## Judge's Biography

The confirmed judge will be Josef Mravik, FCI

Born 1967 in Czech Republic, Josef speaks Russian, German, English, Slovak and Yugoslavian. Josef was the youngest person to become a judge in the FCI. He became a working judge in 1986 and show judge in 1989.

He is qualified to judge;

- approx. 100 breeds,
- Körungs,
- IPO,
- SVV,
- Water Rescue,
- Search and Avalanche Rescue.

Josef has judged trials and dog shows in the USA, Australia, England, South Africa, Germany, Brazil, Portugal, Costa Rica, Italy, Korea, Hungary, Yugoslavia, Poland, Belgium, Czech Republic, Mexico, Slovenia, White Russia, Russia, and many more...! Now, he can add CANADA!

- In 1996 and 1997 he won the Austrian Bundessieger with his male and female dog. His male dog took V1 in Sieger Class at the most prestige Rottweiler show in the world in the German Klubsieger.
- He has trained 15 dogs to SVV2, two Rottweilers to SVV3 and IPO3, 20 dogs to BST, and two Rescue and Avalanche Rescue dogs.
- 1984 National Youth Champion in Rescue Dog.
- 1987-1989 Helper for National Schutzhund competition; one of 6 certified helpers for Körungs at this time.
- 1991, his IPO3 Rottweiler male competed to represent Czechoslovakia in the world championship for Rottweiler in Italy.

On a personal note;

- In 1977-1985 Josef won the Slovak and Czech Championship 27 times in swimming.

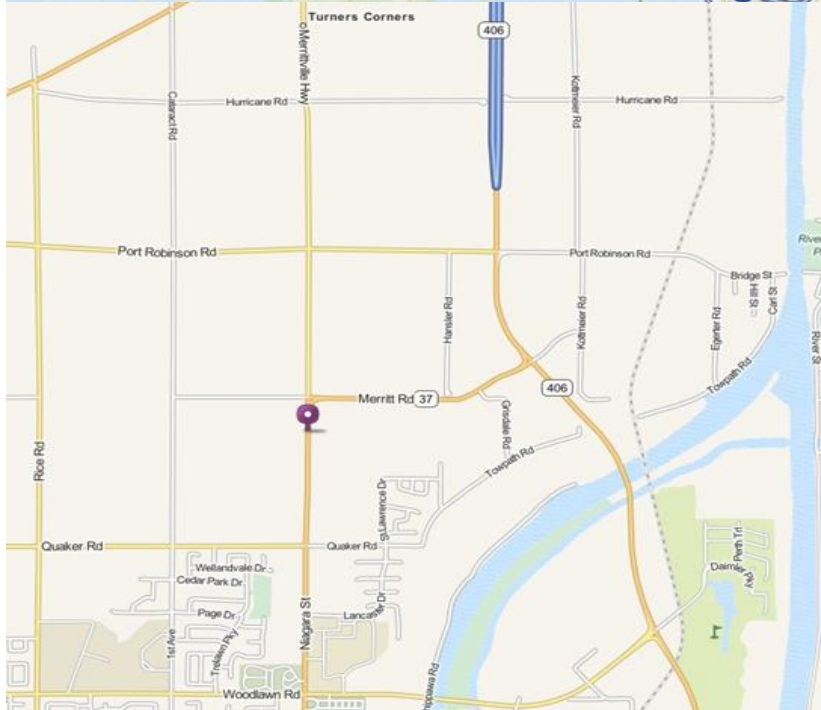
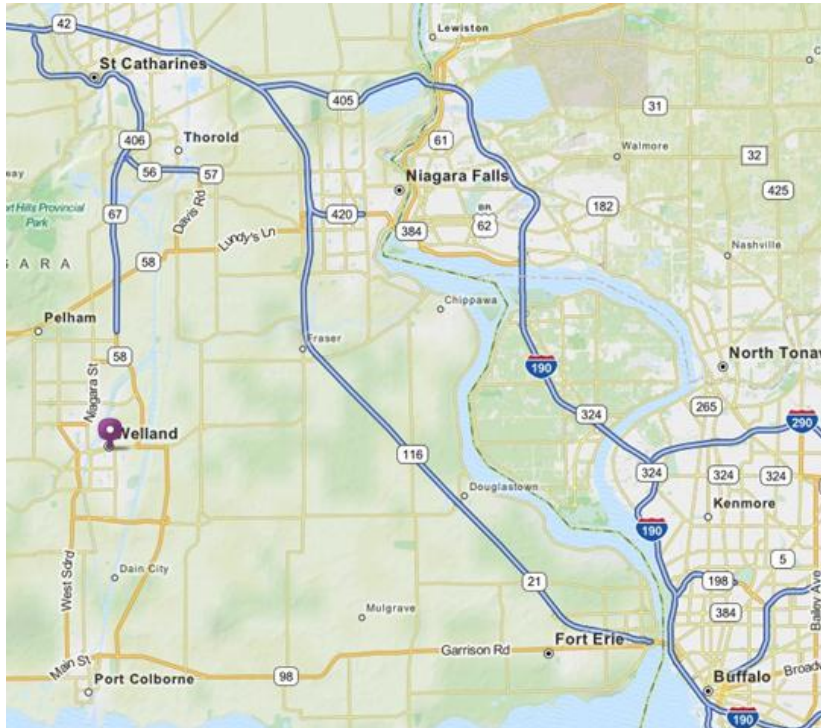

