ALTERNATE LIST: When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries will be assigned a position on an "Alternate List" in the order received. Entries from the alternate list may fill any absentee spaces at the time of the draw. The person making the entry shall be notified of their position on the alternate list. Entries will be refunded within ten days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

Effective January 1, 2011, the Canadian Kennel Club has implemented a non-member participation fee which will be charged to a resident of Canada who is not a member of the Canadian Kennel Club. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards, legs, points, titles being cancelled. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by the non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members. (\$57.60 in 2012)

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

From Fredericton: Take Exit 365 (Sussex, Fundy), travel approx. 33km. Then veer left onto Roachville Road.

From Moncton: Take Exit 193 and turn right off the exit ramp. Turn left at the next stop sign, then straight at the flashing red light.

From Saint John: Take Exit 192, turn left off the exit ramp, right at the next stop sign and left at the flashing yellow light.

The farm is the first on the right at 107 Roachville Road. The barn has "Sussex View Holsteins" on the end.

The Kennebecasis Obedience Club will use all reasonable care to guarantee the safety of dogs and persons at the tests, however, neither will accept the responsibility for loss or injury, however caused, to any dog, person or property.
