ENTRIES

- ◆ All dogs must be individually registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number, or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC miscellaneous Class Certification Number. The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may not be lame or compete if it is taped or bandaged. A dog can only be entered once in any one class in a trial.
- ◆ **Event Registration Numbers:** All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with payment (check with the CKC for the current fee). This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC Event. Please forward your request to The Canadian Kennel Club, Shows and Trials Division, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9.
- ◆ The entry form must be completed in every respect and exhibitors must abide by any errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.
- ◆ No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fee. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- ◆ The tendering of a dishonoured (NSF) cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry

fees and is an offence subject to disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

MOVE-UPS

- ◆ Move-ups will be permitted at the end of the day on Saturday (i.e. between the 2nd and 3rd trial) and dogs may move from Excellent A to Excellent B between trials, however no other move ups will be permitted between trials on the same day. A dog earning a title after the closing date may advance to a higher level providing the Trial Secretary is notified no later than Sunday July 8th at 5:00pm.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ◆ The precinct of the trials shall be the ring enclosure and the areas set aside for the judges and trial officials.
- ◆ Only dogs entered for competition will be permitted in the precinct of the trials.
- ◆ The trials will be held outside on a grass surface. The courses will be set up within an enclosure of 100' by 150'.
- ◆ No provisions have been made for rain or sun. Bring your chair and protection from the weather for yourself and your dog.
- ◆ Please do not litter. Use the designated area for your dog, then clean up.
- ◆ Dogs must be under control at all times and kept on a leash except in the warm up area and on the course.
- ◆ No food or other device will be allowed on the course. The dog may wear a well-fitted plain buckle collar, quick release collar or no collar, on the course (note: no tags or decorations are permitted on the collar).
- ◆ Competitors participate at this event at their own risk. The release on the entry form must be signed.
- ◆ All obstacles will conform to CKC specifications.
- ◆ The Ottawa Valley Golden Retriever Club and the Ottawa Valley Poodle Club reserve the right to refuse entries, subject to CKC rules.

ALTERNATE LIST, REFUNDS

- ◆ **No entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the entry limit has been reached, or after the closing date, whichever comes first.**
- ◆ In the event that the entry limit is reached before the official closing date, an Alternate List will be compiled in the order received. Alternate dogs will be allowed to run in the place of any absent dogs. Alternate dogs which are not able to run shall have the entry fees refunded.
- ◆ There shall be no refunds in the event that the dog is absent on the day of the trial, or if the dog/handler is dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event of inclement weather, other than as provided for below.
- ◆ Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes in season after the entry has been submitted, a refund will be made on submission of a veterinary certificate prior to the day of the trial, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial.

ATTENTION U.S. EXHIBITORS

Event Registration Number (ERN)

Dogs that are foreign-born and owned who enter Canada for the sole purpose of competing in CKC events do not require a CKC registration number, but do require an Event Registration Number. (ERN) This must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event. For further information on obtaining an ERN, please contact the trial secretary or the Canadian Kennel Club at: 416-675-5511 or Fax 416-675-6506

Payment of entry fees:

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

CONDUCT

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

TRACKING FEE - Non CKC Member Canadian Resident

Effective January 1, 2011 the CKC instituted a tracking fee for all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members. In order to protect any points and awards earned at any CKC event, a resident non-member can choose to become a CKC member or pay the tracking fee of \$55 for each dog. Failure to comply with 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. This applies to dogs wholly owned by non-members resident in Canada and does not apply to U.S. exhibitors nor to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member.

JUMP HEIGHTS

All measurements are "at the withers"
8 in for dogs 10" and under
12 in for dogs over 10" up to and including 14"
16 in for dogs over 14" up to and including 18"
20 in for dogs over 18" up to and including 22"
24 in for dogs over 22"

Owners are responsible for entering the correct height division. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their correct division will be eliminated. Judges may require any dog to be measured.

Dogs entered in the Selected division will jump one height lower than the above jump heights.

Dogs 7 years or older may be entered into the Veterans division at one OR two heights lower than their Regular jump height. Dogs entered into Veterans may NOT move back into Regular or Selected.

CLASSES

- ◆ Agility Novice A (Standard or Jumpers with Weaves): For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or with any organization.
- ◆ Agility Novice B (Standard or Jumpers with Weaves): For agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate, and, for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.
- ◆ Agility Intermediate (Standard or Jumpers with Weaves): Open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent title.
- ◆ Agility Excellent A (Standard or Jumpers with Weaves): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.
- ◆ Agility Excellent B (Standard or Jumpers with Weaves): For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

CLASSES

- ◆ Regular – dogs jump height is as per standard rules
- ◆ Selected – dogs jump one height lower than standard rules
- ◆ Veterans – dogs jump one OR two heights lower than standard rules (handlers choice)

AGILITY TITLES (Standard)

- AG.N.** – Agility Novice
- AG.I.** – Agility Intermediate
- AG.X.** – Agility Excellent

Dogs must receive 3 qualifying scores of 85 points or better (out of a possible 100) from at least 2 different judges.

