A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) as established by the CKC, and a fee of \$10.50, must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration or an ERN is not shown on the entry form.

A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a PEN (Performance Event Number) on CCN (Canine Companion Number) ERN's for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC. ERN must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.

Printed catalogues will not be provided. In advance of the test, the catalogue will be made available for download, or emailed to the participants, along with a running order.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The **running order** will be determined by a draw for each stake at the home of the Secretary after time of closing. The running order may be changed on the day of the tests as provided by the Official Rules.

Entry fees will not be refunded after July 3, 2024, In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.

Bitches in season will not be eligible to compete and are not allowed on the test grounds. Fees refunded with a veterinary certificate confirming the bitch is in heat.

Ducks, pheasants, and/or chukars may be used.

Handlers shall not wear distinctively white or light clothing at any time but handlers may wear handling jackets for blinds in WCX.

A rosette and a prize will be awarded to all qualifiers.

No training is allowed on the testing grounds within 24 hours of the start of the test. A bumper thrown by the handler for the purpose of warm-up shall not be considered training.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Release and Indemnification:

By participating in these test, (as handler, spectators or in any other role) each participant agrees to assume all risk and hazards incidental to these tests and agrees to release and save harmless and indemnify the Nova Scotia Duck Toller Retriever Club of Canada, and its members, any volunteer and the owners of the property upon which the tests are held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, cost expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
