

Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta Friday, September 16th to Sunday, September 18th, 2022 CKC Agility Trials

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION and OFFICIAL JUDGING SCHEDULE ***PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION CAREFULLY***

Location

Held at Wet Noses Bed and Biscuit near Calgary. Outdoors (no cover) on grass surface. 2 Page Wire fenced rings 100' x 110' with closed entry and exit gates are used.

Check In

Exhibitors must check in ONCE over the weekend.

Check in each day is from 7:15 am onward. Trial instructions and Judge's briefing will take place at 8:00 am. Walk through is immediately following the judges briefing. First dog on the line immediately following walkthrough. We will be starting with Novice PAD on Friday.

We have a designated Course Building Team to minimize the number of people who are touching the contact equipment, therefore we will be running Tall to Small all weekend.

Benching

FREE on-site benching.

Concession

There will **NOT** be a concession at these trials. Please bring your own food and drink.

Move Up's and Day of entries

We will be doing move ups BETWEEN each trial each day – so there are same day move ups allowed. We are taking Day of entries if we have not hit our 300/day run limit per judge.

Important Rules

Picking up after your dog and yourself is totally your responsibility. There will be waste containers available on site for dog droppings, regular waste and recycled waste. Please use them – there is zero tolerance for waste left behind.

Wet Noses is a 50-acre K9 Exclusive Facility. Water surrounds the property for swimming, to exercise or cool down your agility partner. Take advantage of the securely fenced **Off Leash exercise** to relax and burn off entertaining zoomies at the trials.

The Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta and Wet Noses will not be responsible for the loss or injury to any dog, person or vehicle/belongings whether the result of an accident or other cause during the trial weekend.

Equipment

Obstacles: Agility obstacles meet the requirements of the CKC Agility Rules.

Note: A-Frame, Dog walk, Teeter and Table have rubber surfaces and the tire is a breakaway.

Wall Jump and Broad Jump will not be used on any course.

No equipment familiarization.

NO toys that make squeaky sounds will be permitted within 15 feet of the ring.

Electronic Timers will be used at these trials.

Rocky Mountain Working Herding Club of Alberta / Wet Noses Rules

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Agility Rules and Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club (www.ckc.ca)

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the agility trial. The Trial Chairperson shall have full control of the above trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Trial Chairperson for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The trial committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Trial Chairperson shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the trial grounds

Be respectful to each other, the volunteers and let us keep each other safe.
