From Toronto, Ottawa, Montreal
Follow Highway 401 West to Interchange 278 at Kitchener.
Follow Highway 8 West through Kitchener onto Highway 7 & 8 to Stratford
Highway 7 & 8 becomes Ontario Street.
The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection
of Ontario Street and Road 111.

From Chicago, Detroit and Highway 401

Cross into Canada at Detroit/Windsor.
Follow Highway 401 East to Exit 222 **
Follow Road 6 North to Stratford.
Highway 6 becomes Highway 113 after it crosses Perth-Oxford Road.
Continue on Highway 113 North to Highway 7
Follow Highway 7 East
Highway 7 joins with Highway 8 and becomes Ontario Street.
The Festival Inn is located at 1144 Ontario Street, near the intersection
of Ontario Street and Road 111.

Alternatively: Take Exit 218 at Ingersoll instead of Exit 222.
Follow Highway 119 North through Ingersoll to Highway 7 East to

POLICY CONT'D**

3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
4. Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
5. All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.

SPECIALTY CONFORMATION CLASSES – BOTH SEXES

JUNIOR PUPPY – a dog between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show.

SENIOR PUPPY – a dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12 – 18 MONTHS – a dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

CANADIAN BRED – a dog which is born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – for all dogs.

VETERANS CLASS (classes split by ages: (7-10 yrs & 10-13 yrs, 13 yrs+)) – for all dogs over seven years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs to compete for the regular placements and the 1st place Dog and Bitch from each age split class will go on to compete for Best of Breed. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

WORKING - for dogs that have attained a CKC title of Earthdog. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the first place Male/Female from this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. Dogs competing in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY – dogs who are Canadian Champions only.

AWARD OF MERIT – At the judge's discretion, Awards of Merit may be awarded up to one Award for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. Rosettes will be given for the Awards of Merit which will be presented following Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

BABY PUPPY CLASS – Dogs 3 months of and under 6 months on the day of the show. Both male and female Baby Puppies will be judged prior to the judging of other official classes. Puppies in this category may not compete in any official, unofficial or non-regular classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades.

STUD DOG & GET – Entry comprises the Stud Dog and two only of his Get. Stud Dog must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Entry comprises the Brood Bitch and two only of her Progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

**MOVING CLASS
DOGS TO
SPECIALS**

Chapter 8, Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. Every day of a 2 or 3 day show is a separate show. Please note that this rule is effective up to one hour prior to the opening of the show, NOT one hour prior to the judging of the breed.

**CONFORMATION
SHOW
RULES AND
REGULATIONS**

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Chapter 4- Section 4.7.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

NATIONAL SPECIALTY TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Through the generosity of friends and members, Border Terrier Canada is pleased to offer prizes and rosettes for the following: **Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Best Puppy in Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Veteran, Best Opposite Sex Veteran, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Working Dog, Working Bitch. Best Baby Puppy and all class winners in the regular and non-regular classes.**

Award of Merit: At the judge's discretion, a prize and rosette may be offered for every ten dogs competing at the Best of Breed level.

Prizes will be awarded to every Border Terrier qualifying at any level in either test in Oxford Dog Sports Barn Hunt, at Princeton, Ontario on July 8 & 9, 2017.

THE ANNA FRASER MEMORIAL AWARD

The Anna Fraser Memorial Award is offered for the Best Working in Specialty in memory of founding member J. Anna Fraser for whom "essentially a working terrier" were more than just words in the standard.

To honour her passion, in 2016, friends of Anna donated 5 exquisite mugs made by her favourite Nova Scotia artisan, Deb Kuzyk of Lucky Rabbit Pottery, to be awarded at the next five Border Terrier Canada Specialties to Best Working.

This year, in recognition of the importance of those words in our standard, the Working Class will be an official class. This means that the winners of Working Dog and Working Bitch will compete for Best in Specialty along with the Specials, Veteran Winners, Winners Dog and Winners Bitch

Following Best in Specialty, the winners of the Working Dog and Working Bitch classes will return to the ring to compete for Best Working unless it is automatic.

Because it is an official class, to be eligible dogs must hold a CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) Earthdog Title. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs may compete as long as they hold a qualifying title.

A very limited number of catalogues will be available at the show at a cost of \$15.00 each. Catalogues will not be mailed to absent exhibitors or those who fail to pick up their pre-ordered ones during the show.

BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future:

Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors.

1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).
2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
3. Membership in the BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

Damages shall be defined as:

1. Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
3. Any verified complaint by a BTC member.

BTC Room Regulations:

1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
2. Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.

SPECIALTY SITE AND HOST HOTEL

Our site for the 2017 Specialty is the Festival Inn, 1144 Ontario Street, Stratford, ON, Canada, N5A 6Z3

The property on which the hotel sits is quite expansive and leaves us with lots of room for all our vehicles and RVs.

The area where the ring set-up would be is behind the Courtyard building which consists of 3 single storey buildings where you would drive up to your room, park & unload.

Pop-ups can be set up on grass behind Unit 3 of the Courtyard so the dogs can be kept shaded but still be part of the activities.

The Room rate in the Courtyard is \$135 per night plus taxes, that includes breakfast and pet fees.

It is possible for any one of our party to book any room throughout the hotel. There are rooms in the Main Building, North Wing and Annex. Be sure to mention Border Terrier Canada when you reserve.

PLEASE NOTE: The BTC Room Responsibility Policy will be in effect and strictly enforced.

Rooms may be subject to joint inspection by Hotel Staff. We recommend that you examine your room on check in and if you see any damage that might subsequently be attributed to your dog(s), please report it to a member of the Hotel Staff as soon as possible.

All judging will take place outdoors on the lawn with ample tenting and room for your canopies.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Chapter 15, Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded WINNERS at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

EVENT REGISTRATION FEE

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$62.40 per dog after February 1, 2017 plus applicable taxes. For further information contact:

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011:

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$62.40 plus applicable taxes.
- The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

USA EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or money orders in Canadian Funds and personal cheques, payable in U.S. funds, and for the full amount of the entry will be accepted. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" as such items are not cleared through the banks. Your cooperation is appreciated.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. Substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs which are already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or are eligible for such registration can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries positively close 8:00 p.m. (EST) Wednesday, June 21, 2017** and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.
4. Identification cards and judging schedules will be mailed as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented upon arrival at the show.
5. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any N.S.F. cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. Border Terrier Canadawill use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called three times, it will be marked absent. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several dogs must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times conflict.
5. SHOW PRECINCTS: The Show precincts shall consist of all areas set out for rings, all shelters or facilities set aside for show officials, judges or exhibitors and handlers, and an area of 30 feet outside of the judging rings. In the event of inclement weather, no provisions have been made for cover.
