All levels Judged by Shanna Chynoweth, CPDT-KA, CNWI

Shanna is a CKC Scent Detection Trial judge, SDDA All Levels Judge, Certifying Official for UKC Nosework, C- WAGS All Levels Scent Detection judge, Certified Nose Work Instructor (CNWI) with the National Association of Canine Scent Work LLC (NACSW), as well as a Certified Professional Dog Trainer (CPDT-KA). Additionally, Shanna was past Vice-President of Sniff Alberta and is involved with Sporting Detection Dog Association (SDDA) as a competitor, trial host and shadow judged at Alberta's first SDDA trial. As a leader in the scent work community, Shanna was the first to teach scent classes in the province of Alberta in 2011, and her classes continue to be in high demand in Calgary. Her GSD Koda was the first dog in Alberta to get her UKC Nosework title while her NSDTR Nicholas earned his SDDA Master Championship and Elite title on the same day as well as having his CKC Excellent title. Her students have earned numerous titles and championships in SDDA (Started to Elite), UKC (Novice to Masters), C- WAGS and SDS.

IMPORTANT PARTICIPANT INFORMATION FOR COVID-19

- There will be no kenneling
- Only one handler and one dog in the building at a time during the test.
- Masks are mandatory
- For the Judge's Briefing, all participants must follow social distancing protocols.
- Participants must adhere to all Province of Alberta protocols, including not attending the event if you are sick, have any COVID-19 symptoms, have been in contact with COVID-19 or have travelled within the last 14 days.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION

The Non-Member Participation fee applies to dogs who only owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC. It is not applicable to CKC members or dogs owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The Non-member Participation Fee is paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Trail Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on the receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred (See Section 19.7).
- Scent Detection Levels Offered
Instinct, Novice (Containers, Interior and Exterior), Open (Containers, Interior, Exterior) and Excellent (Containers, Interior, Exterior). Exhibitors can compete in same level components with a maximum of two (2) dogs.



- Note: Dogs must have passed all three (3) components at a level before entering the next. (ie. A dog must pass Novice Container, Interior and Exterior before entering any component at the Open Level.
- Mixed and unrecognized breeds will be accepted at this trial. These dogs must have a CCN (Canine Companion Number) issued by the Canadian Kennel Club in order to participate in these trials. - Bitches in Season
Bitches in season are not permitted to compete (See CKC Scent Detection Rule 6.5). We will refund all entry and listing fee if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate. The certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.
- Penalties Issued by the Club
Dropping food while rewarding is considered contamination. Contamination of the search area will result in a non-qualifying score and any dog that urinates or defecates or vomits within the search area will be excused from the competition. Handlers will be charged for any damage done to equipment by dogs (including urinating on terms, excessive scratching or subsequent breaking of any item.)
- Reminder
That anyone discussing hides before the end of the trial will be excused and asked to leave as per CKC rules. Please show consideration for other competitors.
