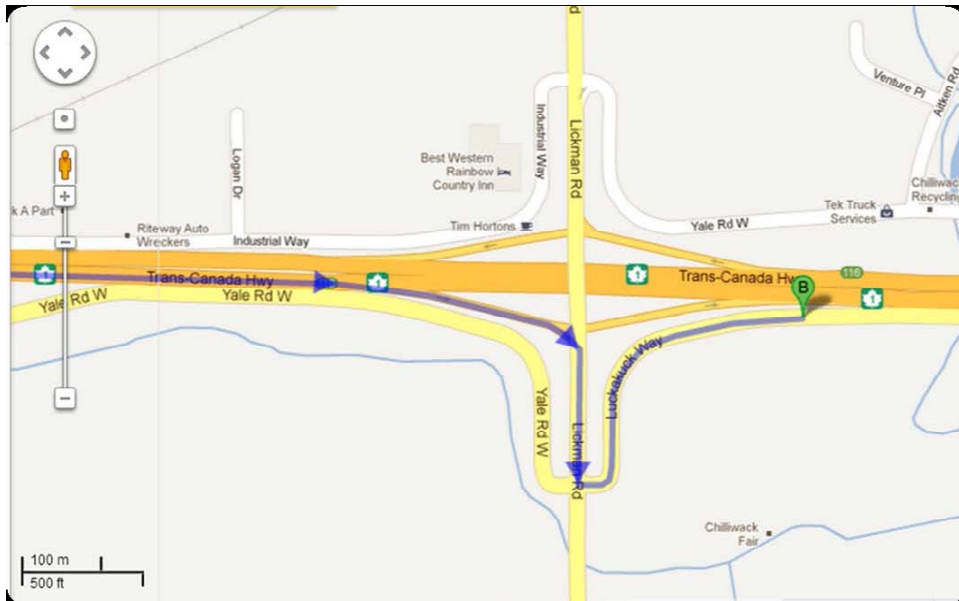

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. THE CLUB RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY PERSON FROM THE SHOW. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT SHALL HAVE FULL CONTROL OF THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS, WHICH WILL BE GOVERNED BY CKC RULES.
2. A DOG EXCUSED BY THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT OR VETERINARIAN FOR ANY REASON SHALL NOT, COMPETE IN ANY CLASS FOR ANY AWARDS FOR BALANCE OF THE SHOW.
3. THE SHOW COMMITTEE WILL USE DUE CARE AND DILIGENCE FOR THE WELFARE OF DOGS AND EXHIBITORS, BUT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR, OR ASSUME ANY LIABILITY IN THE EVENT OF ACCIDENT OR MISFORTUNE TO EITHER DOGS, EXHIBITORS, SPECTATORS OR VENDORS.
4. DOGS MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS 1 HOUR PRIOR TO THE JUDGING OF THEIR BREED.
5. THE OWNER OF A DOG ENTERED IN THESE SHOWS IS ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ERROR IN ENTERING HIS/HER DOG REGARDLESS OF HOW OR BY WHOM ENTRY IS MADE
6. EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR DOGS AND EQUIPMENT LEFT AT THE SHOW GROUNDS.
7. DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY, NOT IN VICINITY OF RINGS
8. ALL RECREATIONAL UNITS WILL HAVE BUCKETS UNDERNEATH FOR THEIR SINK DRAINS. ANYONE FOUND DISCHARGING WATER ON THE GROUNDS WILL BE REMOVED BY ORDER OF THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FINE.
9. IF, BECAUSE OF CIVIL DISTURBANCE OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE CLUB, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR COMPLETE THE SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY.
10. DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES ON THE SHOW GROUNDS OR WITHIN THE SHOW BUILDING WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE OBEDIENCE RINGS.

ALL EXHIBITORS, HANDLERS AND PATRONS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW AND ABIDE BY THE CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows;

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	1	2	3	4	5	

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall **NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; (2) a two point win awarded either at the breed or group level; and (3) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN)

PUPPY & JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The Sweepstakes classes are open to all dogs from 6 months to under 12 months regardless of their place of birth. Dogs MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty. A rosette and 5% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. A Rosette and 25% of class fees collected will be awarded to First Place in each class. A Rosette and 20% of class fees collected will be awarded to Second Place in each class. A Rosette and 10% of class fees collected will be awarded to Third Place in each class. A Rosette and 5% of class fees collected will be awarded to Fourth Place in each class.

