Judges Biographies

Dr Eric Liebes – Colorado, USA



Eric's first two dogs were a Komondor and an Ibizan Hound. The Komondor still shares the breed's AKC All-Breed Best In Show record. The Ibizan Hound finished his championship and was one of the first CDX titled Ibizan's.

In the '80's Eric branched out to many Sighthound breeds and also tried his hand at obedience and performance competition. During the 1980's, based out of Denver, he finished championships on dogs of numerous breeds in the family and for others, and placed regularly in the Hound, Working and Herding groups throughout the Rocky Mountain area. He also achieved 7 Komondor National Specialty wins, 10 all-breed Bests-In-Show and finished CD's on five Komondors, two Ibizan Hounds and a Tibetan Terrier.

Eric's first Ibizan Hound was acquired in 1981. By 1994 he had bred a Dual Champion, multiple Best-in-Field, Pedigree Award, and National Specialty winning dog and several other Dual Champions. Eric is still active as an exhibitor and breeder. He has a 7 year old Ibizan Hound and a 5 year old Komondor. Each of these dogs have been Select at their Nationals. With Joan he has shown, bred and finished Samoyeds, including 3 with specialty wins and group placements.

Eric was first approved to judge by the AKC in 1992. His first breed approvals were Ibizans, Greyhounds, and Komondors. He is now approved to judge all Sporting, Hound, Working and Herding breeds, Misc., Junior Showmanship, and BIS. He has judged in Australia, Canada, China, Sweden, Ireland, and Mexico as well as for AKC. He continues to study and learn more about all of the breeds. Eric has had the honor of judging the National Specialty for Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Kuvasz, Samoyeds and Standard Schnauzers. His goal is to bring a breeder's eye to his judging every time he judges, especially at these important specialties.

Eric is a breed mentor in Komondors, Samoyeds, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds and Pulis. He is currently the Judge's Education Coordinator for the Ibizan Hound Club of the United States. Eric and his wife Joan live outside of Colorado Springs with 7 dogs and 2 horses. Eric is retired from his career as a Research Geophysicist for Chevron.

Lori Iverson



Lori has bred German Shepherds under the Nobler prefix for 30 years. Her first dog was unregistered but upon joining the GSDC of Manitoba club in Jan 1979 the world of breeding and exhibiting purebred dogs was opened up. The Nobler kennel name can be found on over 50 champions and on many Best in Show and Best in Specialty winners. As well, Lori handled many other breeds when living in Manitoba, primarily Herding, Working and Sporting breeds. On the Education Committee for the GSDC of Canada, Lori has co-produced 3 ringside mentoring programs at 3 National Specialties for judges and breeders. Currently, she is continuing to breed and exhibit GSD's, as well as pursuing a new step in the world of purebred dogs as a judge.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will NOT be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Post-dated cheques will NOT be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par" they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank-you.

BORDER CROSSING - A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada, Government Regulations require a Certificate prior to entry into Canada.

Event Registration Number (ERN) Notice

All dogs that are foreign born and owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an ERN. An ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. If factors beyond your control prohibit this or present a problem, please send a written request for a 30 day extension to the CKC. JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

Entry in Sweepstakes from the Exhibition Only class is **not** allowed - **EXCEPT** for puppies aged 3-6 months. These puppies may enter from the Baby Puppy Class or from the Exhibition (3-6 mos.) Class.

The following Classes will be offered (divided by sex):

3 - 6 months 6 - 9 months 9 - 12 months 12 – 15 months 15 - 18 months

The Newfoundland Dog Fanciers of Alberta will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses.

The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

First in each class 7.5% of total entry fee & ribbon

Second, Third & Fourth in each class Ribbons

Best in Sweepstakes

Prize & rosette

Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes

Prize & rosette

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The following Classes will be offered (divided by sex):

7 – under 9 years 9 years and older

The Newfoundland Dog Fanciers of Alberta will retain 25% of each entry fee for expenses. The remaining 75% shall be awarded as follows:

First in each class: 10% of total entry fee & Ribbon

Second, Third & Fourth in each class Ribbons

Best Male in Veterans Sweepstakes: 17.5% of total entry fee + Rosette + Prize

Best Female in Veteran Sweepstakes: 17.5% of total entry fee + Rosette + Prize

Non-regular, unofficial & sweepstakes conformation classes

To compete in the juvenile sweepstakes class, dogs must be entered in a regular class, or for specials only.

Entry in the juvenile sweepstakes from the exhibition only class is not permitted.

Dogs entered in the veteran sweepstakes may be entered in exhibition only.

Sweepstakes will immediately precede the specialty classes.

Champions are permitted in all sweepstakes.

CLASSIFICATIONS

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Baby Puppy	for dogs 3 months of age but under 6 months of age
Junior Puppy	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-15 Months	for dogs 12 months of age but under 15 months of age
15-18 Months	for dogs 15 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Open	for all dogs. <i>This class will be divided by colour – Black & Landseer</i>
Field (Draft) Dog	<i>for any dog that holds a CKC Draft title (DD, DDX, BDD, BDDX). Field dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of these classes shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.</i>
+7 – 9 Years Veteran	for any dog, 7 years of age but under 9 years of age
+9 Years & older Veteran	for any dog, 9 years of age and older <i>Veteran dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winners of these classes shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.</i>
Specials Only	dogs which are <u>registered individually</u> , in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have a CKC ERN and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the CKC, but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only	for all dogs over 3 months of age and eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club

Non Regular Classes

ALL DOGS MUST BE ENTERED IN THE REGULAR CLASSES, VETERANS or FIELD CLASS, SPECIALS ONLY, OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY TO COMPETE IN THE FOLLOWING NON-REGULAR CLASSES (NO BABY PUPPIES).

Stud Dog Stud dog and TWO or more of his Get, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Get **MUST** be entered in a Regular Class, making baby puppies ineligible.

Brood Bitch Brood bitch and TWO or more of her Progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Progeny **MUST** be entered in a Regular Class, making baby puppies ineligible.

Brace Two dogs (not necessarily of the same sex) shown on one lead, ownership need not be identical.

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

Championship Points

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided here under.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total.

If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group.

A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges;

be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN);

have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean:

Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level;

each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing;

all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Dogs Competing	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or More
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

Points awarded beyond breed level shall be:

In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title.

Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship.

A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) or a Best in Multiple-Breed Specialty with at least three (3) breeds represented plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system

Win	Points
First in Group or Best in Specialty Show	5
Second in Group of Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4
Third in Group	3
Fourth in Group (Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	2
Best of Breed (To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	1
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15. The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC. Additional Requirements To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this.