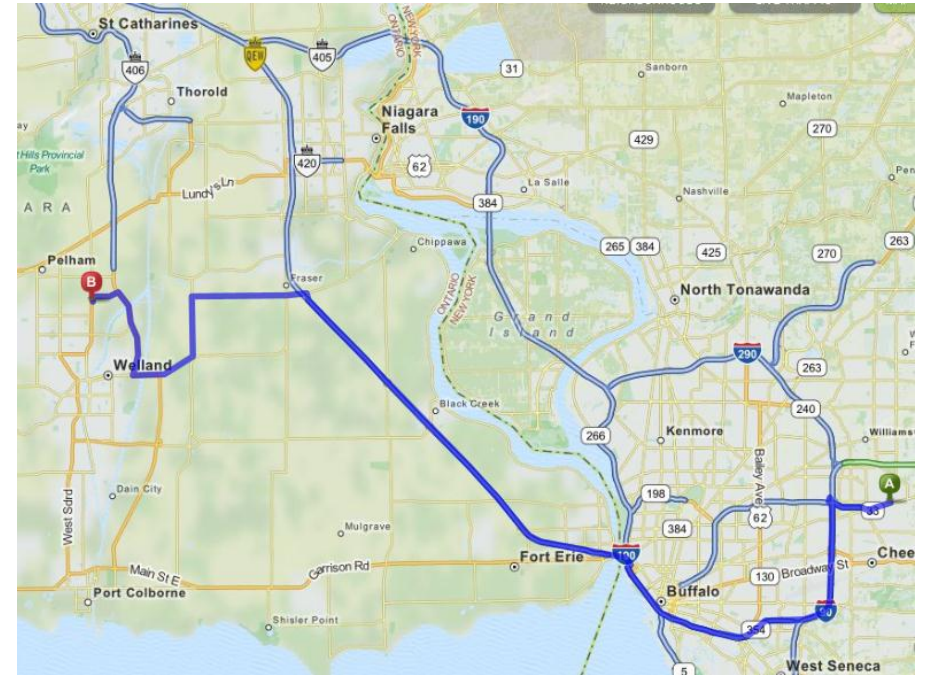

## CONFORMATION SHOW INFORMATION

### Puppy Classes

4-6 Month Male/Female; 6-9 Month Male/Female; 9-12 Month Male/Female

### Youth Classes

12-18 Month Male/Female; 18-24 Month Male/Female

### Adult Classes

**Open Male/Female:** 24 months and older without an IPO title or a Championship title.

**Champion Class** - Over 24 months with Championship title from RKNA, AKC, CKC, CACIB and all National breed club champions. In addition, entries will be accepted from Sieger/Siegerin, Best Adult Male/Female, Klubsieger/in, Best and Most Beautiful in Show, if they meet the requirements of RKNA Championship Program.

**Working Male/Female:** 24 months & older with an IPO title.

**Veteran Male/Female:** 8 years or older the day of the show.

**Brood Bitch:** Entered by the owner of the brood bitch. Must have at least two (2) offspring appear in the ring. Offspring must be entered in regular classes. The class is evaluated on the merits of the offspring. Owner of the brood bitch does not need to be the owner of the offspring.

**Stud Dog:** Entered by the owner of the stud dog. Must have at least two (2) offspring appear in the ring. Offspring must be entered in regular classes. The class is evaluated on the merits of the offspring. Owner of the stud dog does not need to be the owner of the offspring.

**Kennel Class:** Entered by the kennel owner. Three (3) or more dogs bred by the kennel owner & registered with the kennel name of the entrant. All dogs must be entered in the show's regular classes. The kennel owner need not be the owner of all the dogs.

