To comply with the Canadian Kennel Club regulations, the show secretary will not be able to accept entries after the official closing time and date. All entries must be forwarded to the show secretary prior to the closing date. Personal cheques and money orders for the full value only will be accepted and must be made payable to the:

No post-dated cheques will be accepted. The Shows and Trials Division of the Canadian Kennel Club interprets the term "Post Dated" to mean date other than the date on which the entry was received. Entries cannot be processed unless the date of the cheque is current. All NSF cheques will be subject to a fee of \$20.00. NSF fees are considered non-payment of fees and will be subject to disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the show.

Attention US Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due in Canadian Dollars. Discounted cheques are not acceptable and personal cheques are payable in US funds. The amount of the personal cheques is payable for the full amount and no exchange will be refunded. Do not mark cheques "At Par" or "Payable in Canadian Funds". Canadian banks do not accept these cheques. We encourage you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Copies of the Rules pertaining to Dog Shows are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. It is up to each exhibitor to know and comply with these rules at this Canadian Kennel Club event.

PLEASE NOTE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

To show our breed in Canada you MUST have a miscellaneous class certification number provided by the Canadian Kennel Club to enter these shows. Please contact the Canadian Kennel Club to apply for a number before registering. There can be a wait until the number is processed. ENTRY INFORMATION

1. All entries must be received by the Show Secretary and must be received by the closing date and time.
2. No entry is to be accepted without proper forms and fees included.
3. Incomplete entries will be returned. Agents and handlers please note the full name and address must be completely filled in.
4. Exhibitors must abide by errors made when entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the error was made.
5. Only dogs with a CKC Miscellaneous Number will be allowed to enter these shows.
6. A dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements of Championship, in accordance with the provision of Chapter 20 of these rules, after the closing date and time of the show, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only", providing the request is received by the Show Secretary IN WRITING at least one hour prior to the opening of the show by the owner or handler.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS – CHAPTER 21

SECTION 1A – A dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder:

SECTION 2 –

Dogs competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	15 or more
Points allotted	0	1	2	3	4	5

*including the dog awarded Winners

CONFORMATION

REGULAR CLASSES: The following CKC Regular Classes will be provided for both sexes

Junior Puppy	a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Puppy	a dog 9 months up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Month	a dog 12 months up to 18 months on the day of the show
Canadian Bred	a dog which was born in Canada
Bred By Exhibitor	a dog owned and handled by the breeder
Open Class	all dogs
Veterans	a dog 7 years and over
Specials Only	dogs who are Canadian Champions only
Exhibition	dogs 6 months and over not competing.

Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months on the day of the show may be entered as Exhibition Only providing that the owner of the puppies has also entered a dog in one of the regular classes. No exhibitor may enter more than 2 puppies 3-6 months of age as Exhibition Only.

AWARDS OF MERIT will be made (if warranted) at the maximum rate of one for every ten dogs competing for Best of Breed. This award will be made after the judging of Best of Breed.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES Dogs entered in Non-Regular classes must be entered in one of the CKC Regular Classes, Specials Only or Exhibition Only.

Stud Dog Class	shall be for Stud Dog and two or more Get
Brood Bitch Class	shall be for Brood Bitch and two or more Progeny
Parade of Title Holders	is open to all CKC titleholders
Best Canadian Bred	in Specialty will be offered at this Specialty

SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes – All puppies shall be 6 months up to but not including 18 months of age. To enter this class, the dog must be entered in one of the CKC regular classes or in Specials Only. Conformation and Sweeps may be made on the same entry form.

There will be classes in all, divided by sex

Junior Class	a dog 6 months up to 9 months on the day of the show
Senior Class	a dog 9 months up to 12 months on the day of the show
12-18 Months	a dog 12 months up to 18 months on the day of the show

The winners of all six classes will then compete for Best In Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places in each class as well as to Best In Sweeps and Best of Opposite in Sweeps.

For Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

- 5% of the pot will go to each winner of each class
- 2% of the pot will go to the second in class
- 20% of the pot will go to the Best In Sweeps
- 15% of the pot will go to the Best of Opposite Sex in Sweeps
- 23% of the pot will be retained for administrative purposes.

Veterans Sweepstakes – Open to all dogs 7 years or older entered in a CKC regular class or Specials Only. Neutered and spayed dogs may compete in this sweepstakes as long as they are also entered in Exhibition Only. Conformation and Sweeps may be made on the same entry form.

There will be classes in all, divided by sex

7-9 Years a dog 7 years up to 9 years on the day of the show
9-11 Years a dog 9 years up to 11 years on the day of the show
11 Year and Older a dog 11 years and older on the day of the show

The winners of each of the 6 will then compete for Best In Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places in each class as well as to Best In Sweeps and Best of Opposite in Sweeps.

For Sweepstakes the class winners will compete for Best in Sweepstakes with the prize money distributed as follows:

5% of the pot will go to each winner of each class
2% of the pot will go to the second in class
20% of the pot will go to the Best In Sweeps
15% of the pot will go to the Best of Opposite Sex in Sweeps
23% of the pot will be retained for administrative purposes.

- The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the shows, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- All exhibitors will be held responsible for clean up on the show site surrounding areas. Failure to do so will give the right of the CAPRTF

Board of Directors to refuse future entries of such exhibitors to their future shows.

- A judge officiating at a show shall not be subject to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show and it is the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that this rule is enforced. (Dog Show Rules Sec 6.3.3)
- No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally or in writing, to favor his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule of the CKC within 14 days of the act (Dog Show Rules Sec 6.3.4)
- The Canadian Association of Parson Russell Terrier Fanciers will use all care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors or patrons. If, because of riot or civil disturbance or any other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or close the shows, no refund of entries will be provided.
- Judging schedules will be mailed to all exhibitors as soon as the show secretary processes all entries.
- No signage is allowed for sale of puppies or dogs within the show site.

Once arriving at the Airport if driving follow Highway 102 South, Take exit 1A for 103/3/333/Lighthouse Trail toward Peggy's Cove/S Shore/Yarmouth. Merge onto Hwy 103 W then take exit 2B for 3/333/Lighthouse Trail toward Halifax/Peggy's Cove. Merge onto St Margaret's Bay, and then slight right toward Prospect Rd.



Continue straight onto Prospect Rd. Follow the signs to Exhibition Park.

If coming from New Brunswick

Take the Halifax Exit off Highway 104, to Highway 102 S. Follow the same directions as above.