AG.M.X. – Agility Master Excellent

Dogs must earn 10 perfect scores of 100 in the Excellent B class at 10 Agility Trials.

Note: Titles for Selected include an “S” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.S.) Titles for Veterans include a “V” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.V.)

AGILITY TITLES (Jumpers with Weaves)

- AG.N.J.** – Agility Novice Jumper
- AG.I.J.** – Agility Intermediate Jumper
- AG.X.J.** – Agility Excellent Jumper

Dogs must receive 3 qualifying scores of 85 points or better (out of a possible 100) from at least 2 different judges.

AG.M.X.J. – Agility Master Excellent Jumper

Dogs must earn 10 perfect scores of 100 in the Excellent B class at 10 Agility Trials.

Note: Titles for Selected include an “S” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.J.S.). Titles for Veterans include a “V” at the end of the Title (e.g. AG.N.J.V.).

AGILITY TITLE (Champion)

AG.M.CH. – Agility Master Champion

Dogs must have received both the Agility Master Excellent and the Agility Master Excellent Jumpers title.

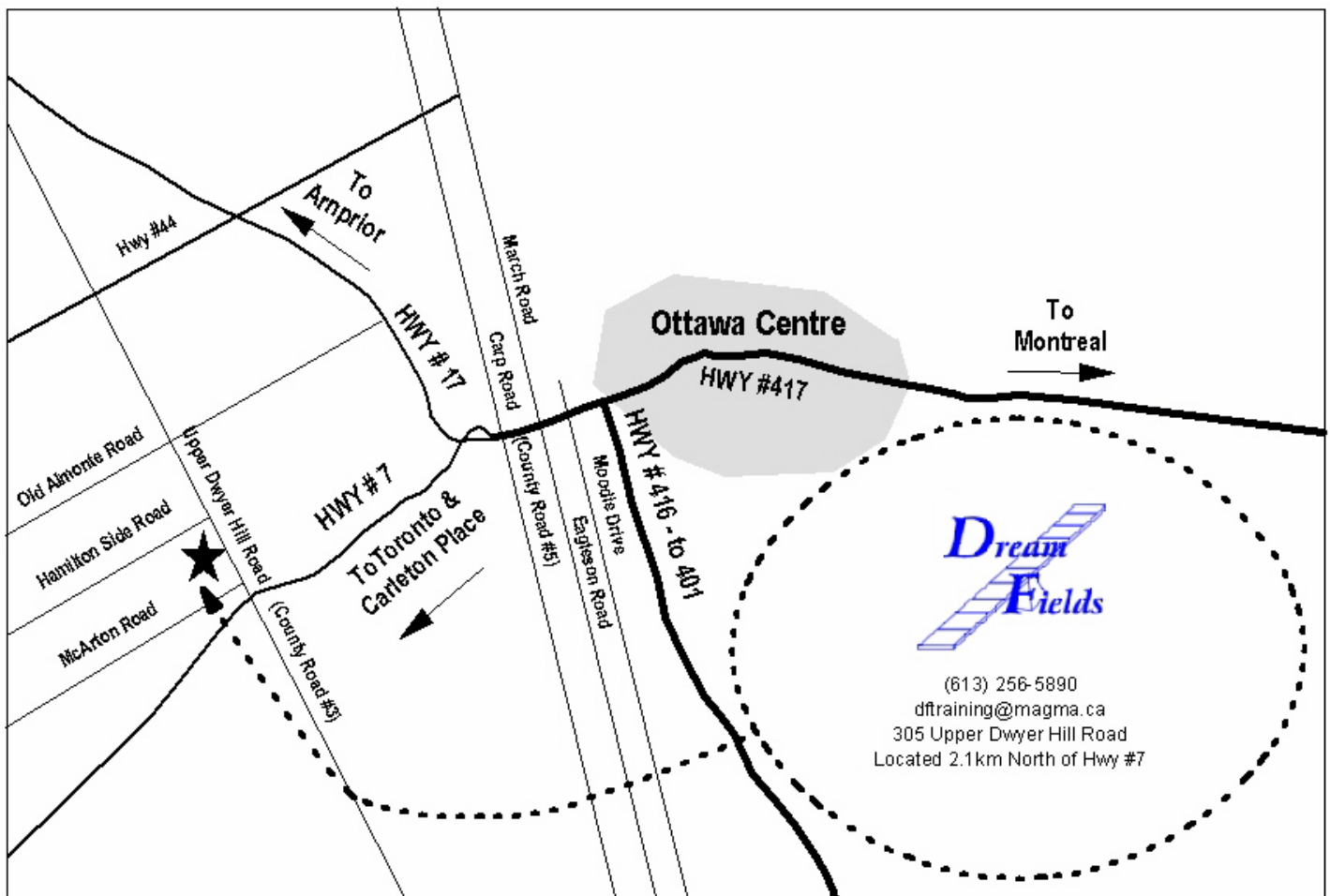
