This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dod's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$58.50 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. <u>These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non-regular</u> or <u>unofficial classes or Parades</u>

#### **NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES**

All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular classes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

BRACE	Two dogs not necessarily of the same sex or owner. Must be handled by one person on one lead and should be judged as an identical pair. Dogs may be spayed/neutered
STUD DOG & GET	Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud Dog and Get may be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition only.
BROOD BITCH & PROGENY	Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny. Same stipulations as for Stud Dog and Get apply to this classification.

# **SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES**

Eligibility for the Altered Dog Classes shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure.

Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered Dog Class judging.

Two classes will be offered: Altered Male & Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in Breed.

#### WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone <u>but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time.</u> If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

## Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to
  enter back into the United States, all <u>US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved</u>
  Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies
  vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this
  country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog. NOTE: Dogs
  less than three months of age do not require rabies vaccination.