Classes (divided by sex ONLY) offered as follows:

- 6 to 9 months Male/Female
- 9 to 12 months Male/Female
- 12 to 18 months Male/Female

25% of all Sweepstakes money collected retained by Club to defray costs.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over. Dogs MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty. Dogs may be spayed or neutered provided they are entered in the Veteran (competitive) class or for Exhibition Only. Classes will be divided by sex as follows:

- 7 to 10 years Male/Female
- 10 years & over Male/Female

A rosette and 30% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best in Sweepstakes, a Rosette and 25% of total fees collected will be awarded to Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. A Rosette and 5% of total fees collected will be awarded to First Place in each class. A Rosette will be awarded for Second through Fourth Place in each class.

25% of all Sweepstakes money collected retained by Club to defray costs

(Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). *This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of obtaining points at a CKC event to avoid cancellation.* Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$55.85 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.)

IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Non Member Participation Fee

(April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
 - The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
 - In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee.
- Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOW RULES

CHAPTER 6.3.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 13 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 2.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

(a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed

(b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration

(c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$8.70 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 1.2, 1.3:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 7.2:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 16 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16, Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

CHAPTER 18 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

Transition Obedience Classes

PRE-NOVICE – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

BABY PUPPY CLASS –This class shall be for any dog **3 months of age and under 6 months of age** on the day of the show

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **6 months of age and under 9 months of age** on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog **9 months of age and under 12 months of age** on the day of the show

12 TO 18 MONTHS: Shall be for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Specialty.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.
(Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs (divided by coat variety i.e. Groenendael, Malinois, Tervuren, Laeken)

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

Note: Any dog entered in a Unofficial/Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only.

SIRE & GET: Shall be for Sire and three maximum of his Get.

BROOD MATRON & PROGENY: Shall be for Dam and three maximum of her Progeny.

BRACE CLASS: Shall be for two dogs (not necessarily the same sex), **MUST** be identical ownership

REGULAR CLASSES

VETERANS CLASS: Shall be for all dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the Specialty. The winners of the Veteran Male and Female classes will NOT compete for Championship points but goes directly into the Best of Breed competition.

SPAYED OR NEUTERED DOGS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION IN THIS CLASS.

Obedience Classifications

***NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH NOVICE "A" & NOVICE "B" @ THE SAME TRIAL
NO DOG MAY BE ENTERED IN BOTH OPEN "A" & OPEN "B" @ THE SAME TRIAL***

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor ***MUST BE THE OWNER*** or ***A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY*** and ***MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.*** No person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "CDX" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but ***MUST COMPETE IN NOVICE B*** This class is open to all dogs, which have not earned the title of "CD", and may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog may not necessarily be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. **One dog ONLY may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.** The exhibitor ***MUST BE THE OWNER*** or ***A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY*** and ***MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES.*** No person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but ***MUST COMPETE IN THE OPEN "B" CLASS.*** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs, which have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog ***MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS.*** A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class..This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins. Prior to the start of the class.

NON-REGULAR/UNOFFICIAL OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY ON THE SAME DAY.

BRACE CLASS - This class is open to any two dogs of the breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. Same person need not own both dogs.

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs that have an obedience title and are 7 years old prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MAY NOT BE ENTERED IN ANY REGULAR CLASS, BUT MUST BE ENTERED FOR EXHIBITION ONLY.

NON-REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES

ALL DOGS ENTERED IN A NON-REGULAR CLASS MUST ALSO BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS ON THE SAME DAY, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF VETERANS OBEDIENCE.

GRADUATE NOVICE CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have not gained a qualifying score toward the "CDX" title in Canada BUT that has obtained the title "CD" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

GRADUATE OPEN CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have not obtained a qualifying score toward the "UD title in Canada BUT which has obtained the title "CDX" in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

VERSATILITY CLASS - This class is open to all dogs that have attained the title of "CDX" in Canada and at least 1 leg on the Utility title, or that has obtained the "UD" title in Canada prior to the closing of entries.

BRACE CLASS - This class is open to any two dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own both dogs.

TEAM CLASS - This class is open to any four dogs of the same breed and of either sex, which have attained not less than a "CD" title in Canada. The same person NEED NOT own all four dogs.

VETERANS CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs that have an Obedience title and that are at least 7 years of age prior to the closing of entries. The exercises shall be performed and judged as in the "Novice Class".

NOTE: DOGS ENTERED IN THE VETERANS CLASS MAY BE ENTERED IN ANY OF THE REGULAR OBEDIENCE CLASSES.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
