### **CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES**

### Chapter 13, Section 10 of the Dog Show Rules State:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry. Notice of withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Show Secretary on or before the official closing date as published in the premium list. When the premium list indicates that entries will be limited, cancellation of entries will not be permitted.

### MOVING A DOG TO THE SPECIALS CLASS

Chapter 13, Section 13, of the dog show rules has been amended to allow a dog which is "INDIVIDUALLY REGISTERED AT TIME OF CLOSING" in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of a Championship, after the closing date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request for transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW by the owner or handler.

### (NEW) NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

- An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

### Saturday June 25, 2011

- Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Show Secretary and must include the following:
  - a) Name of Club and date of event
  - b) Name, address, telephone number, date of birth, signature of Junior Handler.
  - c) Class entered, breed & catalogue number of dog to be handled.
- A Junior Handler may compete with any dog entered in the show, provided he/she has the consent of the owner or agent to do so.
- 3. The Junior Handler will wear the armband number assigned to the dog for the show.
- 4. If necessary, due to conflict, substitution of dog will be allowed.
- 5. Dogs being used in competition must be of appropriate size and temperament for the Junior Handler. If the Junior Handler cannot lift the dog, it is not appropriate in size for the competitor.

#### CLASSES OFFERED AT THIS SHOW

The Hamilton Kennel Club Inc. Is pleased to offer Rosettes for First to Fourth in each class and a Rosette & Trophy for Best Overall Junior Handler, and ribbons for all participants.

**Pee Wee** - Handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year. This class is optional and non-competitive.

**Junior Novice** - Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

**Junior Open** -Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year who have won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice - Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open -Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31 st of the year preceding the competition year who have won 6 first places with competition.

Senior Novice -This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

**Senior Open** - This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places with competition in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

### ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

- Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership with a written request for an ERN.
- Include full payment in the amount of \$57.60 plus applicable tax. Accounts may be paid with personal or business cheque, money order, Visa or Mastercard. For Non-Members please note that if paying by cheque, the cheque must be certified. Non-residents of Canada please note that discounted cheques or money orders will not be accepted due to fluctuating currency rates.

### **CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

<u>SECTION 1:</u> A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6 -9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder: RREEDS COMPETING AT GROUP LEVEL:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- All communication regarding entries should be addressed to the Show Secretary.
- Entries without a fee will not be accepted.
- Acknowledgement of entries with a judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after the closing date.
- 4. Make all cheques payable to Diana Edwards Show Services
- 5. The Club and Diana Edwards Show Services will not be responsible for cash sent through the mail.
- Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added by Diana Edwards Show Services in addition to any back charges for each returned cheque.

- If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts of God, it is impossible to open or complete the show, not refund of entries shall be made.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing time is prohibited.
- 11. The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- 12. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/Agents are responsible to have their dogs present when their classes are called to be judged.
- 13. Exhibitors are requested to keep their groming and crating areas clean and tidy. If space is at a premium, exhibitors must remove exercise pens if requested by the Show Superintendent.

The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.

# BORDER TERRIER CANADA ROOM RESPONSIBILITY POLICY

(adapted with permission from the Border Terrier Club of America Room Policy)

Border Terrier Canada (BTC) has adopted the following rules in order to insure that its members and their dogs will be welcome at hotels in the future.

Any individual attending a Border Terrier Canada (BTC) sanctioned event and staying in a hotel, motel, inn or campsite/fairground has the responsibility of leaving that room or campsite exactly as found. This includes picking up after dog(s) on the grounds. Anyone who damages a room or campsite/fairground and does not report the damage to the hotel/campsite/fairground management, and make immediate restitution or arrangements to do so within a period of time agreed upon by the management, will be subject to any or all of the following actions by the BTC Board of Directors.

- 1. May be banned from showing at the next BTC sanctioned event(s).
- 2. May be subject to CKC sanctions.
- 3. Membership in the BTC may be terminated and may not be allowed to be reinstated.

### Damages shall be defined as:

- Flea infestation, urine, defecation and/or any damage to hotel/campsite/fairground property (walls, bedspreads, carpets, drapes, etc.).
- 2. Any verified complaint by the host hotel/campsite/fairground.
- 3. Any verified complaint by a BTC member.

### BTC Room Regulations:

- 1. All dogs shall be crated and quiet when left alone in a room. Noisy dogs shall be quieted upon request, even if this means the owner/handler must stay in the room with the dog.
- Individuals will be expected to immediately report any damage by dogs or themselves to the hotel or campsite/fairground management, and to assume complete financial responsibility for those damages.
- 3. No bathing or grooming will be allowed in rooms. A grooming room will be available whenever possible.
- Dogs are to be allowed on hotel furniture/beds ONLY if the furniture is covered with protective covering provided by the owner/handler.
- All owners/handlers will take preventative measures to assure that their dogs are free of fleas, mites, intestinal parasites and other communicable diseases prior to arriving at the hotel/campsite.

THIS POLICY WILL BE REQUIRED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE SPECIALTY PREMIUM LIST WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM ALSO INSURES COMPLIANCE WITH THIS POLICY. THE POLICY WILL ALSO BE INCLUDED IN ANY SPECIALTY PACKET MAILED TO MEMBERS AND WILL BE DISTRIBUTED WITH ANY SPECIALTY HOSPITALITY PACKETS. ALL INDIVIDUALS ARE REQUIRED TO COMPLY.

OUR SHOW GROUNDS IS A LOVELY PLACE FOR A DOG SHOW, AND IN ORDER TO ENSURE THE AVAILABILITY OF THE SITE FOR FUTURE SHOWS, PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS WHEN EXERCISING THEM. PLEASE DO NOT EXERCISE YOUR DOGS ON THE STREETS, OR PRIVATE PROPERTY.

THESE ARE OUTDOOR SHOWS & TRIALS, AND NO COVERING WILL BE PROVIDED IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER. THE SHOW PRECINCTS ARE 30 FEET FROM ALL RINGS, THE ARENA, AND ALL AREAS RESERVED FOR JUDGES AND SHOW OFFICIALS.
