Practice Runs to be offered on Sunday, July 16th from 3pm to 4pm (estimated time) - Pay on the day of, at Check-In desk. Pre-entry <u>not</u> required for practice runs. Dog must have NO collar or a flat collar ONLY (any harness, e-collar, prong, or banadas must be taken off before running).

HOW TO ENTER MY DOG(S)?

<u>All dogs must have a UKC number to enter</u>. See information here to acquire UKC number. For ALL dogs

If your dog is not already registered, and you want to enter something within the next 4 weeks, you can obtain a Temporary Listing Number instantly on the UKC site, here: <u>https://www.ukcdogs.com/tl-numbers</u>. This TL number is good for an unlimited number of entries in any UKC event, until you apply for and receive a full registration. Any wins or titles you earn on a TL will be 'held' until you have full registration.

If your dog is CKC, AKC or FCI registered, you would apply for Single Registration, here: <u>https://www.ukcdogs.com/single-registration</u>. This permanent UKC number can be used in all events.

If your dog is not registered elsewhere, is a mixed breed, or has a disqualifying fault, you would apply for a Performance Listing, here: <u>https://www.ukcdogs.com/performance-listing</u> With a PL, you can enter all events except conformation.

REFUND POLICY

Lame dogs and females in season may not be entered. Entry fees will be refunded if notified prior to Check-In.

JUDGING

A standardized course plan of approximately 400 to 600 yards will be used, and each part of the course demonstrates speed, agility, or endurance. Each skill is judged on one third of the course; speed is judged on the run- up (first portion), agility is judged through the agility portion (second portion), and endurance is judged on the return to the start (third portion). Judges will indicate the winner following each course. Ties will be re-run immediately, if necessary. Dogs will have at least a 20-minute break between courses.

AWARDS

Ribbons will be offered for all placements. Prizes will be awarded for Regular Stakes | Breed Leader.
