SHOW ETIQUETTE

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (4.1.5)

Baby Puppy will be offered for puppies 4-6 months
Altered Competition will be offered and judged immediately
following Best Puppy and Best Baby Puppy in Specialty.

Rosettes and suitable prizes will be offered for BOB, BOS, BOW, WD , WB, Select Dog, Select Bitch, AOM (1 for every 10 dogs competing for Best of Breed), Best Puppy, Best Baby Puppy, Best Altered, Best Veteran, Best Canadian Bred and Best Bred-by Exhibitor.

CKCSCAC will follow the refund policy in place for the Moncton Kennel Club shows.

REFUND POLICY The Moncton Kennel Club has instituted the following refund policies. Up to November 11, 2022, 8:00 am AST refunds should the show be cancelled shall be 80%. Remainder will be kept by the Club to cover costs. Once the show starts there shall be no refunds.

REFUND INFORMATION ~ COMMUNICABLE DISEASES Entry Fees will be refunded for dogs/bitches that are posing a threat of a COMMUNICABLE DISEASE on the day of the show. To obtain the refund, a letter from a practicing Veterinarian **MUST** be presented to the Show Secretary prior to the commencement of the show.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

CHAMPIONS & CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1: A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing:	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
POINTS ALLOCATED*	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded WINNERS

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS FOR ALTERED DOGS

Points will be awarded for altered exhibits according to the schedule above.
