START TIMES AND CALLBACKS for Open and Amateur will be posted at the conclusion of each stake on Friday and Saturday evenings. Judges will impose a system of ROTATION in both the Open and Amateur stakes using the 2 ending digits in the TSX index as of the closing of business on Wednesday15th as starting numbers for the first series of these stakes. There may be rotation in qualifying.

NEW C.K.C. Ruling – Non CKC members who are Canadian, running a wholly-owned dog, cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member fee to the CKC. Otherwise, Awards and Titles will be cancelled. CKC fee will be paid directly to the CKC.

All entries must be received by the Draw party, Wednesday, June 8th, 2022 at 7:00 PM at the home of Anna Morrison-Scott. Cheques should be dated no later than June 8th, and made payable to the York Retriever Field Trial Club in Canadian funds. U.S. currency will be accepted at par.

LISTING FEE: The listing fee of \$11.30 per dog must be submitted for any dog not having an individual registration number.

Game Birds: Ducks will be used in all stakes

Prizes: Standard CKC Rosettes will be awarded to dogs placing 1st through 4th and CM's designated by judges.. Presentations will be made at the completion of each stake.

ALL SCRATCHES MUST BE REPORTED TO THE FIELD TRAIL SECRETARY 24 HOURS BEFORE THE TRIAL. Entry fees will be refunded only for bitches in season or for injured dogs, upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate. Once the catalogue has been printed, a \$10.00 surcharge will apply.

NOTICE TO TRIALERS:

Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations, it shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the Canadian Kennel Club any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred.

Please check in with the Marshal upon arrival at your stake. It is the responsibility of the handler to inform the Marshal if they have dogs running in other stakes, and the Marshall has the authority to move dogs for the efficiency of the test.

Noise makers will be used.

Handlers are expected to be familiar with the CKC Rules and Regulations for Field Trials.

It is understood that this agreement is binding upon the participant and all of his/her heirs, executors and assigns.

CAUTION; The York Field Trial Retriever Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage eo any dog, or to any equipment whether the result of an accident or otherwise. Furthermore, the York Field Trial Retriever Club will assume no liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to participants, bystanders, club members, workers or any other individual using the properties for any purpose.

CKC HEALTH REMINDER: No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: 1. is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. 2 Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days prior to the event. 3 has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on the premises on which there has existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subjected to disciplinary action if it is found that the CKC rules have been contravened.
