My husband and I acquired our first Dane in 1972. He was a Harlequin, and was sold to us as "show quality." Well, you can probably guess the punch line." He was not show quality, but he was a wonderful companion and went everywhere

with us: camping, sledding, hiking, swimming, etc.

Meanwhile we went to some matches, dog shows, and handling classes. We also read and studied the standard and every book we could find about Danes and handling. There were not too many dog publications at that time, but we found the dog that we wanted to be behind our foundation in New Hampshire. His name was CH. Dinro's Simon Templar, bred by Rose Roberts. Off we went in the motor home from California to New Hampshire. Long story short--we got a German import male and a dog and bitch sired by Simon, who was the top harlequin in the country. We also bought a Basset bitch from Simon's owner, who is to this day my best friend and mentor.

We bred Bassets and Great Danes for the next 20 years under the name "KIMO" which is a Mojave Indian word for Big Dog. We were very blessed to have the foundation stock that we had and the mentoring of my best friend. We have produced many generations of Champions, Specialty winner, group placing and group winning dogs in both breeds.

I applied to judge Bassets first as I was specialing a Great Dane. When his career was finished, I applied for Danes. I am now approved to judge the Working group, the Hound group, Juniors, and BIS. I enjoy judging, and

I try to make every exhibitor comfortable in my ring and feeling as if their exhibit was judged fairly. I have judged Specialties for many breeds all over the country and in Canada. I have judged the Canadian National, and several years ago, I judged the Dane Specialty in New Zealand. I also judged a Dane, Basset, and Rhodesian Ridgeback Specialty in Australia. I was on the Board of the Great Dane Club of America for six years, and I am the Judges' Education Chairman for the Parent Club. I have just completed the production of an educational CD on the Great Dane for judges, breeders, exhibitors, and anyone who wishes to learn about the "Apollo of Dogs." I am a retired teacher, and I share my home with two Bullmastiffs, a wonderful kitty, and my newest addition is a Border terrier named "Scamp" who is a great playmate for the Bullmastiffs and the kitty.



In 1986, a chance encounter with a Samoyed sitting in the driver's seat during my lunch in downtown Seattle led to going to my first all-breed dog show that summer weekend. What a world of wonders with breeds I had never heard of, vendors offering everything under the sun (so it seemed), and of

course, my Sams. What started as just a family companion became Canadian Ch. Tsiulikagta's Illamar, and I was hooked!

Joined the regional breed club, and then the national club. Became active in both, and went to my first national in 1991. Studied, was mentored, and for many years went to more dog shows to just watch and learn - other breeds as well as my own - to learn about structure and movement. I also sought to learn the history and purpose of the breeds I observed, to be able to equate and understand the working breeds I observed.

Along the way, Moonstar Samoyeds was established, and I have been fortunate in the mentors (who became good friends) I have had. Our mission/vision: We strive to consistently produce a SPIRIT and temperment that lives easily with its human and canine family and is adaptive to doing what is asked ... soundness of BODY ... movement that takes your breath away ... and beauty that stems from the whole/total dog being in BALANCE and in proportion. We have had BIS winners as well as multiple BISS winners, as well as working titled dogs.

Fast forward to 2009 when all the years of observing, studying and encouragement from my mentors shaped itself into the decision to become a judge. Approved to judge Samoyeds in 2011, I have learned how all those years outside the ring have helped me inside the ring, and I love it! Being able to judge other breeds is a goal, but more important is the journey as I learn each breed's history and standard, and making sure I have the "eye" to judge well.

Thank you for inviting me to judge your sweepstakes. It is a wonderful chance too see your future through the puppies, and your past with the Veterans.

