Please note:

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary before the official date and time of entry closing. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to this specialty.
2. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
3. A judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under CKC rules shall not be subject to any indignity (*CKC dog show rules, 19.7*).

ATTENTION - ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

TO COMPETE IN ANY JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES CLASS, DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS, OR FOR SPECIALS ONLY. ENTRY IN JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED. VETERANS MAY BE ENTERED IN EXHIBITION ONLY. ENTRY IN BREEDERS SWEEPSTAKES FROM THE EXHIBITION CLASS IS NOT ALLOWED.

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Classes will be divided by sex as follows:
6 - 9 months
9 - 12 months
12 - 18 months

Veteran Sweepstakes

Classes will be divided by sex as follows:
7 - 9 years
9 - 12 years
12 years & older

Breeders Sweepstakes: Breeder or Co-Breeder must show the dog, but it does not need to be owned by the Breeder or Co-Breeder. Each sex will be judged separately and a first and second place will be awarded. The first place winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes. The second place winner to Best in Sweepstakes will then compete for Reserve Best in Sweepstakes.

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular.

Sire & Get

Stud dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Stud dog may be spayed/neutered. Get must be entered in a regular class.

Dam & Progeny

Brood bitch and two of more of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Dam may be spayed/neutered. Progeny must be entered in a regular class.

Brace

Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed), **not necessarily owned by the same owner.** Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES

Dogs entered in any Unofficial class must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Spayed / neutered dogs may compete in Non-Regular or Unofficial classes.

GUN DOG	For all dogs who have received a Junior Hunter Title or higher, a Working Certificate or higher, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries.
FIELD DOG	For all dogs who have earned a Certificate of Merit or better at a Licensed Field Trial, in Canada or the United States by the close of entries
GENERATIONAL CLASS	Consists of three or more dogs in a three or more generation DIRECT line (i.e., Mother or Father with son or daughter and grandson or granddaughter or great grandson or great granddaughter). These dogs are shown together (handled separately). To be judged on similarity of type (similar to stud dog or brood bitch). Dogs may be spayed/neutered and breeder(s) owner(s) need not be identical. Please fill out "Extra Form".

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Baby Puppy.....	for dogs 3 months of age but under 6 months of age These puppies are not eligible to compete for points
Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-15 Months.....	for dogs 12 months of age but under 15 months of age
15-18 Months.....	for dogs 15 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for all dogs. <u>will NOT be divided by colour.</u>
Open	for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.
Veteran	
Specials Only	dogs which are <u>registered individually</u> , in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN number and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only	for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club
Exhibition Only (3-6 Months)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only (3-6 Months) provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular classes or Parades.</u>
