Carl E. Gomes, of the Bronx, New York, became involved in the sport of dogs as a teenager. His first acquisition was a Boston Terrier, quickly followed by a German Shepherd Dog. Mr. Gomes began showing dogs in 1968 and was granted an AKC Professional Handlers License in 1973.

Mr. Gomes judges Best in Show, the Non-Sporting Group, and several breeds in other groups. For many years, he has chaired the Boston Terrier Club of America judges' education committee. His responsibilities include training and development of future judges of the breed and the dissemination of information, with the intent to promote and protect the interest of the breed.

His judging assignments include the Westminster Kennel Club and the AKC/Eukanuba National Championship. He has judged abroad in Germany, Sweden, South Korea, China, Canada, England, St. Lucia, and Trinidad. Mr. Gomes has been a member of several national breed clubs and is AKC Delegate from the Pacific Coast (California) Boston Terrier Club.
