

Simcoe Performance Dogs Nov. 7, 2021 Agility Trial Judging Schedule

Masks MUST be worn at ALL times in the Red Barn. When running your dog, you may remove your mask.

Please note: To comply with provincial Covid 19 regulations all participants will need to provide proof of 2 vaccinations (when you check in at the trial) or a certified medical exemption letter and proof of identification. You will only need to show this once, we will record that you have shown this information and at the next trial you will not need to show it. Thank you for being patient while we check this information. Please do not email this information to us as we are not allowed to store the actual vaccination form.

We are allowing crating space in the Red Barn. Please note that dogs <u>in the area</u> <u>marked as non reactive</u> must be able to sit quietly in their crates. If your dog is not able to do this (even while you are volunteering in the ring) please crate in the GENERAL crating area. If you have already booked a crating spot, please remind us when you check in, we will be refunding your crate payment as we have been permitted to have more crating. You are still welcome to crate from your car but we are not calling out names in parking lot. Please refer to the map included as an attachment to this email.

You will get course maps at the registration desk where you will be checking in and selecting your volunteering positions (you will get two stickers with your name on it and you can stick it on two spots to help). Barb, the volunteer coordinator will be there to assist you. Your entry was dependent on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial.

Please note we will not have a leash runner. Please either put your leash in your pocket or bring a second leash and hang it on the wall at finish area. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Thank you for supporting our trial. If you have not already done so, please review your entry for classes and jump heights and notify the trial secretary at <u>dlmagility@gmail.com</u> as soon as possible of any concerns.

The site will be open for full day volunteers only at 8:00 a.m.

Competitors may enter the Red Barn at 8:15 a.m. Please do not arrive early, to ensure proper training and safety of our volunteers we will have to uphold this rule.

Please note day of trial entries will not be accepted at this trial due to Covid protocols.

In 2010 the Board of Directors of the CKC passed a motion with respect to a Non-Member Tracking Fee for Canadians that participate in CKC events and are not CKC members. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non- CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. The Non-Member Participation Fee is effective January 1, 2011. Cost is \$63.90 + HST
