DIRECTIONS TO SITE

Take Hwy 2, at exit 297, Nevers Road, turn past the Irving Big Stop. Go to the end of the road and turn right onto Waasis Rd. Go 1.3 km's and turn left onto Rusagonis Road. Go apx 3.5 km's and turn left onto Sunpoke Road. Go 3.5 km's and turn right onto Dewitt Road. #91 is apx 1 km on the left hand side.

Release and indemnification of Landowners

By entering this Test, each participant agrees to assume all risks and hazards incidental to participation in the test and agrees to release, save harmless and indemnify the owner(s) of any property upon which the test is held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, costs, expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participant's use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant, or his heirs, his executors and assigns.

CKC Rules and Regulations

It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at the hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles. Canadian non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles.
