General Rules and Regulations

- UNOFFICIAL USE OR PRESENCE OF TRIAL ODORS NOT PERMITTED ON THE TRIAL SITE
- Open to all breeds & mixes of dogs. Dogs must be registered with the SDDA and be over six (6) months of age.

Dogs: Must be under control at all times. Keep barking to a minimum, there are homes nearby. Dogs MUST be on leash when not crated or in the search areas. Do not allow your dog to approach other dogs or people (WATCH your

dog when on a flexi). All dogs must be on a flat collar or harness (non-tightening) in the search area. Leashes may be cloth or leather of any length in the search area.

Bitches in heat: Are allowed to compete, however as they will run very last in each component we ask that you notify us ASAP if your bitch is in heat so we can notify other competitors of a change in run order.

Doggy Doo: Pick up after your dogs promptly and dispose of waste in OUTDOOR trash cans.

Handler Warning: Any handler displaying inhumane or aggressive treatment of any dog, trial officials, other handlers, or facility staff (physically or verbally) will be asked to leave without refund.





Competitors: Through the submission of their entries, acknowledge that they know the Rules and Regulations and agree to abide by them. See the Master Rule Book on the SDDA web site (www.sportingdetectiondogs.ca).

Please check in: At the secretaries table upon your arrival to the site and present each dog's registration card.

Running Order: Order will be decided by random draw, and may change for each component.

Entry Rules and Regulations:

Regular Fees: \$30.00 per Component Entered

Maximum one dog/handler entered/level entered

Awards & Prizes: Qualifying ribbons will be presented per component, and rosettes for components, titles & placements. Prizes for: Judges Choice, Qualifying Raffle, & Great Sportsmanship.

Titles: All three (3) components (Container, Interior, Exterior) must be successfully completed (qualifying scores earned) to earn the **SD-S** or **SD-A** title. The **SP (Special)** designation will be added to the title of any dog that completes the three components on the same day, at the same trial.

No shows: will be defined as handlers missing the check in time (i.e. not having checked in prior to the handlers briefing of the first component, the container search) and their spot offered to the next in line wait list competitor.

Next day move-ups permitted: A dog may be entered in Started on both days and move-up to Advanced levels of the same components on Sunday, but will only be permitted to run the Advanced level if they pass Started.

Payment: Accepted methods of payment will be Interac email transfer.

Payments must be received within 24 hours of email entry confirmation.

Closing Date: When trial fills. If the trial fills a wait list will be maintained. Handlers will be notified of their position on the wait list and contacted if a spot becomes available.

Entry confirmations: Confirmations of entry receipt, notification of wait list order (if applicable); will be emailed upon receipt and processing of entry and payment.

Entry limits: Handler/Dog Teams may enter one, two, or all three components however a handler may not have more than 1 dog entered in a given component.





Refunds: Refunds will be given for any dog withdrawing for medical reasons. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the trial.

Benching: Benching will be in your vehicle. Please bring appropriate equipment to keep your dog(s) comfortable.
