m. Thursday.
11. The Camrose Regional Exhibition will LOCK the doors at 10 p.m. each night of the show and OPEN the doors at 6:30 a.m. each morning. CRE staff will patrol the building overnight but will not be responsible for any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons or their property.
12. All EMPTY rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour before the show and during the show.
13. Entries will be ACKNOWLEDGED after the closing date. Judging schedule and receipts available online or by mail.
14. Dogs must be EXERCISED in designated areas only. If you exercise outside you must clean up after your dog.
15. All dogs in the show building must either be REGISTERED in the show or "IN TRANSIT".

16. All entries must be CLEARLY filled out. The BRCA or the Show Secretary will not correct incorrect entries.
17. SIGNS advertising puppies or other services will not be permitted in the benching area or around the rings
18. BRCA has a ZERO tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with BRCA Shows, including spectators.

COVID ERA RULES

Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not abiding by the Alberta Government Covid-19 protocols.

1. At the time the Premium List was sent out, most of the COVID restrictions were removed. If they are reinstated in any form the following may apply. Additional rules may also be required. Notice will be sent out in the judging schedule.
2. **REFUND POLICY:** If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Camrose or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies or directives, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be considered. In the event of any refunds; credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded.
3. WRISTBANDS may be required at all times while in the building.
4. Hand sanitizing stations may be provided in the building.
5. Violation of any rule may result in your entries for the weekend being canceled with NO refund of entries.
6. The concession will not be operating. Food trucks may be available in the parking lot.
7. The building will be CLEANED each night and anything left behind will be removed. Tables and other touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly throughout the day. There may be limited chairs at ringside.
8. If you are sick, please stay home and get a handler for your dogs.
9. There will be a PHOTOGRAPHER at this show. Judges are NOT required to take photos with you.



CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Points Awarded	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

15.1.9 A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

15.1.10 Permission shall be granted to a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

15.1.11 A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

15.1.13 The Board interprets the words “earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges” to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge’s awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.
