BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season may not compete. When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed, a Veterinarian's certificate verifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given.

- The Selected & Veteran Classes will run with the Regular Classes in jump heights.
- Equipment Familiarization will run before the Novice Standard Class only.
- Jump heights in all classes in all trials will run from low to high.
- Since the JWW and Standard in Trials 57 and 58 are running concurrently, please notify the trial secretary and do your paperwork immediately if you are eligible to move-up between Trials 57 and 58.

Please note:

All crating and food set-up is in the Obedience Hall; McCann's allows no crating in the agility hall. Thank you for your attention to this change.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Trial Secretary is in full charge of the Trials.

- No provision will be made for inclement weather.
- Indoor crating is in the Obedience Hall. No crating in the agility arena.
- There is no camping, water or hydro at this location.
- Food or toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other instruments or devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course.
- There will be contact familiarization. A warm up area with one jump will be provided.
- Handlers in all classes will be able to walk the course, without their dog prior to the start of the class.
- It is the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- TRIAL PRECINCTS: The Trial precincts shall consist of the entire precincts of McCann's Agility Building. Only those dogs entered in the Trials will be allowed within the trial precincts.
- PLEASE PLACE EITHER A GRASS MAT OR TARP BENEATH YOUR CRATES, CHAIR AND ALL BELONGINGS. PLEASE ASSIST US BY CLEANING UP YOUR OWN AREA UPON DEPARTURE. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR LEAVING YOUR AREA AS CLEAN AS POSSIBLE. WHEN LEAVING, PLEASE DO NOT SHAKE YOUR TARP INSIDE THE BUILDING. IF YOU SPILL SOMETHING OR IF YOUR DOG HAS AN ACCIDENT ON THE ARTIFICIAL GRASS, IT WILL NEED TO BE BLOTTED WITH PAPER TOWEL IMMEDIATELY, THEN DOUSED WITH WATER/VINEGAR SOLUTION., PLEASE DO NOT DUMP WATER BOWLS OUT THE FRONT DOOR FOR SOMEONE TO SLIP ON, BESIDE THE BUILDING OR OVER THE FENCE WOULD BE SAFEST.
- LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED NOT LATER THAN ONE HOUR PRIOR TO TRIAL START. Late entries will be at a fee of 35.00 per run and will only be accepted by the trial secretary if room permits within the trial/class.

EVENT INFORMATION

Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run.

OBSTACLES

- Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1, 2017
- 24" weave poles will be used.
- on any jump, in any level ,one bar may be used on a jump
- the tire will be set at 4" lower than the height of the jump (except 4")
- Electronic timer will be used.

ELIGIBILITY

- To be eligible to compete in these trials, a dog must be 18 mos. of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or CCN.
- Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:

1) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee

2) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

3) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members or American exhibitors.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN.

Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or MasterCard. For non-members of the CKC please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates. Provide a full return address. Faxed request will be accepted. Please ensure that your Visa or MasterCard number is legible and that you have included the expiry date and signature. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30-day extension. Forward ERN request to:

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

TROPHIES- Flat ribbons will be given for $1^{\rm st}$ to $4^{\rm th}$ qualifying scores in all Jump heights.

SELECTED/VETERAN DIVISION — Section 8.2 CKC Jan 1/2017 rule book. The Selected/Veteran Divisions follow the Agility Trials Rules & Regulations. The Courses will be the same as in the regular classes but will have adjusted height & course times (see Sections 8.5.1 and 10.11)

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- The owner or handler of the dog must sign the Liability Agreement on the back of the entry form. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the correct fees.
- Courier entries will be accepted if no signatures are required.
- Move-ups will be allowed after the closing date, up to 48 hrs prior to the scheduled start of the trials.
- Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited, except Move Ups.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
- Judging schedules will be mailed or e-mailed as soon as possible after the closing date.
- Tendering a NSF cheque is considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge.
- "Day-of" Entries will be accepted up to one hour prior to the start of the first trial by the trial secretary only if there is room in that trial/Class.