**Exhibition Class:** Exhibition Classes are for critique only. This class is open to Rottweilers with a disqualifying fault or who are spayed or neutered. Puppies too young to enter regular puppy class can enter exhibition class if puppy has a proof of registration. No ratings or placements are to be awarded. Dogs are critiqued with fault(s) noted. This class is for educational purposes only.

*If a dog is eligible for more than one class, the owner may determine the class to enter in.*

## STANDARD EVALUATION TEST INFORMATION

### **RKNA Standard Evaluation Title (SE):**

The **RKNA SE** title is not a breed test title as it is a certified conformation analysis and consists of measurement, grading of eye color, dentition check and show critique. The dog's conformation must be judged of breeding quality and free of disqualifying faults. The owner must provide a weight certificate signed by a vet within 20 days prior to the test. The dog must have a valid hip certification and have a tattoo or microchip for identification (handler is responsible for providing a microchip reader). The Rottweiler is assessed for conformation and soundness.

The test includes everything on the dog being measured or evaluated, including:

height at withers, body length, muzzle, chest depth, chest circumference, skull, eye color, bite and dentition, bone strength, head shape, cheek bone, and general behaviour.

**i) Dogs will be weighed, measured and critiqued.** A weight certificate (issued within 20 days of the test) may be substituted for weighing the dog if no scale is available. Character traits of the dog become more or less apparent during the weighing and measuring process.

**ii) The tattoo or microchip number shall be read out loud** as part of the measuring and critique.

**iii) The following tests will be done to establish the interaction in a group and sensitivity to noise;**

**a.** The Group. The handler with dog on leash walks through a group of five to eight people. The handler and dog return to the center of the group where the dog sits. The group, when instructed by the judge, converges on the dog and handler and remains there until told by the judge to disperse.

**b.** The Gun. The handler and dog walk away from the judge. At a distance of fifteen paces, a 22 short blank starter pistol, or its equivalent, is fired twice with a short interval in between each shot. Should the dog have a reaction to the gunfire, this exercise may be varied and repeated at the judge's discretion. If the dog continues to show a strong reaction to gunfire, the test is stopped and the dog does not pass.

**Original paperwork must be presented to Show Secretary upon registration at show.** This includes registration papers and hip certification papers. If titles are to be recorded on the Standard Evaluation, proof of titles must be shown (score book and current membership card from organization the score book is held with, title certificates, etc.).



## IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION:

- Dogs born in countries with anti-docking laws must be shown with a natural tail.
- A copy of your dog's proof of registration papers MUST be sent in with each entry. Copies of supporting documents for the Champion and Working classes; breed surveys, and Standard Evaluations must also be submitted.
- Spayed or neutered dogs may not show with the exceptions of Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, and Exhibition Classes.
- Dogs with missing teeth will be excused from the ring
- Males will be judged first
- All dogs must be shown on a Fur-Saver collar (no nylon collars or chokes)
- Dogs are shown in natural stance; no hand stacking is allowed. No food is allowed in the ring; toys may be used at the judge's discretion. Double handling is encouraged.
- Any entry that does not meet the Class requirement will be invalid.
- When a dog is eligible for more than one class, the dog's owner determines the entry
- This is a German style Breed show
- The event is being held outdoors, rain or shine
- No dogs are allowed to be tied out at the show site or ringside
- No dogs are allowed to be crated near the ring
- Please use designated areas to exercise your dogs and clean up after them
- Adult classes will be moved long enough for the judge to evaluate the movement
- You should always receive confirmation to the shows you enter. CORK and RKNA are not responsible for lost or late postal deliveries or lost or misdirected electronic entries. It is the entrant's responsibility to check on entry status on or before the entry closing date if confirmation has not been received.
- *Your dog should know to show bite; sides, front and open wide.*
- *The dog must allow the judge to touch genitals and tail while standing.*

## RKNA CHAMPIONSHIP PROGRAM

To attain the RKNA Championship title, a dog must achieve 5 total points. Points can be earned in the following ways:

- 1 point: V1 rating at any RKNA show
- 1 point: RKNA Best Male/Female
- 2 points: Ztp
- 2 points: IPO title

To attain the RKNA Elite Championship title, a dog must be a RKNA Champion and achieve an additional five (5)

Points. Points can be earned in the following ways:

- 1 point RKNA Best or Most Beautiful in Show
- 1 point RKNA Kombi-Sieger/in
- 2 points RKNA Sieger/in or RKNA Klub Sieger/in
- 2 points RKNA Gekört.