Specials Only	Dogs which have a recorded CKC Registration number or Event Registration number and have attained the required points for championship status. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, and Best Puppy if eligible.
	NON-REGULAR CLASSES
Exhibition Only	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any of the Regular Classes
Brace Class	For 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex), judged as an identical pair. A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead. When viewed from the side they should appear as one dog and its shadow. Need not be identical ownership.
Stud Dog/Dam and Get/Progeny Class	For the Sire/Dam and two or more of his/her Get/Progeny. To enter this class the Sire/Dam must be entered in one of the Regular classes, or Exhibition Only. Get/Progeny MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

For surgically neutered/spayed dogs 6 months of age or older. There are NO classes other than OPEN. Class will be divided by sex. Awards will include the following: Best Altered in Breed, Best of Opposite Sex-Altered, Winners Altered Male/Female, Reserve Winners Altered Male/Female, First to Fourth in each class. Points awarded in the same manner as Regular Competition judging. Points may NOT be carried over into these classes from regular competition judging. Classes will be judged immediately following the Regular breed classes. For further information, please see the Dog Show Rules—Chapter 4

BABY PUPPY

This is a new class approved by the CKC for 2012 open to puppies between the ages of 3-6 months. No points are awarded to Baby Puppies, rather it is handled as an exhibition only. Placements are awarded first through fourth for each sex with Best Baby Puppy Male and Best Baby Puppy Female awarded respectively. Immediately thereafter a Best Baby Puppy in Specialty is chosen. (Unlike the 6-9 month puppies, the Baby puppies are not required to enter the ring after Best of Breed.) note: "Judges should not disqualify dogs in this class for lack of testicles or not meeting a minimum height requirement required in the breed standard."

EXTRACTS FROM CKC CONFORMATION SHOW RULES

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$8.82 (Baby Puppy listing fee is \$2.10) must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 2.3:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being canceled, and persons making such changes will be subject to disciplinary action.

Section 8.2:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be canceled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 16,

Section 3 of the CKC Dog Show Rules

CHAPTER 9 - EXHIBITORS and THEIR DOGS

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ADDITIONAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

- 1. The Canadian Mastiff Club will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs, exhibitors, handlers, spectators and vendors, but will not be responsible for any personal injury or death of any person or animal, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, nor for any damage, loss or theft of personal property.
- 2. All persons attending this event hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation.
- 3. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct of their animals while they are on the show grounds. ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.
- 4. The CMC reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed. CASH PRIZES will be handed over in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over. The Club disclaims any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.
- 5. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from these shows, which will be held strictly under the Canadian Kennel Club Rules.
- 6. The welfare of any children is deemed to be the responsibility of the guardian or parent. Please exercise control and restraint over your child's behavior.
- 7. Dogs must be ready for judging. The Club will not be responsible for, and not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. NO RING WILL BE HELD UP WAITING FOR EXHIBITORS OR HANDLERS.
- 8. All trailers, motor homes, campers and recreational units will have buckets underneath their sink drains. Anyone found discharging black or gray water from their unit will immediately be removed from the grounds.
- 9. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS. Dogs are to be exercised in designated areas only. Failure to comply may result in future entries being refused.
- 10. This show will be held outdoors. Exhibitors and handlers are responsible to provide adequate shelter to protect their dogs from the sun. Exhibitors are responsible for their equipment and possessions. There will be no other facilities in case of inclement weather.

ADDITIONAL ENTRY INFORMATION

- 11. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- No refund of entry will be made due to riot, civil disturbance, "Act of God", or 12. other reason beyond the control of the Club where it is deemed impossible to open or complete the show.
- 13. Corrections /cancellations must be made in writing BEFORE entries close. Substitutions or cancellations after the closing date is prohibited. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Moving Class Dogs to Specials is permitted.
- No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are 14. completed in full. Incomplete entries will be returned.
- Tendering of N.S.F. Cheques is considered non-payment of fees. Any NSF or 15. returned item will be subject to a \$50.00 service charge.
- Entries close 1:00 pm (PDT) Thursday July 3, 2014, and must be in the 16. hands of the show secretary by that date.
- Entries will be acknowledged (including Judging Schedules) by EMAIL ONLY.
- Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall 18. not compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the show.
- Exhibitors are expected to know and abide by the Canadian Kennel Club Dog 19. Show Rules. Rulebooks may be obtained from the Canadian Kennel Club, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9; www.ckc.ca
