

## **ENTRIES & FEES**

Entries must be typed, filled and signed correctly, and emailed. No mailed, photographed or late entries will be accepted.

- TCN fee: A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) as established by the CKC, and a fee of \$10.50, must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration or an ERN is not shown on the entry form. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a PEN (Performance Event Number) or CCN (Canine Companion Number) ERN's for foreign born or foreign owned dogs can be obtained from the CKC. ERN must be applied for within 30 days of entering a CKC event.
- Please note: The CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

### Catalogues

Catalogues and a Running Order will be emailed to handlers prior to the test. They will not be distributed at the test. A Running Order will be posted on site for reference

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. Only entries on official CKC forms (attached), accompanied by the appropriate payment will be accepted up to the closing date and time.
- 2. Entries must be typewritten, no photographs please. This club does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of any entry form. Dog owners and / or their agents are responsible for requesting correction of errors contained in the catalogue.
- 3. The **running order** will be determined by a draw for each stake at the home of the Secretary after time of closing. The running order may be changed on the day of the tests as provided by the Official Rules.
- 4. Bitches in season are not eligible for entry and are not allowed on the test grounds.
- 5. Full refunds will be given for any dog withdrawn because of estrus, injury, illness or death and unless otherwise agreed by the trial committee must be accompanied by a Veterinarian's certificate. Other refunds (less a scratch fee of \$10.00 per dog) may be given for an extraordinary reason at the discretion of the trial committee. All requests for refund must be in writing and must be received by the trial secretary no later than 2 hours before the test.
- 6. Ducks, pheasants or chukars may be used.
- 7. Dogs are permitted to wear Neoprene vests for water marks and water blinds.
- 8. All participants and spectators shall wear hunting attire or dark clothing.
- 9. Vehicles must be confined to designated roads only.
- 10. Please take any refuse or recycling items with you.
- 11. Rosettes will be awarded for all qualifying dogs and will be presented at the end of each test.

### LEGAL MATTERS

Hunt Test Rules & Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club state in Section:

2.5.1 There shall be no training of dogs on the grounds of a hunt test, accept for single training bumpers which are thrown by hand by the handler, either within 24 hours of the commencement of the event, or any time during the event.

3.8.1 A judge officiating at test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the test. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue."

### Release and Indemnification:

By participating in these tests (as handler, spectator or in any other role) each participant agrees to assume all risk and hazards incidental to these tests and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the British Columbia Labrador Retriever Club Society and its members, any volunteer and the owners of the property upon which the tests are held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, cost expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants use or entry upon the property. It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
