Day of Trial entries will be accepted up to one hour before the scheduled start of each trial.

Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds with a Canine Companion Number (CCN) are permitted to enter these trials.

These events are being held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

The trial precinct shall consist of all areas inside Torbay Common as well as the parking lot.

Fee Structure

Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Pre-Entry) - \$35.00
Entry Fee for Second Class, Same Dog, Same Trial - \$25.00*
Entry Fee per Dog per Class (Day of Trial) - \$45.00
Listing Fee (TCN) per Dog per Class - \$11.50
Exhibition Only per Dog per Day (Pre-Entry) - \$15.00
Exhibition Only per Dog per Day (Day of Trial) - \$25.00
Junior Obedience - \$5.00

Catalog (Pre-Entry) - Free (One per Handler)

* This discount is for dogs who are entered in two classes in the same trial (Rally Advanced B & Excellent B, Rally Excellent B & Master, or Open B & Utility B Obedience only.) Pre-Entry only. Classes must be entered and paid for at the same time.

There will be no refunds for withdrawn entries after the closing date except in the case of a female in season. When a female comes into season after entries have closed, she may be withdrawn from the trial and refunded providing the Trial Secretary receives, on or before the date of the trial, a veterinarian's certificate declaring that the female was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial.

There will be a veterinarian on call throughout all shows via the Veterinary Specialty Center at 709- 221-7838.

All exhibitors are required to clean up after their dogs. Clean up bags and garbage bins are available for this purpose throughout the trial site. There continues to be those who do not take responsibility for their dogs, jeopardizing the club's access to this venue. For this reason, exhibitors who permit a dog to soil on the trial grounds without cleaning up will be denied entry to NKC shows and trials for one full calendar year.
