DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW: From Moncton/Nova Scotia: Take Route 2 to Fredericton. Take exit 333 to Sheffield (Route 105) Casey's Campground is 12 km from the exit.

Due to the construction closure of a major Bridge crossing the St John River during July & August I have mapped out new driving directions to the show site. With only 1 remaining bridge to the North side of the River, there will be a lot of extra traffic. To avoid this extra traffic the following directions have been provided for your convenience.

US Exhibitors: Traveling on 1-95 from the Houlton Border to Fredericton- Stay on I-95N entering Canada (NB). Continue on NB 95N taking Exit Ramp NB 2 East. Travel NB 2 East for approx. 1 hr 40 min. Take exit 333 Sheffield (off NB 2E) to Hwy 105N. This exit puts you 10 min past the show site so you will be backtracking for about 12-15 km. Casey's is directly on Hwy 105 on your right. The River is on the Left.

From Quebec/Ontario – at the Quebec/NB border you are on Hwy 2 East. Follow direction above.
