CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog *6 months of age and under 9 months of age* on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog *9 months of age and under 12 months of age* on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTH CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

(Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co-owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. **Note: A Listed dog MAY be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees WILL NOT be refunded**

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(if offered by the club, refer to individual Premium List)

NOTE: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class **MUST** also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day

BABY PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The awards for this class are: Best Baby Male, Best Baby Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Best Baby Puppy in Group, Best Baby Puppy in Show (This class will be held on completion of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and **PRIOR** to Best in Show)

VETERANS CLASS - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

ALTERED CLASS- will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each. The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Altered in Group and Best Altered in Show. All dogs must be surgically altered to enter this show.

INFORMATION ON THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

THE AUTHORITIES OF ANY SHOW MAY:

- (A) Decline to accept entries for just cause and/or
- (B) Refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show grounds on account of disease or viciousness.

In the case of Non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have claim or recourse against the organization holding the show, or any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry.

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds.

BORDER CROSSING:

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this Certificate and MUST be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the US

Females in season as pertains to trial

When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee and listing fee will be refunded.

CCN NUMBER (Canine Companion Number) Allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility; Obedience and Rally Obedience. To enter any Trial, the dog *MUST* have a CCN. A dog in this category may not be entered as "Listed". The application form for the CCN can be found on the CKC website, under Forms Online, Registration. GENERAL RULES COVERING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above Shows and Trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.**
- 2. The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.**
- 3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the Show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this Rule has been violated.**
- 4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds.**
- 5. Dogs must be on the Grounds one hour before the judging of their Breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging.**
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of Breed or Class Judging. No Ring shall be held up waiting Exhibitors or Handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute Handlers available so that judging will not be delayed.**
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these Shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the Entry was made.**
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship Show held under these Rules cannot again be shown at a Show held under these Rules until the dog has been examined by an Official Committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the Examining Committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.**
- 9. Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.**
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the Exhibitors and the Spectators we insist upon keeping our Grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please Exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging Ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, NOT in the vicinity of the Ring areas.**
- 11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.**
- 12. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.**
- 13. The use of PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM will be kept to an absolute minimum. Therefore, IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE, when necessary. There will be no paging for individual dogs.**
- 14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.**

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs, instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$58.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETEING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

***includes the dog awarded Winners**

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The system provides for additional Points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) (3) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

Non Member Participation Fee – (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non member of the CKC. This fee will match the ERN fee.**
- The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.**
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days or notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.**
- This fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.**

Rally Obedience Classes:

Ring Size 40 X 50

The following classes will be offered in each trial. Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries. **Rally Novice A, Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B**

RALLY NOVICE A:

Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B:

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE:

The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes.(CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A:

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A:

This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D.. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

**Refer to Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for further information.
All exhibitors must be familiar with Rally Rules and Regulations effective: January 1, 2015.**

The precincts of these trials are the rings and immediate area surrounding the rings of the show site at 5100 North Nechako Road. Dogs are not permitted in the buildings. Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.

**Entries will be accepted on the day of the trial up to one hour prior to starting of judging
ONLY IF SPACE IS AVAILABLE.**

OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Obedience Ring Size will be 40' X 50.

Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries.

The following classes will be offered in each Obedience trial: Pre-novice, Novice A, Novice B, Novice C, Novice intermediate, Veterans, Open A, Open B, Utility A, Utility B.

Scores earned by dogs entered in Pre-Novice, Novice C, and Veterans are not eligible for High in Trial.

NOVICE "A" - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. Title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be canceled.

NOVICE "B" - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for purebred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada

OPEN "A" - No licensed handler, no trainer, nor any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its U.D. title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class, any score awarded will be cancelled. The dog must have earned it C.D. Title to enter this class.

OPEN "B" - Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person & shall be for pure-bred dogs of any breed which have not won the title of C.D. in Canada. The dog must have earned it C.D. title to enter this class.

UTILITY A – For any purebred dog that has not earned the title of UD. No person who has earned a MOTCH title may handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or a member of their immediate families. Exercises will be performed in the usual order.

UTILITY B – Exercises will be done in random order. Order will be posted approximately 30 minutes prior to judging.

PRE-NOVICE – shall be for any dog which has not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person.

NOVICE C – Novice C

For any dog that has earned the title CD, CDX, or UD or any Obedience Trial Championship title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE – Shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any Obedience Trial Championship.

SENIOR OPEN CLASS: THIS CLASS IS FOR HANDLERS 15 YEAR OF AGE AS OF DECEMBER 31ST OF THE YEAR PRECEDING THE COMPETITION YEAR AND UP TO 18 YEARS OF AGE, WHO HAVE WON 6 FIRST PLACES WITH COMPETITION IN THE SENIOR NOVICE CLASS AND FOR ANY HANDLER WHO HAS PROGRESSED THROUGH THE INTERMEDIATE OPEN LEVEL AND FEELS THAT HE HAS ENOUGH EXPERIENCE TO COMPETE AT THIS LEVEL
